

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A and B, cut:

two 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
six 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric C, cut:

seven 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighty 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric F, cut:

four 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty 3-1/2" squares

From Fabric G, cut:

twelve 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
forty-eight 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips

From Fabric H, cut:

seven 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Fussy cut:
thirty-one 5" x 9-1/2" rectangles. You will be able to center five fussy cut pieces per WOF,
using every other row of flowers.

From Fabric I, cut:

four 2-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fourteen 2-3/4" x 9-1/2" strips

From Fabric J, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 1-1/2" x 63-1/2" top/bottom inner borders
two 1-1/2" x 83-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric K, cut:

eight 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 3-1/2" x 65-1/2" top/bottom middle borders
two 3-1/2" x 89-1/2" side middle borders

From Fabric L, fussy cut:

five 5" x length of strips, centering the flower print along the strip. You will use every other row of flowers. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:
two 5" x 84" top/bottom outer borders
two 5" x 102" side middle borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

ten 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

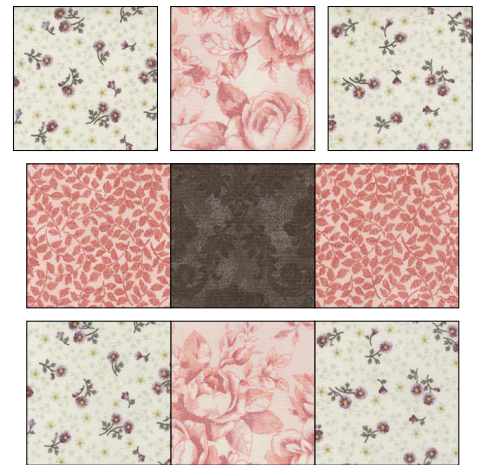
Assemble the A Blocks (Nine Patch Blocks)

Step 1: Gather:

- four Fabric C squares
- two Fabric D squares
- one Fabric E square
- two Fabric F squares

Arrange in three rows of three, as shown. Sew the squares together to form rows, pressing the seams toward the B and C squares. Sew the rows together to form the Nine Patch block, pressing the rows seams open or to one side.

The block should measure 9-1/2" square. Repeat to make twenty A Blocks.



Assemble the B and C Blocks (Strip Blocks)

Step 2: Gather:

- one Fabric G strip
- one Fabric H rectangle
- one Fabric I strip

Sew together, as shown, pressing the seam away from the center rectangle. The block should measure 9-1/2" square. Repeat to make fourteen B Blocks.



Step 3: Gather
two Fabric G strips
one Fabric H rectangle

Sew together, as shown, pressing the seam away from the center rectangle. The block should measure 9-1/2" square. Repeat to make seventeen C Blocks.



Assemble the Quilt Center



Step 4: Arrange the Fabric A squares, Fabric B squares, A Blocks, B Blocks and C Blocks together to form nine rows of seven, as shown. Note the placement and orientation of the Blocks.

Step 5: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

Step 6: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Add the Borders



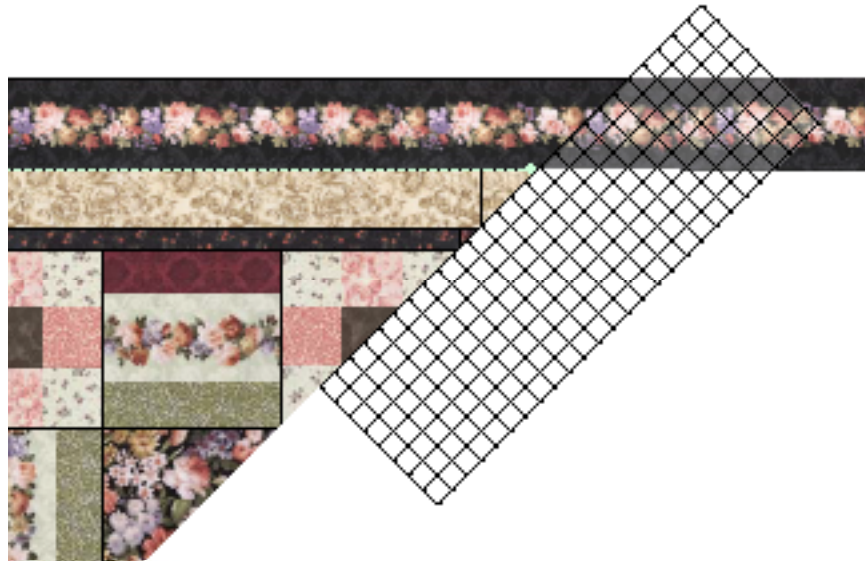
Step 7: Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the top and bottom middle borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side middle borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 9: Center and pin one side outer border to the quilt top. Sew the border, starting and stopping 1/4" from each end of the quilt top. Repeat with the remaining side outer border. Repeat with the top and bottom borders. Note: borders will extend beyond the quilt's edge.

Step 10: Fold the quilt diagonally, right sides together and align two of the borders directly on top of each other.

Use your ruler to draw a line from the corner of the quilt to the edge of the border.



Step 11: Sew along this marked line, beginning at the point where your border stitching had ended and sew to the edge of the border. Check to be sure the mitered border presses flat from the front, then trim 1/4" away from the marked line, removing the excess border length.



Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!










