

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

Color	Fabric	Name/SKU	Yardage	
	A	SRKF-15850-1 WHITE	2-1/2 yards	You will also need: curtain rod and five curtain clips
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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Cut a 85" long piece from Fabric A and trim off the selvages.

Assembly

Using a rolled hem foot**, sew around all four edges of the design wall, brining the raw edge to the wrong side of the design wall. At the corners, stop, clipping stitches. Press the next side to prepare it for sewing, folding the corner over from the previous edge. Begin sewing the next side, continuing this pattern for the remaining edges.

**A rolled hem foot is ideal for this project, but not necessary. Without a rolled hem foot, fold and press a 1/8-1/4" hem on all sides, then repeat. Remove some of the bulk from the corner, if desired. Sew next to the folded edge, around the entire design wall.

Space clips out evenly along the top edge of the design wall and hang on a curtain rod for an easy and movable space to lay out projects!
