

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, fussy cut:**

one 20-1/2" x 40-1/2" panel

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom panel borders

two 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

Sew the remaining full and partial strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" side panel borders

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" top and bottom 3rd borders

two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" side 3rd borders

### **From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:**

two 4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

fourteen 4" squares

### **From each of Fabrics E and F, cut:**

two 6-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seven 6-1/4" squares. Cut each square along both diagonals, creating four triangles each.

From the remainder of the last strip, cut:

one 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

### **From Fabric G, cut:**

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 36-1/2" top and bottom 1st borders

Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" side 1st borders

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding

### **From Fabric H, cut:**

six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 5-1/2" x 38-1/2" top and bottom 2nd borders

Sew the remaining strips together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 5-1/2" x 68-1/2" side 2nd borders

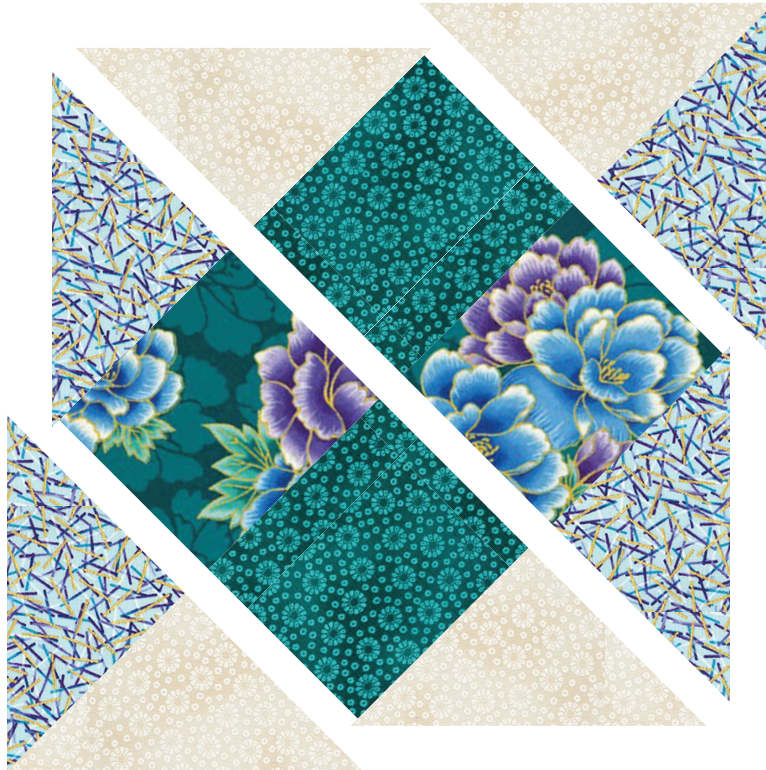
### **From Fabric I, cut:**

seven 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 6-1/2" x 50-1/2" top and bottom 4th borders

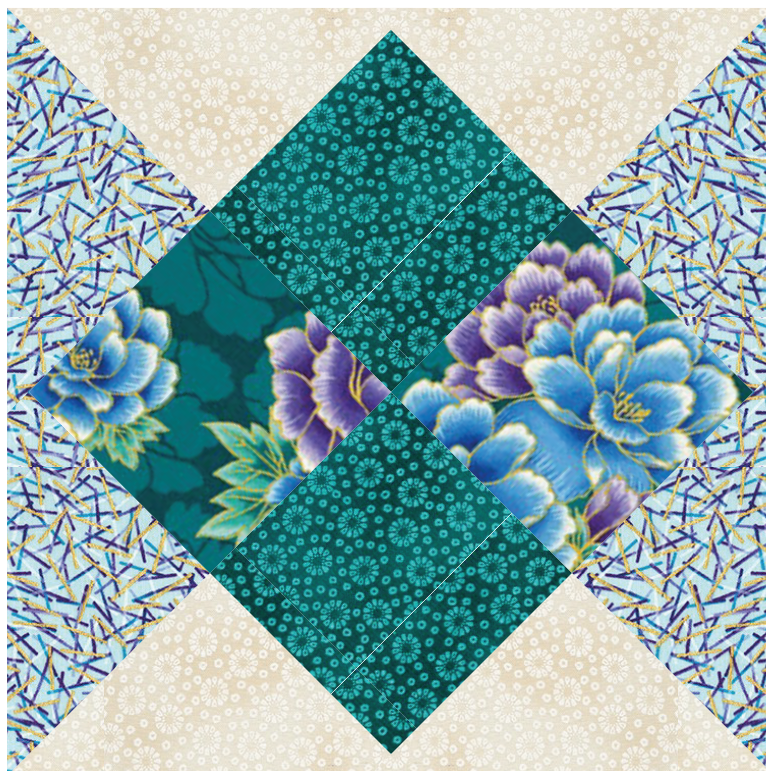
two 6-1/2" x 82-1/2" side 4th borders

## Assemble the Pieced Blocks



**Step 1:** Arrange two Fabric C squares, two Fabric D squares, four Fabric E triangles and four Fabric F triangles, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together to form four diagonal rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions in alternating rows.

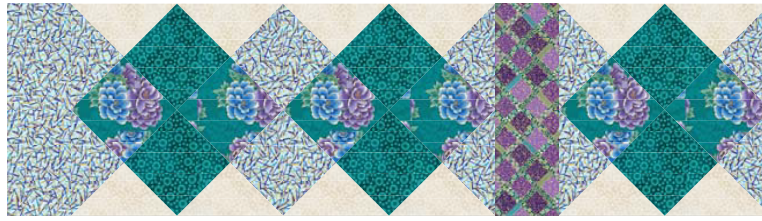
*Tip: Align the right angle of each triangle with the corner of any adjacent squares. Tips of the triangles will extend beyond the square at the opposite end of the seam.*



**Step 2:** Trim the block to 10-1/2" square, if necessary. Repeat to make seven blocks.



## Assemble the Quilt Center



**Step 3:** Sew the 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" Fabric B panel borders to the top and bottom of the panel. Press toward the borders. Sew the 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" Fabric B panel borders to the sides of the panel. Press toward the borders.

**Step 4:** Gather four completed blocks and one 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle each of Fabric B and Fabric F. Arrange to form a column, following the Quilt Center Diagram. Note the fabric placement and block orientation of the pieced blocks. Press the seams to one side.

**Step 5:** Gather three completed blocks and one 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle each of Fabric B and Fabric E. Arrange to form a row, following the Quilt Center Diagram. Note the fabric placement and block orientation of the pieced blocks. Press the seams to one side.

**Step 6:** Sew the completed Step 4 unit to the right edge of the panel. Press the seam toward the panel. Sew the completed Step 5 unit to the top of the quilt center. Press the seam down toward the panel. The quilt center should measure 36-1/2" x 56-1/2".



## Add the Borders



**Step 7:** Sew the Fabric G 1st borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric G 1st borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 8:** Sew the Fabric H 2nd borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric H 2nd borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 9:** Sew the Fabric B 3rd borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B 3rd borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 10:** Sew the Fabric I 4th borders to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric I 4th borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!







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



