## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 20-1/2" x 40-1/2" panel

## From Fabric B, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom panel borders
two 3-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
Sew the remaining full and partial strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 3-1/2" $\times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side panel borders
six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 1-1/2" $\times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom 3rd borders
two 1-1/2" $\times 70-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side 3rd borders
From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:
two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fourteen 4" squares
From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:
two 6-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
seven 6-1/4" squares. Cut each square along both diagonals, creating four triangles each.
From the remainder of the last strip, cut:
one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle

## From Fabric G, cut:

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom 1st borders
Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 1-1/2" $\times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side 1 st borders
eight $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding

## From Fabric H , cut:

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" top and bottom 2nd borders
Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 5-1/2" $\times 68-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side 2 nd borders

## From Fabric I, cut:

seven 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 6-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom 4th borders
two $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 82-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ side 4 th borders


Step 1: Arrange two Fabric C squares, two Fabric D squares, four Fabric E triangles and four Fabric F triangles, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together to form four diagonal rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions in alternating rows.

Tip: Align the right angle of each triangle with the corner of any adjacent squares. Tips of the triangles will extend beyond the square at the opposite end of the seam.


Step 2: Trim the block to 10-1/2" square, if necessary. Repeat to make seven blocks.


Step 3: Sew the $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B panel borders to the top and bottom of the panel. Press toward the borders. Sew the $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 46-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B panel borders to the sides of the panel. Press toward the borders.

Step 4: Gather four completed blocks and one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle each of Fabric B and Fabric F. Arrange to form a column, following the Quilt Center Diagram. Note the fabric placement and block orientation of the pieced blocks. Press the seams to one side.

Step 5: Gather three completed blocks and one $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle each of Fabric B and Fabric E. Arrange to form a row, following the Quilt Center Diagram. Note the fabric placement and block orientation of the pieced blocks. Press the seams to one side.

Step 6: Sew the completed Step 4 unit to the right edge of the panel. Press the seam toward the panel. Sew the completed Step 5 unit to the top of the quilt center. Press the seam down toward the panel. The quilt center should measure $36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Step 7: Sew the Fabric G 1st borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G 1st borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the Fabric H 2nd borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric H2nd borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Sew the Fabric B 3rd borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B 3rd borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 10: Sew the Fabric I 4th borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric I 4th borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
