All border strip length measurements are approximate. Please measure your quilt top before cutting the length of each border.

Large Blocks-	ABT-7825-13	ABT-7850-200	1-1/4 yards
Four Patch A-	ABT-7830-3	ABT-9139-133	3/8 yard
Four Patch B-	ABT-7830-14	ABT-7833-133	3/8 yard
Four Patch C-	ABT-9143-9	ABT-9141-3	3/8 yard
Four Patch D-	ABT-9145-214	ABT-7830-9	3/8 yard
Sashing-	Kona® Avacado	Kona® Navy	1-1/4 yards
Inner Border & Binding-	ABT-9141-3	ABT-9141-133	1-1/4 yards
Outer Border-	ABT-7825-49	ABTM-9144-203	1-5/8 yards
Backing-	Your Choice	Your Choice	4-1/4 yards

Cutting Instructions

Large Blocks-	Cut Fifteen 8-1/2" squares.
Four Patch A-	Cut Fifteen 4-1/2" squares.
Four Patch B-	Cut Fifteen 4-1/2" squares.
Four Patch C-	Cut Fifteen 4-1/2" squares.
Four Patch D-	Cut Fifteen 4-1/2" squares.
Sashing-	Cut Thirty-Six 2" x 8-1/2" strips. Cut eleven 2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make seven 2" x 49-1/2" strips.
Inner Border & Binding-	Cut six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 2-1/2" x 59" strips and two 2-1/2" x 53-1/2" strips for the Inner Border. Cut seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.
Outer Border-	Cut eight 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make two 6-1/2" x 63" strips and two 6-1/2" x 65-1/2" strips for the Outer Border.
Backing-	Cut two 73" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make one 73" x 82" piece for the backing.

Assembly Instructions:

- 1) To make one 8-1/2" four patch block, follow Figure 1 to sew together one 4-1/2" Fabric A, B, C and D square. Repeat to make fifteen 8-1/2" four patch blocks.
- 2) To make the horizontal rows 1, 3 and 5, refer to the quilt photo and sew together three 8-1/2" large squares, two 8-1/2" four patch blocks and six 2" x 8-1/2" sashing strips.
- 3) To make the horizontal rows 2, 4 and 6, refer to the quilt photo and sew together three 8-1/2" four patch squares, two 8-1/2" large square blocks and six 2" x 8-1/2" sashing strips.
- 4) Refer to the quilt photo to sew the horizontal rows and 2" x 49-1/2" sashing strips together to make the quilt top.
- 5) Sew one 2-1/2" x 59" strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 53-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 6) Sew one 6-1/2" x 63" strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 65-1/2" strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 7) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.

*Optional piecing instructions [after Step 5] for Boy Scout quilt directional border:
Cut four 6-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 6-1/2" x 65-1/2" strips.

Cut five 6-1/2" x length of fabric (LOF) strips. Piece the strips together to make two 6-1/2" x 63" strips for the side borders.

If you do not wish to piece borders, you'll need a total of 2-3/4 yards to complete the directional borders.

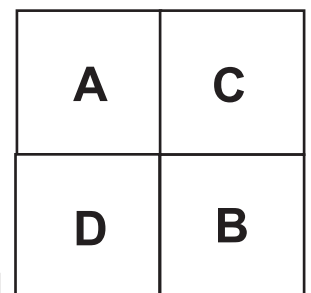
