Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

one 21-1/2" x 37-1/2" center panel

From Fabric B, cut:

three 7-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then cut:

two 7-1/2" x 48-1/2" side border 3 pieces

six 6-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, in two sets of three then cut:

two 6-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom border 3 pieces

two 6-1/2" x 66-1/2" top/bottom border 4 pieces

two 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 5-1/2" squares. Cut each in half along both diagonals.

Trim the remainder of the second strip to 5" x WOF. Subcut:

two 5" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal.

four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 3" x 39-1/2" top/bottom border 2 pieces

two 3" x 28-1/2" side border 2 pieces

From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty-four 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

eleven 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 37-1/2" top/bottom border 1 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 23-1/2" side border 1 pieces

Sew the remaining seven strips together, end-to-end, then cut:

four 1-1/2" x 66-1/2" pieced border strips

From Fabric F, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:


twenty 5" squares. Cut each in half along one diagonal.

one 5-1/2" square. Cut in half along both diagonals.

From Fabric G, cut:

three 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 5-1/2" squares. With the stripes placed vertically these triangles on the cutting surface, cut each in half along both diagonal. Keep all small triangles from the left and right edge. Keep only two small triangles from the top or bottom edges of a square (set aside for Steps 5 and 7) and discard the rest of this type.




one 5" square. With the stripes placed vertically on the cutting surface, cut along one diagonal from upper left to lower right. Discard one triangle.

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt Panel Center



Step 1: Sew the top and bottom border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 2: Sew the top and bottom border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Assemble the Ribbon Border



Step 3: Gather: one large Fabric F triangle one small Fabric B triangle one small Fabric G triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.

Repeat to make thirty-four units like this.



Step 4: Gather: one large Fabric F triangle one small Fabric B triangle one small Fabric F triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.



Step 5: Gather: one large Fabric B triangle one small Fabric G triangle - from the two small triangles set aside in the cutting one small Fabric F triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.



Step 6: Gather: one large Fabric B triangle one small Fabric G triangle one small Fabric F triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.



Step 7: Gather: one large Fabric F triangle one small Fabric G triangle - from the two small triangles set aside in the cutting one small Fabric B triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.



Step 8: Gather: one large Fabric B triangle one small Fabric G triangle one small Fabric F triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two smaller triangles together and press. Sew the larger triangle to the pieced unit along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.



Step 9: Gather: one large Fabric B triangle one large Fabric G triangle

Arrange as shown, then sew the two triangles together along the longest edge. Press. Trim to 4-1/2" square, centering the diagonal on the unit, if needed.

Step 10: Gather: the Step 4 unit ten Step 3 units

Sew together, as shown, and press. Sew to the top edge of the quilt center.

Step 11: Gather: eleven Step 3 units

Sew together, as shown, and press. Sew to the bottom edge of the quilt center.

Step 12: Gather: the Step 8 unit the Step 9 unit seven Step 3 units



Sew together, as shown, and press. Sew to the left edge of the guilt center.

Step 13: Gather: the Step 5 unit the Step 6 unit the Step 7 unit six Step 3 units

Sew together, as shown, and press. Sew to the right edge of the quilt center.

Assemble the Pieced Upper and Lower Borders

Step 14: Gather:

twenty-two Fabric C squares twenty-two Fabric D squares two 1-1/2" x 66-1/2" Fabric E strips

Arrange the squares to form two rows, alternating fabric colors. Sew the squares together to form a row, pressing the seams toward the darker fabric. Sew the rows together, pressing the seam to one side. Sew the Fabric E strips to the top and bottom edges of the border. Press toward the strips.



Repeat Step 14 to make a second border.



Step 15: Sew the top and bottom border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 16: Sew the pieced borders from Step 14 to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press.

Step 17: Sew the top and bottom border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
