

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabrics A, B, C & F

- Cut six strips 3-7/8" x WOF. Subcut each strip into ten squares 3-7/8" x 3-7/8" (fifty-four total).

Fabric D

- Cut four squares 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"
- Cut four rectangles 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Fabric E

- Cut four rectangles 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"
- Cut four squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"

Fabric G

- Cut nine squares 6-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Fabric H

- Cut twenty-four squares 3-1/2" x 3-1/2"
- Cut twenty-four rectangles 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Fabric I

- Cut thirty-six rectangles 3-1/2" x 6-1/2"

Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Make Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Pair fabrics as follows to make HSTs:
 Fabric A with Fabric C
 Fabric B with Fabric F

- Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on an A square and lay it right sides together with a C square (figure 1).
- Sew 1/4" from each side of the drawn line and then cut along drawn line (figure 2)
- Press seams open and then trim HST down to 3-1/2" (figure 3).
- Repeat steps for all A/C squares and all B/F squares.

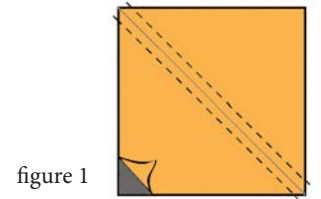

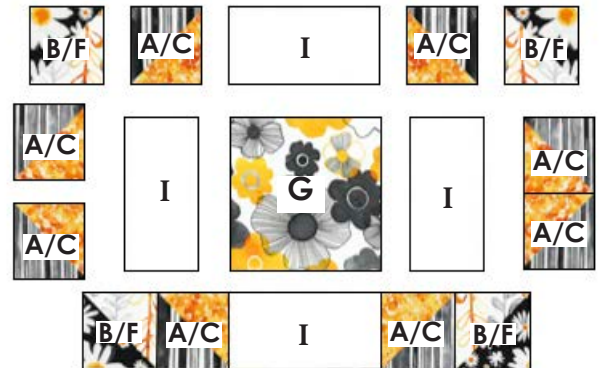


Step 2: Make Blocks

You will be making five different blocks. Blocks 1 and 2 are whole blocks, Blocks 3 and 4 are half blocks and Block 5 is a quarter block.

Block 1:

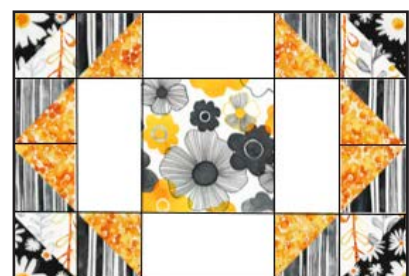
- Sew HSTs and pieces together into rows and then sew rows together to complete block .
- Make nine blocks.



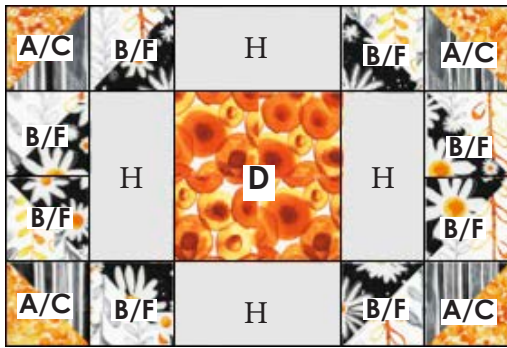
1. Lay pieces out according to diagram.



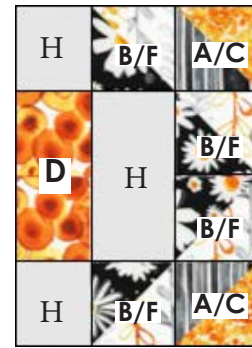
2. Sew together into rows.



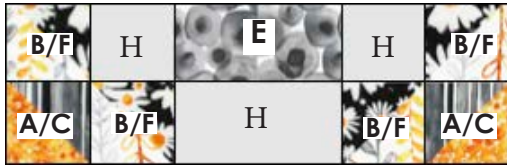
3. Sew rows together to complete block.



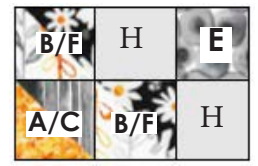
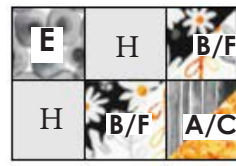
Block 2: Make four.

Block 5: Make four (two facing one way and two facing the opposite way.)

Step 3: Assemble Quilt

- Lay the blocks out according to the assembly diagram and then sew blocks into rows.
- Sew rows together to complete the quilt top.
- Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

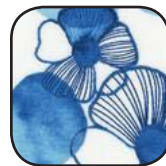

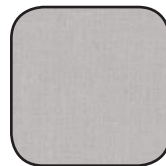

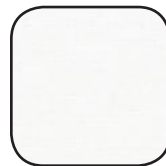
