

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-R, cut:

From Fabric S, cut:

fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew seven strips together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 68-3/4" side outer borders

two 2-1/2" x 57-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From the remaining eight strips, cut:

two hundred eighteen 2-1/2" x 1-1/2" sashing pieces

twenty-eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

seventeen 1-1/2" x 68-3/4" column sashing strips

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Columns

Step 1: Arrange Column 1 by sewing the 2-1/2" x 5" print rectangles in the following order, sewing a Fabric S sashing piece between each one: A-B-C-D-E-F-G-H-I-J-K-L

Complete the column with a sashing piece and a 2-1/2" x 2-3/4" Fabric M piece.

Press all seams toward the sashings.

Step 2: Arrange Columns 2-18 as you did in Step 1, referring to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement.



Step 3: Sew Columns 1-18 together, using a Fabric S sashing strip between each one. Tip: To aid in the piecing of this, sew a sashing strip to a column and press toward the sashing. Gradually grow the quilt top by sewing pairs of columns together, as shown.

Step 4: Sew the side outer borders to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt. Press.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
