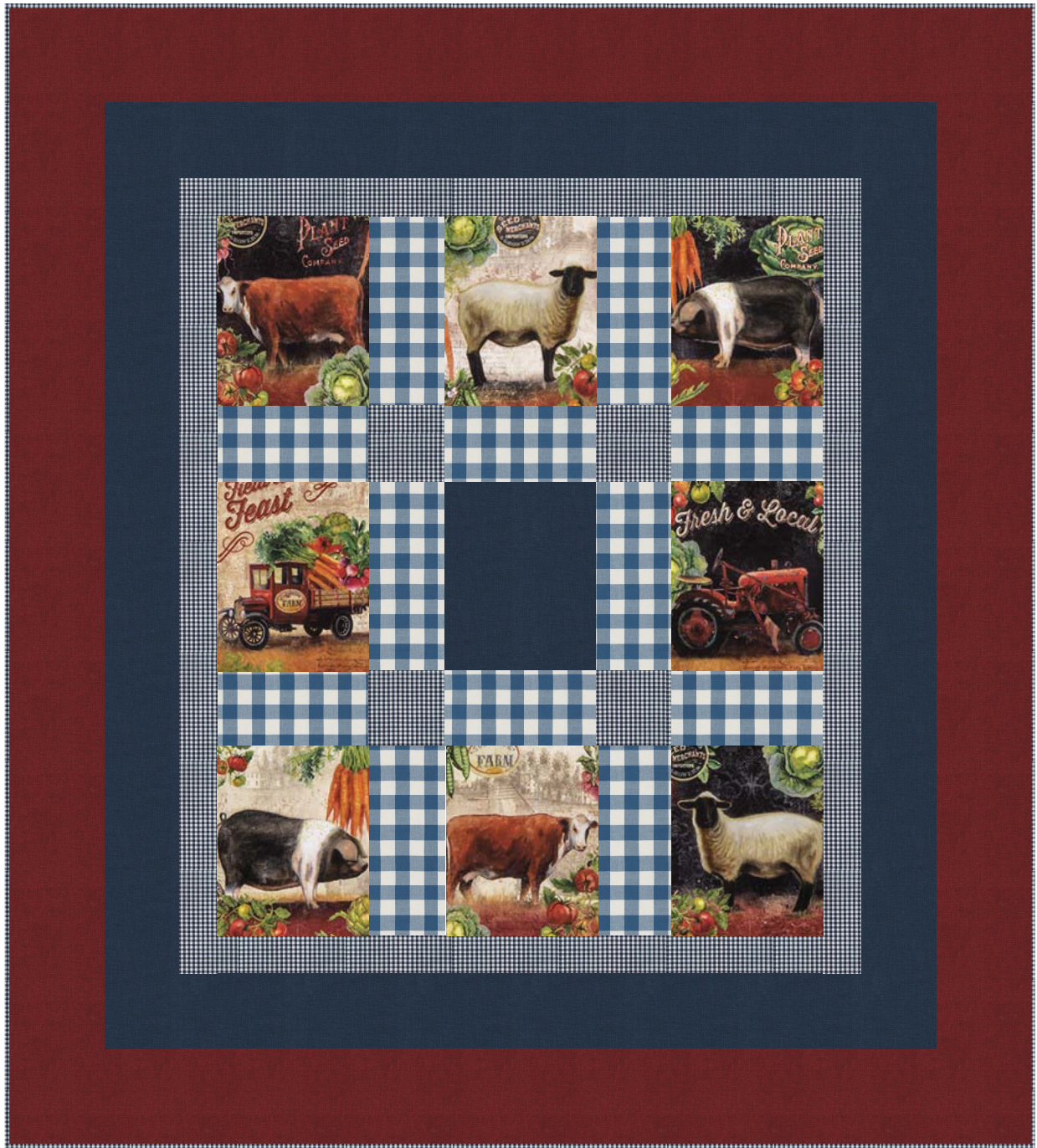

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 43" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 43" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles

### From Fabric B, cut:

five 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 4-1/2" x 36-1/2" top/bottom middle borders

two 4-1/2" x 50-1/2" side middle borders

one 8-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangle

**From Fabric C, cut:**

three 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
six 4-1/2" x 10-1/2" block sashing strips  
six 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" row sashings

**From Fabric D, cut:**

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
four 4-1/2" square cornerstones  
four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Trim to yield:  
two 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" top/bottom inner borders  
two 2-1/2" x 42-1/2" side inner borders

**From Fabric E, cut:**

six\* 5" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:  
two 5" x 44-1/2" top/bottom outer borders  
two 5" x 59-1/2" side outer borders

\*if selvages are trimmed sparingly, you may be able to cut these from five WOF strips.

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Quilt Center



**Step 1:** Arrange the Fabric A and B rectangles together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric C block sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

**Step 2:** Gather two Fabric D cornerstone squares and three Fabric C row sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make two sashing rows.

**Step 3:** Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

## Add the Borders



**Step 4:** Sew the Fabric D top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric D side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 5:** Sew the Fabric B top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric B side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 6:** Sew the Fabric E top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric E side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
