Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles

four 5-1/2" x 6-1/4" rectangles

two 5-1/2" x 3-3/4" rectangles

two 5-1/2" x 2-3/4" rectangles

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

ten 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles

two 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

six 3-1/2" x 2-1/2" rectangles

sixteen 3-1/2" squares for the large pinwheel HSTs

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-eight 3" squares for the Animal Block HSTs

nineteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. From ten strips, subcut:

twenty-eight 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for the Animal Blocks

twenty-eight 2-1/2" squares for the Animal Blocks

two 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

twenty-six 2-1/2" squares for the small pinwheel HSTs

Sew together the remaining nine strips, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 65-1/2" side inner border strips

two 2-1/2" x 53-1/2" top/bottom inner border strips

seven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" strips

four 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

two 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Sew the remaining five strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

four 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" column sashing strips

two 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3-1/2" squares for the large pinwheel HSTs

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty-eight 3" squares for the Animal Block HSTs

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips for the Animal Block side border

sixteen 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips for the Animal Block top/bottom border

Tip: to maximize yardage, cut two of each length from each WOF strip.

From Fabric D, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

ten 2-1/2" squares for the small pinwheel HSTs

From Fabric E, cut:

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
four 3-1/2" squares for the large pinwheel HSTs

From Fabric F, cut:

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" squares for the small pinwheel HSTs

From Fabric G, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 4-1/2" x 69-1/2" side outer borders
two 4-1/2" x 61-1/2" top/bottom outer borders
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
eight 2-1/2" squares for the small pinwheel HSTs

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Animal Blocks

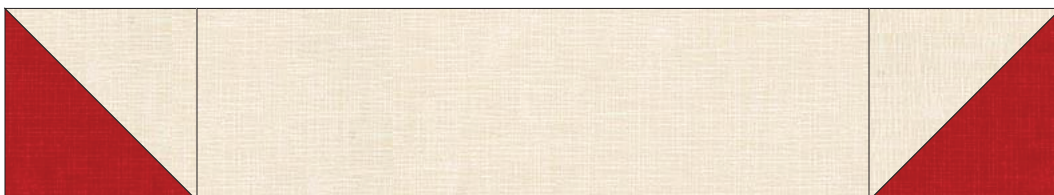


Step 1: Sew a Fabric C side block border to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square. Press. Sew a Fabric C top/bottom block border to the remaining edges of the Fabric A square. Press.

Step 2: Pair a 3" Fabric B square with a 3" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make sixty-four B/C HSTs.



Step 3: Sew a completed B/C HST to each short end of a 2-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric B rectangle, pressing toward the rectangle. Note that the Fabric B portion of the HST is next to the Fabric B rectangle. Repeat to make twenty-eight units like this.



Step 4: Gather:

- one Fabric A block center (with Fabric C border)
- four 2-1/2" Fabric B squares
- four completed Step 3 units

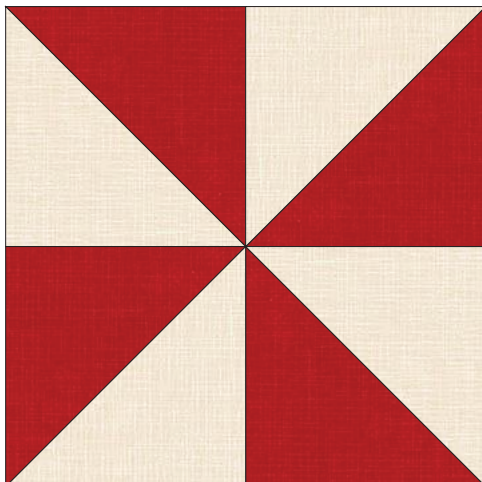
Arrange in three rows, as shown. Press the top and bottom row seams toward the center and press the middle row seams away from the center. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams. The resulting block will measure 15-1/2" square.

Repeat to make seven Animal Blocks.

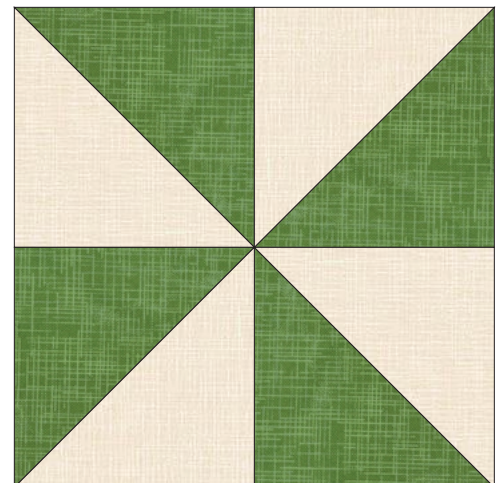


Assemble the Small and Large Pinwheel Units

Step 5: Pair a 3-1/2" Fabric B square with a 3-1/2" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3" square. Repeat to make twenty-four B/C HSTs.

