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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 21-1/2" $\times 20$ " rectangle for the quilt center
From Fabric B, cut:
two 12-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
four 12-1/2" squares
Trim the remainder of the strip to 6-1/2" wide, then subcut: four 6-1/2" squares
one 6-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 6-1/2" squares, for a total of eight
Trim the remainder of the strip to 3-1/2" wide, then subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares
four 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
forty 4" squares for the Large HSTs
one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
twelve 3-1/2" squares, for a total of sixteen
three 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $2^{\prime \prime} \times 21-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 1 strips
two 2 " $\times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 1 strips
From each of Fabrics C, G, K and O, cut: one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 4" squares for the Large HSTs
From Fabric H, cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
three 4" squares for the Large HSTs
From each of Fabrics D and L, cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
three 4" squares for the Large HSTs
Trim the remainder of the strip to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs
From each of Fabrics E, I, and M, cut: one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 4" squares for the Large HSTs
From each of Fabrics $\mathrm{F}, \mathrm{N}$, and R , cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 4" square for the Large HSTs

## From Fabric J, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
one 4" square for the Large HSTs
Trim the remainder of the strip to form two $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ wide strips. Subcut:
two $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

## From Fabric Q, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 4" squares for the Large HSTs
Trim the remainder of the strip to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide, then subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs
From Fabric P, cut:
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut: three 4" squares for the Large HSTs
five $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 2 strips
two $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 54-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 2 strips
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
two 2-1/2" $\times 66-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side Border 3 strips
two 2-1/2" $\times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top/bottom Border 3 strips

## From Fabric T, cut:

one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Subcut:
four $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs
From Fabric S , cut:
four 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixteen 6-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-four 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs
four 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
sixty-four 2" squares
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

## The Large HSTs

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric B square with a 4" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs).
 Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square. Repeat to make eight B/C HSTs.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

six B/H HSTs

eight B/K HSTs

six B/L HSTs

eight B/O HSTs


four B/E HSTs

four B/I HSTs
two B/J HSTs


four B/M HSTs

four B/Q HSTs

two B/F HSTs

two B/N HSTs

two B/R HSTs

## The Small HSTs

Step 3: Pair a 2-1/2" Fabric $S$ square with a 2-1/2" Fabric D square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press
 toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2" square. Repeat to make thirty-two S/D HSTs.

Step 4: Repeat Step 3 to make:

thirty-two S/L HSTs

thirty-two S/Q HSTs

thirty-two S/T HSTs

## Assemble the Star Point Blocks



## Step 5: Gather:

one 6-1/2" Fabric B square
two 3-1/2" Fabric B squares
four B/C HSTs
three B/D HSTs
two B/E HSTs
one B/F HST
Arrange the units as shown, noting the fabric placement and HST orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite direction every other row. Sew the first two rows together, press, then sew the $6-1 / 2$ " Fabric B square in place. Press.

Step 7: Sew the remaining rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Star Point Block will measure 12-1/2" square. Repeat to make a second Star Point Block from Fabric C/D/E/F.


Step 8: Repeat Steps 5-7 to make the following Star Point Blocks, noting the differences in HST orientations:

make two from
Fabric G/H/I/J

make two from
Fabric K/L/M/N

make two from Fabric $O / P / Q / R$

Assemble the Small Star Blocks
Step 9: Gather:
four Fabric $S$ squares
eight Fabric D Small HSTs
one Fabric D square
Step 10: Sew the HSTs together to form pairs, as shown. Press.
Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 11: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.

Step 12: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

The resulting Small Star Block should measure 6-1/2" square. Repeat to make four
 Fabric D Blocks. Repeat Steps 9-12 to make:

four Fabric Q Blocks

four Fabric T Blocks

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 13: Sew the Star Point Blocks into pairs, as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press.
Step 14: Sew the Fabric J strips to the top and bottom edges of the Fabric A center unit. Sew the side Border 1 strips to the left and right edges of the center unit. Press. Sew the top/bottom Border 1 strips to the remaining edges of the center square. Press.

Step 15: Arrange the Star Point Block pairs, Fabric B squares, and Center Block unit into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 16: Sew the units together to form rows. Press the seams away from the Star Point Block pairs.

Step 17: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Step 18: Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 19: Gather:
four Fabric $S$ rectangles
one Fabric Q Small Star Block
one Fabric D Small Star Block
one Fabric T Small Star Block
Sew together, as shown, to form the right Star Block border. Sew to the left edge of the quilt center. Repeat and sew to the right edge of the quilt center. Press.

Step 20: Gather:
four Fabric $S$ rectangles
one Fabric Q Small Star Block
one Fabric D Small Star Block
one Fabric T Small Star Block
two Fabric L Small Star Block
Sew together, as shown, to form the top Star Block border. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center. Repeat and sew to the bottom edge of the quilt center. Press.

Step 21: Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
