Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!
- *IF not using the Easy Angle or Half-Square Triangle, cut 6-7/8" squares, cut once on the diagonal for large triangles.
- IF not using Companion Angle, cut 7-1/4" squares, cut twice on the diagonal.


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, cut:

two 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve Half-square Triangles
From Fabric B, cut:
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve Companion Angle triangles
From Fabric C, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for the border. one 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 1-1/2" $\times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips

## From Fabric D , cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve Companion Angle triangles
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
three 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks
Step 1 Sew the Fabric B and Fabric D triangles together, exactly as shown, with the Fabric B print on top. Press toward the Fabric B print. Make twelve units.


Step 2 Sew the units from Step 1 together with the large Fabric A triangles. Press toward the Fabric A triangles. Make twelve units. At this point the unit should measure 6-1/2" square.


Step 3 Sew two Step 2 units together as shown. Press toward the Fabric A triangle. Make six units.

Step 4 Sew the Step 3 units together, matching and pinning the centers. Twist the center to open, pressing the seams to spin around the center. Make three blocks. At this point the blocks should measure 12-1/2" square.



Step 1 Sew the striped sashing between the blocks, creating the table runner. Press toward the sashing.

Step 2 Measure and trim two borders the length of the table runner. Sew to the sides of the runner, pressing toward the borders.

Step 3 Measure and trim two borders the length of the short ends of the runner. Sew to the runner, pressing toward the borders.

Your table runner is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