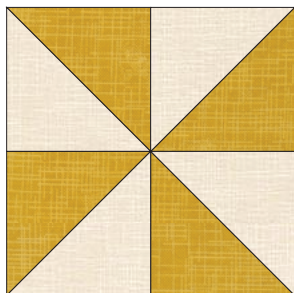
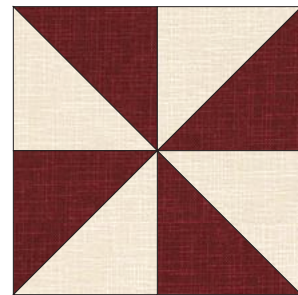


Step 6: Arrange four matching HSTs together in two rows of two, noting the fabric placement and HST orientation in the diagram. Sew the HSTs together to form rows, pressing the seam toward the darker fabric. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seam open. Repeat to make six 5-1/2" square B/C large pinwheel blocks.

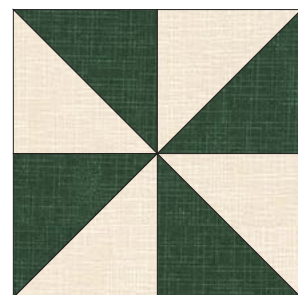


Step 7: Repeat Steps 5 and 6 to make two 5-1/2" square B/E large pinwheel blocks.

Step 8: Repeat Steps 5 and 6 with the 2-1/2" Fabric B and Fabric D squares to make five 3-1/2" square B/D small pinwheel blocks.



Step 9: Repeat Steps 5 and 6 with the 2-1/2" Fabric B and Fabric F squares to make four 3-1/2" square B/F small pinwheel blocks.



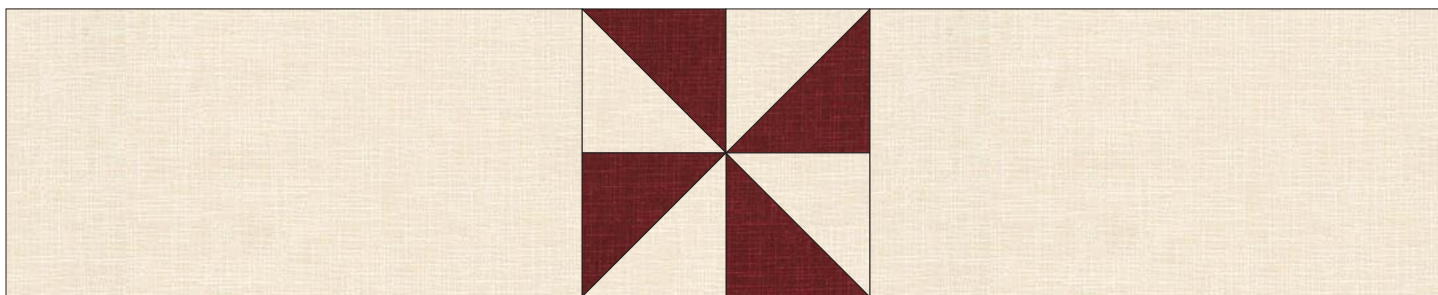
Step 10: Repeat Steps 5 and 6 with the 2-1/2" Fabric B and Fabric G squares to make four 3-1/2" square B/G small pinwheel blocks.

Assemble the Pieced Columns

Step 11: Gather:

- one Fabric B/D small pinwheel
- two 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangles

Sew the rectangles to opposite sides of the pinwheel unit. Press. Repeat to make five units like this.



Step 12: Gather:

- one Fabric B/F small pinwheel
- one Fabric B/E large pinwheel
- one 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 6-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 2-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle

Arrange as shown. Sew the units together to form columns (and press), before sewing the columns together to form the pieced block. Press. The block will measure 15-1/2" x 8-1/2". Repeat to make a second block. These will be used for the middle column.

Step 13: Gather:
three completed Animal Blocks
two completed Step 11 units

Sew together to form the left column, placing a Step 11 unit between each Animal Block. Press. Repeat to make the right column.

Step 14: Gather:
two completed Animal Blocks
one completed Step 11 unit
two completed Step 12 units
two 1-1/2" x 15-1/2" Fabric B strips

Sew together to form the center column. Press.

Step 15: Sew the three columns together to form the Quilt Center, placing a 1-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric B sashing strip between each column and on the left and right edges. Press toward the sashing strips.

Step 16: Sew the 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" Fabric B strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press.

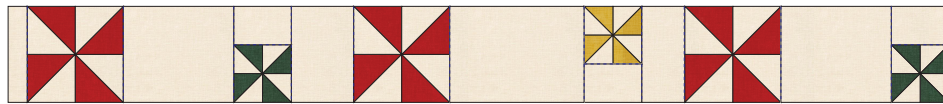


Assemble the Pieced Upper and Lower Borders

Step 17: Gather:

- three Fabric B/C large pinwheels
- two Fabric B/G small pinwheels
- one Fabric B/F small pinwheel
- two 5-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric B rectangles
- three 3-1/2" x 2-1/2" Fabric B rectangles
- one 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 3-3/4" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 5-1/2" x 7-1/2" Fabric B rectangle
- one 2-3/4" x 5-1/2" Fabric B rectangle

Arrange as shown. Sew the units together to form sections where indicated (and press), before sewing the units together to form the pieced row. Press. Repeat to make a second border.



Sew to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center, noting the orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Finish the Quilt Assembly



Step 18: Sew a Fabric B side inner border to the left and right edges of the Quilt Center. Press. Sew a Fabric B top/bottom inner border to the Quilt Center. Press.

Step 19: Sew a Fabric G side outer border to the left and right edges of the Quilt Center. Press. Sew a Fabric G top/bottom outer border to the Quilt Center. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
