

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

two 12-1/2" x 42-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

five 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 5" squares. Cut each square in half once along the diagonal.

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim to yield:

two 2-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom borders

two 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" side borders

From Fabric C, cut:

two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 1-1/2" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

twelve 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred-eighty 2-1/2" squares.

From each of Fabrics E-H, cut:

two 6-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 6-1/4" squares.

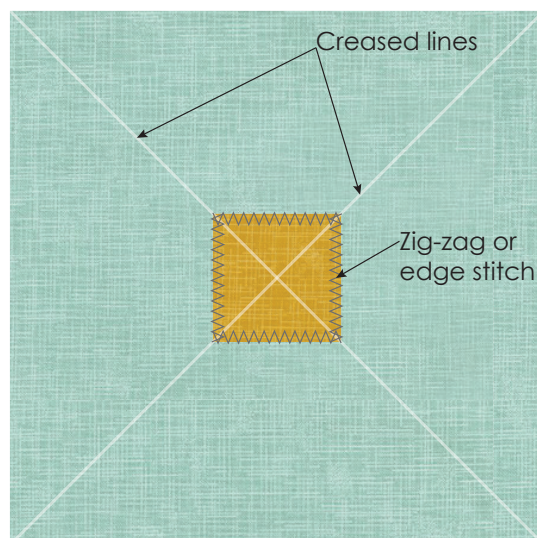
From Fabric E (the binding), cut:

six 2-1/4" x WOF strips.

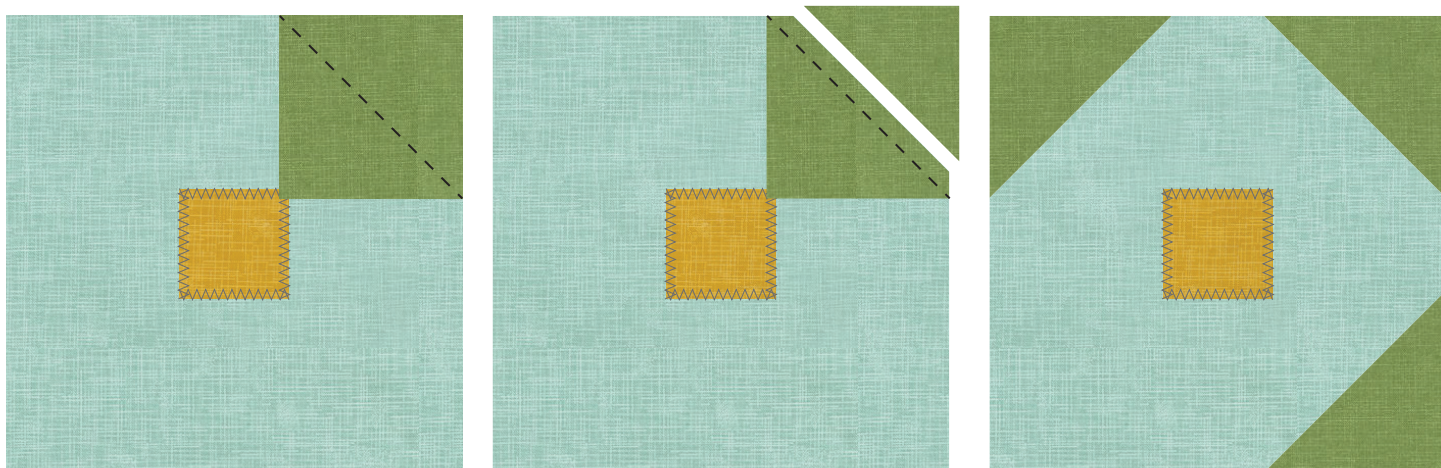
Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Gather the Fabric E-H squares and the Fabric C squares. Fold and press each square in half along both diagonals to mark creases at the center point.

