## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric A, cut:

ten 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighty 5" squares for the HSTs
nine 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighty 4-1/2" squares
From each of Fabrics B-U, cut:
four squares from each ten square for a total of one-hundred sixty 5" squares
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles

Note: If you prefer for the directional prints in the quilt to read as they do in the cover, it is recommended to cut the squares in half diagonally, following the direction of the print shown in each specific place in the diagram, then sew together to form the HST and trim to size.

Step 1: Pair a 5" Fabric A square with a Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 4-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A/B HSTs.


Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

eight D/E HSTs

eight B/C HSTs

eight A/F HSTs

eight A/D HSTs

eight A/G HSTs

eight A/E HSTs

eight F/G HSTs

eight A/H HSTs

eight A/K HSTs

eight L/M HSTs

eight A/P HSTs

eight A/S HSTs
eight T/U HSTs

eight A/I HSTs

eight J/K HSTs

eight A/N HSTs

eight A/Q HSTs

eight R/S HSTs

eight H/I HSTs

eight A/L HSTs

eight A/O HSTs

eight P/Q HSTs

eight A/T HSTs

eight A/M HSTs

eight N/O HSTs


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## Assemble Block 1



Step 3: Gather:
four 4-1/2" Fabric A squares
four A/B HSTs
four A/C HSTs
four B/C HSTs
Arrange in four rows of four, following the fabric placement and block orientation shown in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the squares together to form rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions every other row. Sew the rows together, pressing the seams up. The Block should measure 16-1/2" square. Repeat to make a second Block 1 unit.

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make twenty Blocks. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement and combinations for each block.

## Assemble the Quilt

Step 5: Arrange the blocks into five rows of four blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 7: Sew the rows together to
 form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!


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
