Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.



Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

four 4" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: thirty-six 4" squares for the HSTs

- seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 44-1/2" top/bottom outer borders two 3-1/2" x 38-1/2" side outer borders thirty-six 3-1/2" squares four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:
 - two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" row sashing strips six 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" block sashing strips

From each of Fabrics B-J, cut:

one 6-1/2" square

From each of Fabrics K-S, cut:

four 4" squares

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Step 1: Pair a 4" Fabric A square with a 4" Fabric K square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make eight A/K HSTs.



Step 2: Repeat the process in Step 1 to make:



Assemble the Blocks



Step 3: Gather: four 3-1/2" Fabric A squares eight A/K HSTs the Fabric B square

Arrange the units as shown. Sew the HSTs together in pairs. Press.

Arrange the units into three rows of three. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together to form three rows. Press the seams away from the HST pairs.

Step 4: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block. Press.

Repeat Steps 3 and 4 to make the remaining eight blocks, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 5: Arrange the Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using sashing strips between each block. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make three block rows.

Step 6: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Step 7: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