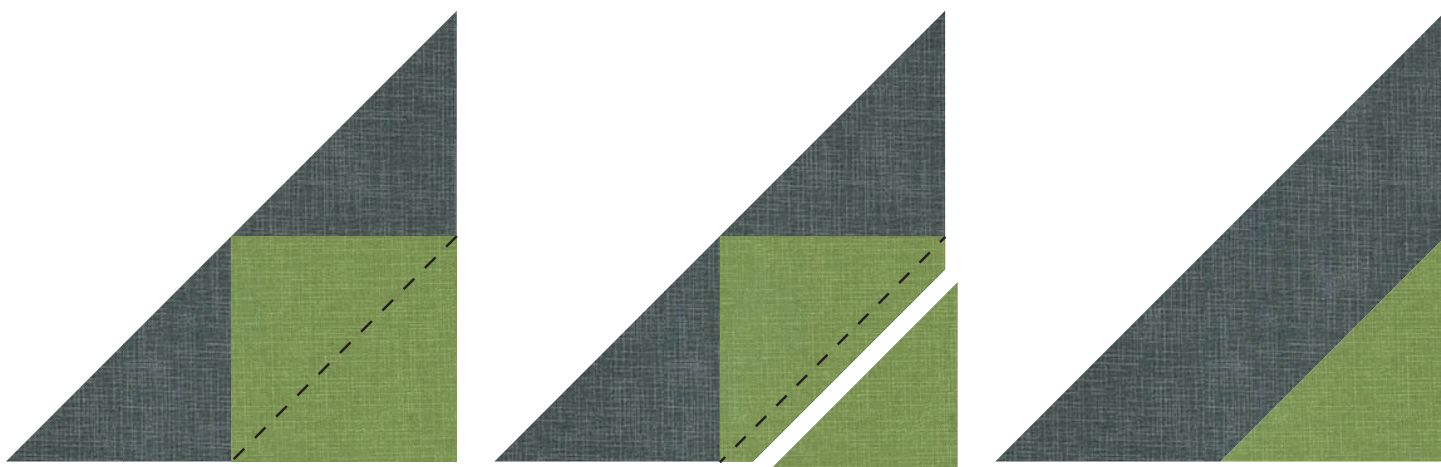
Step 2: Place a Fabric C square in the center of each Fabric E-H square, aligning the creases to place them precisely. Using an edge-stitch or small zig-zag stitch, appliqué the center squares to the larger squares. Repeat for all thirty-six E-H squares.



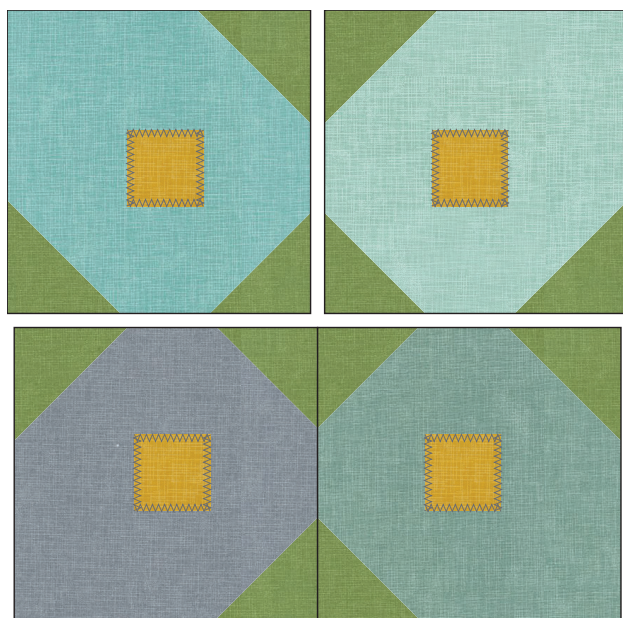
Step 3: Place a Fabric D square at one corner of a Fabric E square. Sew along the diagonal as shown, marking the diagonal prior to sewing if necessary. Trim away the excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seam toward the corner. Repeat for two more corners of the Fabric E square, leaving one corner without a stitch-and-flip triangle. Repeat for all remaining Fabric E-H squares.



