## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 59" wide.*

\* Each 1/4 yard will yield four scrunchies/headbands.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 59" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST
- Right sides out has been abbreviated to RSO.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

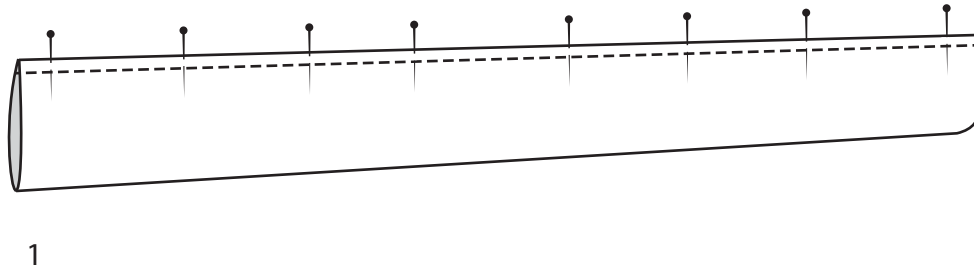
5"x18" fabric for scrunchie OR sew together scraps and trim to 5"x18"  
one 6 1/2" length of elastic

## Tip

When sewing with knit, use a stretch stitch on a conventional sewing machine or, use a serger.

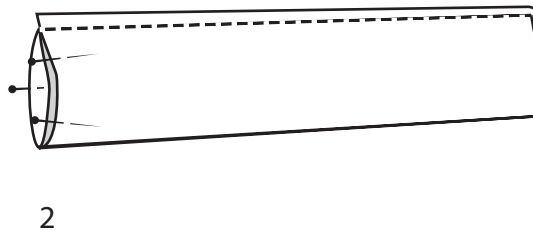
## Assembly

1. Sew long sides RST. (1)



2. Turn tube RSO.

3. Bring short ends RST by sliding one open end of the tube up towards the other. Match ends, making sure not to twist seam. (2)

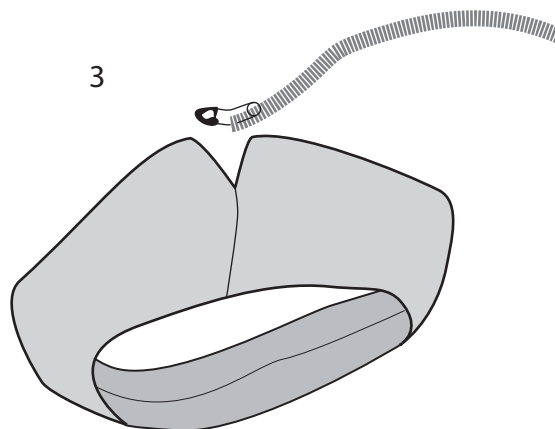


4. Stitch 3/4 of the way around the opening.

5. Turn RSO through opening.

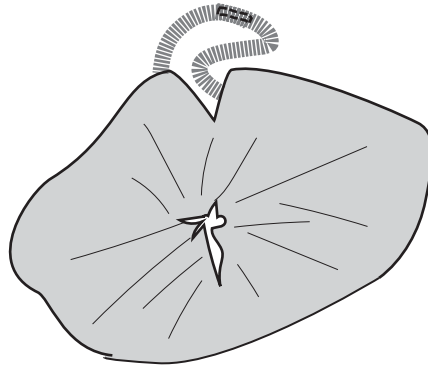
6. (For headband skip to step 10.)

7. Using safety pin or bodkin, pull one end of the elastic through opening and tube. (3)



8. Overlap ends of elastic and stitch together. (4)

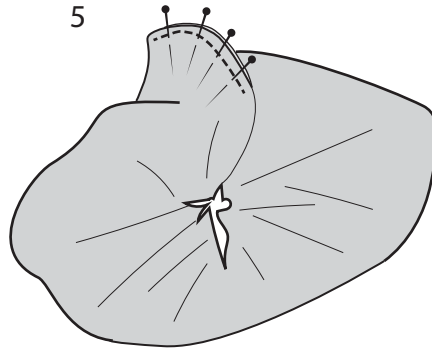

9. Release elastic into scrunchie.

10. Bring edges of opening together, folding seam allowance in. Stitch opening closed by machine or hand. (5) (6 for headband)
