* Each 1/4 yard will yield four scrunchies/headbands.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 59" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST
- Right sides out has been abbreviated to RSO.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

5"x18" fabric for scrunchie OR sew together scraps and trim to 5"x18" one 6 1/2" length of elastic

Tip

When sewing with knit, use a stretch stitch on a conventional sewing machine or, use a serger.

Assembly

1. Sew long sides RST. (1)



- 2. Turn tube RSO.
- 3. Bring short ends RST by sliding one open end of the tube up towards the other. Match ends, making sure not to twist seam. (2)



- 4. Stitch 3/4 of the way around the opening.
- 5. Turn RSO through opening.
- 6. (For headband skip to step 10.)
- 7. Using safety pin or bodkin, pull one end of the elastic through opening and tube. (3)



8. Overlap ends of elastic and stitch together. (4)



- 9. Release elastic into scrunchie.
- 10. Bring edges of opening together, folding seam allowance in. Stitch opening closed by machine or hand. (5) (6 for headband)