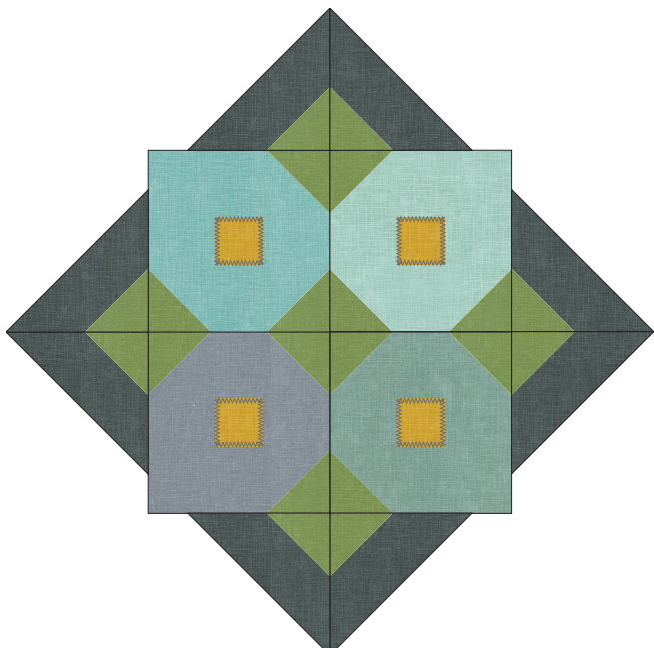
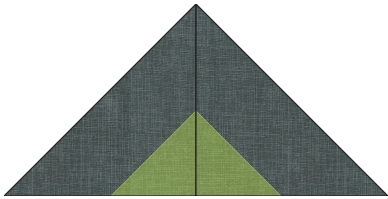
Step 4: Place a Fabric D square at one corner of a Fabric B triangle. Sew along the diagonal as shown, just as you did in Step 3. Repeat for all remaining Fabric B triangles.



Step 5: Gather: eight Fabric B triangles and one square each from Fabrics E-H. Arrange following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the squares together in two rows of two, then together to form the block center. Press.

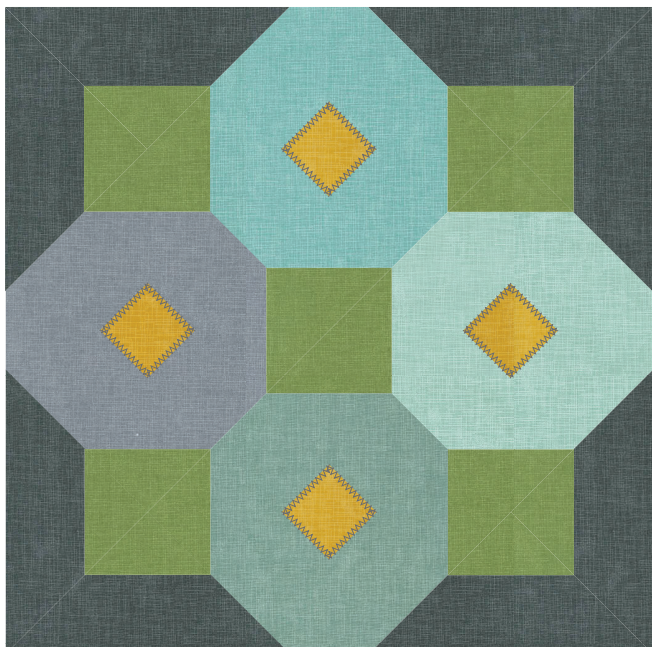


Step 6: Sew the Fabric B triangles together in pairs, as shown. Repeat for all Fabric B triangles.



Step 7: Place an assembled Step 6 unit on one edge of an assembled block center from Step 5. Center and align the seams of the Fabric D triangles. Sew together and press away from the block center. Repeat for the three remaining edges of the block center.

