

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

four 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2-3/4" x 24-1/2" border strips

two 2-3/4" x 29" border strips

five 2-1/4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2-1/4" x 48" border strips

two 2-1/4" x 51-1/2" border strips

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" rectangles

sixty-four Template 3 pieces

sixty-four Template 4 pieces

forty-eight Template 11 pieces

forty-eight Template 11-Reversed pieces

four Template 7 pieces

four Template 7-Reversed pieces

From Fabric B, cut:

sixteen Template 1 pieces two Template 10 pieces one Template 9 piece

From Fabric C, cut:

sixteen Template 1 pieces two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric D, cut:

sixteen Template 1 pieces two Template 5 pieces two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric E, cut:

sixteen Template 1 pieces one Template 9 piece one Template 10 piece

From Fabric F, cut:

sixteen Template 2 pieces two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric G, cut:

sixteen Template 2 pieces six Template 5 pieces

From Fabric H, cut:

sixteen Template 2 pieces four 4-3/4" squares

From Fabric I, cut:

sixteen Template 2 pieces one Template 9 piece one Template 10 piece

From Fabric J, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric K, cut:

six Template 5 pieces two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric L, cut:

twelve Template 6 pieces one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric M, cut:

two Template 5 pieces one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric N, cut:

four Template 6 pieces one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric O, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric P, cut:

one Template 10 piece one Template 9 piece

From Fabric Q, cut:

one Template 9 piece one Template 10 piece four 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric R, cut:

one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric S, cut:

one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric T, cut:

one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric U, cut:

one Template 9 piece two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric V, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric W, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric X, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric Y, cut:

one Template 10 piece

From Fabric Z, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric AA, cut:

one Template 10 piece

From Fabric BB, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric CC, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric DD, cut:

two Template 10 pieces

From Fabric EE, cut:

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

four 3-1/2" x 51-1/2" border strips

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 3-1/2" x 66" border strips


two 3-1/2" x 72" border strips

twenty-four Template 9 pieces


From the binding, cut:

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Flower Blocks





Step 1: Sew a Fabric A, Template 3 piece to a Fabric B, Template 1 piece. Clip the seam allowance and press to one side. Repeat to make sixteen.



Step 2: Sew a Fabric A, Template 4 piece to a Fabric F, Template 2 piece. Clip the seam allowance and press to one side. Repeat to make sixteen.


Step 3: Pair a Step 1 piece with a Step 2 piece, as shown. Sew along the longest/angled edge and press the seam toward the darker fabric. Unit should measure 5-1/4" square. Repeat to make sixteen.





Step 4: Arrange four Step 3 units together to form the block. Sew the top blocks together and press the seam to the left. Sew the bottom blocks together and press the seam to the right. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and press the row seam open. Block should measure 10" square.


Step 5: Appliqué a Fabric G or K, Template 5 piece to the center of the block, using your preferred method.




Step 6: Appliqué a Fabric L, Template 6 piece to the center of the block, using your preferred method.


Repeat to make four completed blue blocks. Each block should measure 10" square.

Repeat Steps 1-6 to make four completed yellow blocks using Fabrics C and G. Use Fabric D or M for the Template 5 piece and Fabric N for the Template 6 piece.




Repeat Steps 1-6 to make four completed pink blocks using Fabrics D and H. Use Fabric G or K for the Template 5 piece and Fabric L for the Template 6 piece.





Repeat Steps 1-6 to make four completed purple blocks using Fabrics E and I. Use Fabric G or K for the Template 5 piece and Fabric L for the Template 6 piece.

Assemble the Center Triangle Blocks



Step 7: Gather:

six Fabric EE, Template 9 pieces


three Template 9 pieces: one each of Fabrics I, E and M

one Fabric A, Template 7 piece

one Fabric A, Template 7-Reversed piece

one Fabric A, Template 8 piece

Arrange following the Block Assembly Diagram, noting the fabric placement for the print triangles.




Step 8: Sew the Template 9 pieces together in rows, pressing seams in opposite directions for each row. Sew the rows together, forming the triangle shape.





Step 9: Sew the Template 7 and 7-Reversed pieces to the left and right edges of the completed Step 8 unit. Press toward the Fabric A pieces.


Step 10: Sew the Template 8 piece to the remaining edge of the completed Step 8 unit. Press toward the Fabric A piece. Block should measure 12-1/2" square.



Repeat Steps 7-10 to form a total of four Center Triangle Blocks. Follow the Block Assembly Diagrams for proper fabric placement within the block.








Assemble the Outer Border Triangles

Step 11: Sew a Fabric A, Template 11 and Template 11-Reversed piece to the sides of each Template 10 print triangle. Press toward the Fabric A sides. Repeat with all remaining prints cut from Template 10, for a total of forty-eight Outer Border Triangles.



Quilt Assembly Diagram


Step 12: Gather the four Center Triangle Blocks and sew into two rows of two. Press block seams in opposite directions and press the row seam open. Center unit should measure 24-1/2" square.


Step 13: Sew a 2-3/4" x 24-1/2" Fabric A strip to the left and right of the quilt center. Press toward the strip. Sew a 2-3/4" x 29" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strip.


- **Step 14:** Sew a purple flower block and a yellow flower block to opposite sides of a pink flower block. Press the seams to one side. Repeat. Referencing the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement, sew one to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the sashing.
- **Step 15:** Sew five flower blocks together in this order: blue, yellow, pink, purple, blue. Press the seams to one side. Repeat. Referencing the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement, sew one to each side of the quilt center. Press toward the sashing.
- **Step 16:** Sew a 2-1/4" x 48" Fabric A strip to the left and right of the quilt center. Press toward the strip. Sew a 2-1/4" x 51-1/2" Fabric A strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strip.
- **Step 17:** Sew a 3-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric EE strip to the left and right of the quilt center. Press toward the outer strip. Sew a 3-1/2" Fabric Q square to each end of a 3-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric EE strip. Press toward the strip. Repeat. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strip.
- **Step 18:** Sew twelve blue Outer Border Triangles to form a border, following the fabric placement in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press the seams in one direction. Sew a 3-1/2" x 4-3/4" Fabric A rectangle to each end of the border. Repeat to form the yellow, pink and purple Outer Borders.
- **Step 19:** Sew the purple and yellow Outer Borders to the sides of the quilt center, noting the orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the quilt center. Sew a 4-3/4" Fabric H square to each end of the blue and pink Outer Borders. Press toward the square. Sew to the top and bottom of the quilt center noting the orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press toward the quilt center.
- **Step 20:** Sew a 3-1/2" x 66" Fabric EE strip to the left and right of the quilt center. Press toward the strip. Sew a 3-1/2" x 72" Fabric EE strip to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the strip.


Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

Print at 100%. Tape sections of templates together where indicated.
