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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Fabric A:

Fussy cut each of the ten panel blocks to $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric B:

Cut one 10-1/2" x WOF strip. From this, cut:
Four $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$
Trim the remaining WOF strip to be $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide. From this, cut:
One 7-1/2" $\times 14-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Two 4" $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric C:

Cut four $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$, on point


## Fabric D:

Cut four $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric E:

Cut two $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut four 7-1/2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric F:

Cut eight 7-1/2" $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric G:

Cut four 4" $\times 4^{\prime \prime}$
Cut four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric H :

Cut eight 7-1/2" $\times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric I:

Cut two 4-3/8" x WOF strips. From these, cut:
Sixteen $4-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 4-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Cut each once on the diagonal to form thirty-two triangles.
Cut eighteen 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips. Set aside seven strips for binding. Sew six strips together, end to end. Trim these to create:

Two 2-1/2" $\times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Two $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
From the remaining strips, cut:
Four $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Fabric J:

Cut three 3" x WOF strips.
Sew the strips together, end to end. Trim these to create:
Two 3" $\times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Cut three 5" x WOF strips.
Sew the strips together, end to end. Trim these to create:
Cut two 5" $\times 55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## Assemble the Quilt Center

1. Gather all Fabric C and D squares. Taking care not to handle the bias edges of the Fabric C blocks, sew Fabric I triangles to opposite sides of each square, pressing away from the square. Sew triangles to the remaining sides, pressing away from the square. Square in a Square blocks should measure $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
2. Sew 4 " $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B pieces to one side of a Fabric D Square in a Square block. Repeat for a second Fabric D block. Press seams toward Fabric B.
3. Sew a Fabric D Square in a Square block to both ends of the $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 14-1 / 2$ " Fabric $B$ piece. Press toward Fabric B.
4. Sew 4 " $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $F$ pieces to the left side of a Fabric C Square in a Square block. Repeat for a second Fabric C block. Press seams toward Fabric C. Repeat with two more Fabric C blocks and F rectangles, sewing the Fabric F piece to the right side of the blocks.
5. Sew a 4 " Fabric G square to a 4 " $\times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F rectangle. Press toward the rectangle. Repeat to form a total of four FG units.
6. Assemble the quilt center in rows, following the Quilt Center Assembly Diagram. Press seams to one side.

7. Sew a $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $G$ square to each end of a $28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip. Repeat to form both side sashing strips.
8. Sew $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the sashing. Sew the sashing strips assembled in Step 1 to the sides. Press toward the sashing.
9. Create the side inner borders by sewing together the following pieces, referring to the Border Assembly Diagram for placement:

- Three Fabric A panel pieces
- Two Fabric । $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- Four Fabric H $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- Two Fabric E $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles

Sew along the $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides of each piece. Repeat to create a second side inner border.
4. Create the top/bottom inner borders, by sewing together the following pieces, referring to the Border Assembly Diagram for placement:

- Two Fabric A panel pieces
- Two Fabric I $2-1 / 2$ "x $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- One Fabric E $7-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle
- Two Fabric B 10-1/2" x 4" rectangles

Sew along the $10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sides of each piece. Repeat to create a second top/bottom inner border.
5. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center, pressing toward the border. Sew the side inner borders to each side of the quilt, pressing toward the border.
6. Sew the $46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I sashing strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward sashing.

Sew the 56-1/2" Fabric I sashing strips to the sides of the quilt, pressing toward the sashing.
7. Sew the $3^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric J borders to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the outer border. Sew the 5 " $\times 55-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $J$ borders to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the outer border.



Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
