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

Cutting Instructions From each block frame fabric: Fabric A/D/G	Cut (1) 14-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (6) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strips and (12) 2-1/2" squares. Cut (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut into (6) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips.	
From each background fabric: Fabric B/E/H	Cut (1) 10-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut into (3) 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles.	
From each applique fabric: Fabric C/F/I	See instructions to cut (3) animal appliques from each solid fabric.	


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Cutting Instructions (continued)

From border fabric: Fabric J	Cut (3) 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together to make (2) 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" strips for the top & bottom borders. Cut (2) 4-1/2" x 48-1/2" strips from the length of fabric for the side borders.	
Non-directional borders:	Cut (5) $4-1/2$ " x WOF strips. Pieces the strips together to make (2) $4-1/2$ " x $48-1/2$ " strips for the side borders and (2) $4-1/2$ " x $50-1/2$ " strips for the top & bottom borders.	
From binding fabric: Fabric K	Cut (6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.	
From backing fabric:	Cut (2) 58" x WOF pieces. Piece the fabrics together to make (1) 58" x 64" backing.	

Assembly


- 1) To make one block, place (1) 2-1/2" Fabric A square to the top left corner of (1) 10-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangle, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, 1/4" away from the sewn seam.
- 2) Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2-1/2" Fabric A square to each of the remaining corners of the Fabric B rectangle to make Background One Block (Fig. 4).
- 3) Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric A strip to each side of the Background One Block. Sew (1) 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" strip to the top & bottom of Background One Block to complete.
- 4) Repeat steps 1-3 to make (3) Background One Blocks total.
- 5) Repeat steps 1-3 using Fabric D & E pieces to make (3) Background Two Blocks.
- 6) Repeat steps 1-3 using Fabric G & H pieces to make (3) Background Three Blocks.
- 7) Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace (3) bunny templates, (3) lamb templates, and (3) swan templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each shape outside the drawn lines.
- 8) Press each shape onto the wrong side of the applique fabric, referring to quilt photo for animal/color placement. Cut out each shape on the drawn lines.
- 9) Refer to the quilt photo and press the shapes to the center of each background block as shown. Finish the raw edges of the applique with a decorative stitch such as satin or buttonhole.
- 10) Refer to the quilt photo to sew together (3) blocks to make (3) rows. Sew the rows together to make the 42-1/2" x 48-1/2" quilt top.
- 11) Sew (1) 4-1/2" \times 48-1/2" border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 4-1/2" \times 50-1/2" border strip to the top & bottom of the quilt top.
- 12) Layer, baste, quilt, & bind as desired.
