

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 44" wide.

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#### Pattern Notes

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

#### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A. cut:

thirty-six Template 1 pieces

#### From Fabric B, cut:

twenty Template 2 pieces

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together in sets of three, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 1-1/2" x 61-1/4" side border strips

two 1-1/2" x 63-1/4" top/bottom border strips

#### From Fabric C, cut:

sixteen Template 2 pieces

#### From Fabric D, cut:

one 7-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: five 7-1/4" squares

#### From Fabric E, cut:

one 7-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 7-1/4" squares

#### From each of Fabrics F-N, cut:

one 7-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut: four 7-1/4" squares

#### From the binding fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the A Blocks

**Step 1:** Fold the Template 1 and Template 2 pieces in half and finger press to mark the center of the inner and outer curves. Pair each Template 2 pieces (in Fabrics B and C) with a Template 1 piece, RST, pinning at the center creases and again at each end. Add additional pins to ease the curves together. Sew together and press seam to one side. Tip: Sew with the Template 1 pieces on top for easier stitching. Each block should measure 7-1/4" x 7-1/4".


**Step 2:** Arrange four Step 1 units from Fabric B, one Fabric D square and the four Fabric F squares in three rows of three, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the squares into rows, pressing seams toward the Fabric B squares. Sew the rows together, pressing seams

towards the Fabric F squares. Repeat with Fabrics G-J and all remaining Fabric B and D pieces to create a total of five A Blocks.

#### Assemble the B Blocks

**Step 3:** Repeat Step 2 above, using the Fabric C, E and K-N squares to create the four B Blocks. Note the orientation of the Fabric K-N squares in each block.

#### Assemble the Quilt Center



**Step 4:** Arrange the A and B Blocks in three rows of three, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew the blocks together to form rows, pressing seams to the left in the first and third rows and to the right in the second row. Sew the rows together, pinning at block intersections and pressing seams open.

#### Add the Border

Sew the 1-1/2" x 61-1/4" strips to the sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips. Sew the 1-1/2" x 63-1/4" strips to the sides of the quilt. Press seams toward the strips.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
