## Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

Fabric A
Fussy cut the following blocks from the panel:
Tree block:12-1/2" wide $\times 21-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall
Donkey, barn, horse, and deer blocks: 12-1/2" wide $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ tall
Fabric B
Cut five strips 1-1/2" x WOF - for sashing from one strip sub cut three strips $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ trim two strips down to 1-1/2" x 27-1/2" trim three strips down to $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut four strips 2-1/2" x WOF trim two strips down to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - for top and bottom outer borders trim two strips down to $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ - for side outer borders

Fabric C
Cut four strips 1" x WOF
trim two strips down to 1 " $\times 34-1 / 2$ " - for side inner borders trim two strips down to 1 " $\times 28-1 / 2 "$ - for top and bottom inner borders

Binding:
Cut four strips 2-1/2"x WOF

## Block Construction

Step 1: Sew a 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric B sashing strip between three of the $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ panels to make one long block (see fig. 1). Press towards sashing.

Step 3: Sew a 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" Fabric B sashing strip between and on either side of the block columns from Steps 1 and 2. Press towards sashing. Sew a $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 27-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B sashing strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top. See diagram to the right. Press towards sashing.


Step 4: Following the quilt assembly diagram sew the 1" x $34-1 / 2$ " Fabric $C$ side inner borders to the quilt top. Press towards sashing.

Step 5: Sew the $1 " \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C top and bottom inner borders to the quilt top. Press towards sashing.

Step 6: Following the quilt assembly diagram sew the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B side outer borders to the quilt top. Press towards sashing.

Step 7: Sew the $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 32-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B top and bottom outer borders to the quilt top. Press towards sashing.

Step 8: Your quilt top is now compete. Sandwich baste and quilt using your favorite method. Bind in binding fabric.

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