Step 8: Trim the excess from the points of the E-H squares to leave a 14-1/2" square. Repeat to create nine blocks.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 9: Arrange the blocks into three rows of three blocks, with a Fabric A panel between each row. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

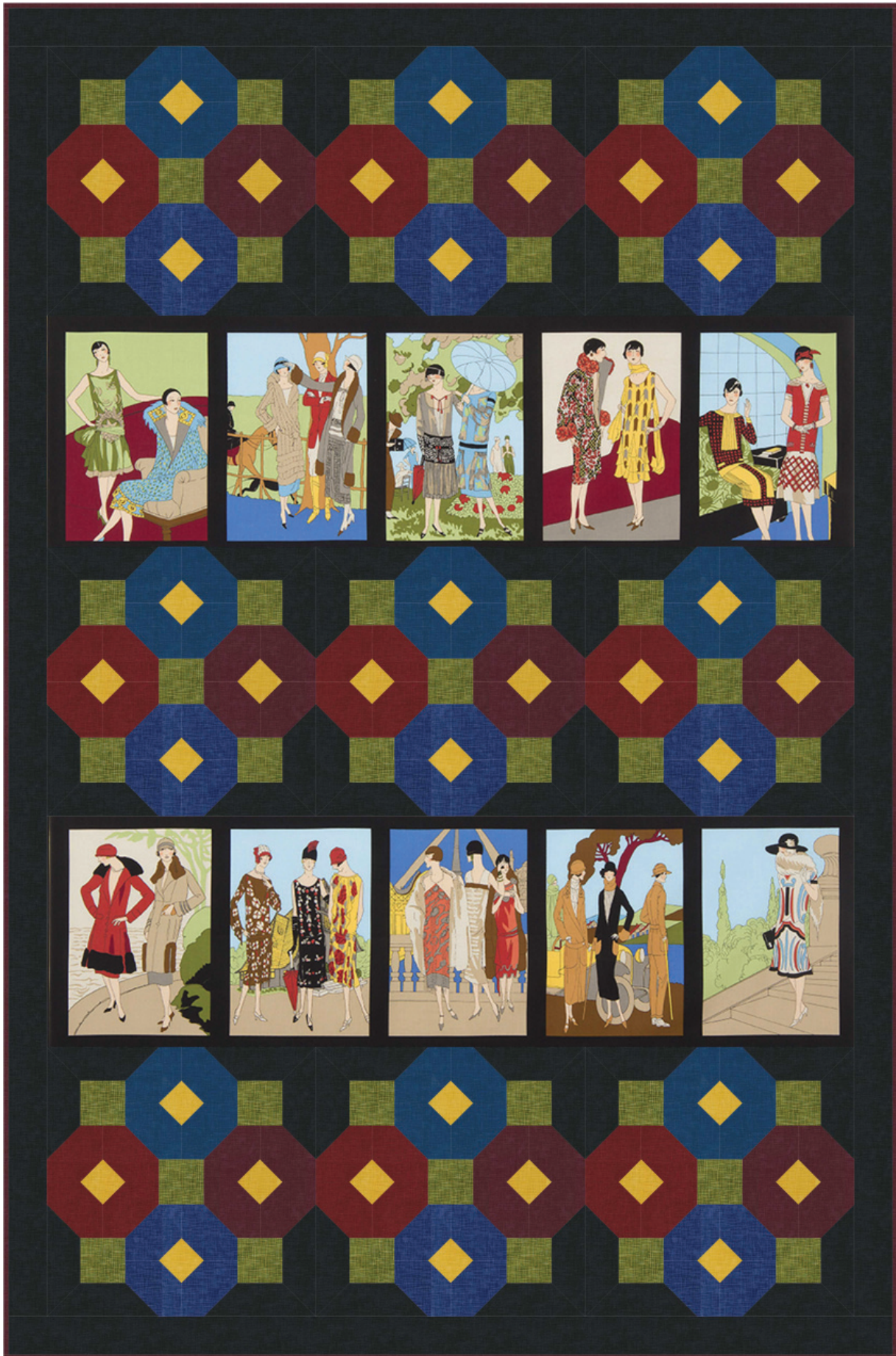
Step 10: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams open or to one side.

Step 11: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open or to one side.

Step 12: Sew the side borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is now complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!









