Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From the Charm Pack squares:

Remove the squares that match Fabric A. From the remainder, cut thirty-four squares into four 2-1/2" squares each, for a total of one hundred thirty-six 2-1/2" squares. Note: one square will not be used.

From Fabric A, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred thirty-five 2-1/2" squares

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric B. cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

two 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" side outer borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Rows


Step 1: Gather five Fabric A squares and four assorted Charm Pack squares. Sew together to form a row, beginning and ending with a Fabric A square. Press the seams toward the right. Repeat to make fifteen rows like this.



Step 2: Gather four Fabric A squares and five assorted Charm Pack squares. Sew together to form a row, beginning and ending with a print square. Press the seams toward the left. Repeat to make fifteen rows like this.



Assemble the Runner



Step 3: Alternating between Step 1 rows and Step 2 rows, sew the rows together to form the center panel, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams to one side.

Step 4: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 5: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your runner top is finished! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
