

# Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From **Fabric A**, cut:

Use 1/2 yard and template to cut seventy-two of Template B (shape B)

#### five 2-1/2''x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-1/2" squares (shape C)

#### three 2-7/8'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty-six 2-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield seventy-two half square triangles (shape D)

### five 4-7/8'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty-six 4-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield seventy-two half square triangles (shape G)

#### From **Fabric B**, cut:

nine 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- one hundred forty-four 2-1/2" squares (shape C)

#### six strips 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield one hundred forty-four half square triangles (shape D)

#### From **Fabric C**, cut:

one 4-3/16" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- nine 4-3/16'' squares. Cut diagonally twice to yield thirty-six quarter square triangles (shape E)

# four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty-six 4-1/2" squares (shape F)

#### From **Fabric D**, cut:

five 2-1/2'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-1/2'' squares (shape C)

#### From **Fabric E**, cut:

five 2-1/2'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-1/2" squares (shape C)

#### From **Fabric F**, cut:

two 2-7/8'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- twenty-four 2-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield forty-eight half square triangles (shape D)

#### four 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty-six 4-1/2'' squares (shape F)

#### From **Fabric G**, cut:

five 2-1/2'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-1/2" squares (shape C)

#### From **Fabric H**, cut:

two 3-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- eighteen 3-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield thirty-six half square triangles (shape A)

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- seventy-two 2-1/2'' squares (shape C)

four strips 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

- forty-eight 2-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield ninety-six half square triangles (shape D)

#### From **Fabric I**, cut:

\*\* For Sunflower Colorstory, use the remaining Fabric B here.


three 2-7/8'' x WOF strips. Subcut:

- thirty-six 2-7/8'' squares. Cut diagonally once to yield seventy-two half square triangles (shape D)

one 4-3/16" x WOF strip. Subcut:

- nine 4-3/16'' squares. Cut diagonally twice to yield thirty-six quarter square triangles (shape E)

From **Binding fabric**, cut: eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## The Blocks

The quilt is made of 8 different blocks. Make the number of each block as follows:



Block 1 – make 2



Block 2 – make 4



Block 3 – make 4



Block 4 – make 8







Block 6 - make 4




Block 7 - make 4



Block 8 - make 8

## Assembly:


To construct each block, divide the block in quarters.



Make the upper left quarter as follows:

Sew each D to each C as indicated. Sew each of these units to

the corresponding side of F.



Sew A to B and then sew this unit to remainder of block.




# Make the upper right quarter and lower left quarter as follows:

Sew the corner D to its adjacent D to form a square. Trim to 2-1/2", if needed. Sew the other two D pieces to the square as shown. Sew G to this unit. Trim to 4-1/2", if needed.




Sew the two C pieces along the bottom edge to each other and then sew them to the large pieced square.



Sew the three C pieces along the side edge to each other as indicated and then sew this unit to the remainder of the block.



## Make the lower right quarter as follows:




Sew each D to each C as indicated. Sew each of these units to the corresponding side of F.

Sew the two E pieces to each other. Sew the combined E piece to B and then sew this unit to the remainder of the block.

Sew the upper left quarter to the upper right quarter to form the top half of the block.

Sew the lower left quarter to the lower right quarter to form the bottom half of the block.

Sew the top half to the bottom half.



# Assemble the Quilt

Use the following chart to place the individual block styles. Example: 1 means Block 1.

1	6	3	6	3	5
7	4	8	4	8	2
2	8	4	8	4	7
7	4	8	4	8	2
2	8	4	8	4	7
5	3	6	3	6	1



Referencing the Block Placement Chart and the Quilt Assembly Diagram, arrange the blocks into six rows of six blocks, each.

Press block seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows.

Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
