

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
four 3" squares for the Center Square HSTs

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

one 4-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Border 13  
Trim the remainder of the strip to 3" x WOF. Subcut:  
four 3" squares for the Center Square HSTs

### **From Fabric C, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
twelve 3" squares for the Center Square HSTs

### **From Fabric D, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
twelve 3" squares for the Center Square HSTs  
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

### **From Fabric E, cut:**

six 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end, then trim:  
two 3-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom Border 11 pieces  
two 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" side Border 11 pieces  
three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
thirty-six 3" squares for the Border 7 HSTs  
two 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
two 2-1/2" x 16-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces  
two 2-1/2" x 20-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

four 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
forty-eight 3" squares for the Border 10 HSTs  
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13  
four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
ninety-six 1-1/2" squares for the Border 3 pieces

**From Fabric G, cut:**

four 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" top/bottom Border 4 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 26-1/2" side Border 4 pieces

**From Fabric H, cut:**

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" top/bottom Border 5 pieces

two 2-1/2" x 32-1/2" side Border 5 pieces

eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

**From Fabric I, cut:**

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 3" squares for the Border 7 HSTs

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom Border 8 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 40-1/2" side Border 8 pieces

ninety-six 1-1/2" squares for the Border 3 pieces

**From Fabric J, cut:**

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end to end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 40-1/2" top/bottom Border 9 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" side Border 9 pieces

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

**From Fabric K, cut:**

one 3-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

six 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3" squares for the Center Square HSTs

forty-eight 3" squares for the Border 10 HSTs

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

sixteen 2-1/2" squares for the Center Square

**From Fabric L, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

**From Fabric M, cut:**

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 3-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

four 3-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

two 1-1/2" x 34-1/2" top/bottom Border 6 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 32-1/2" side Border 6 pieces

Sew the remaining strips together, end to end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 56-1/2" top/bottom Border 12 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" side Border 12 pieces



**From Fabric N, cut:**

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 3-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

**From Fabric O, cut:**

one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13  
two 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:  
two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces  
two 1-1/2" x 22-1/2" side Border 2 pieces  
Tip: Cut one of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

**From Fabric P, cut:**

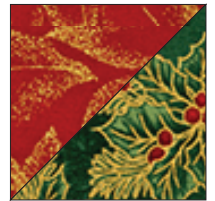
one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:  
eight 2-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for Border 13

**From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

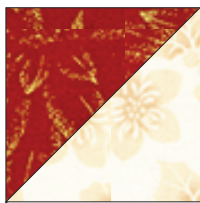
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

## Assemble the Center Square

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make four A/B HSTs.



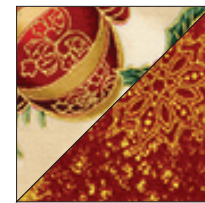
**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



four A/K HSTs



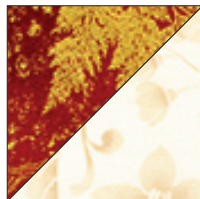
four B/K HSTs



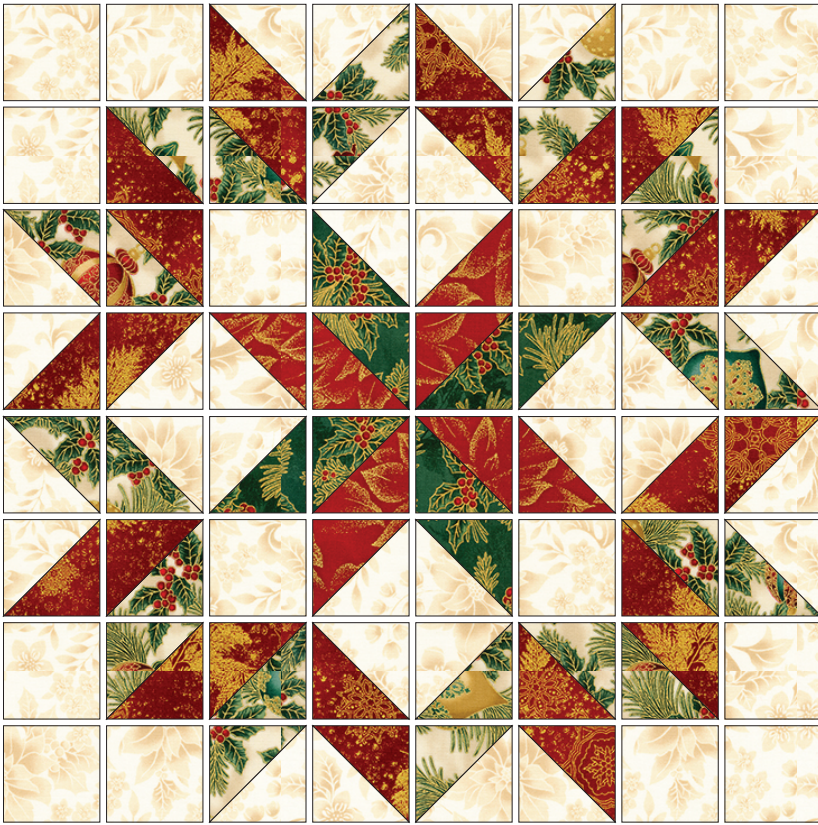
twelve C/D HSTs



twelve C/K HSTs



twelve D/K HSTs



**Step 3:** Arrange the HSTs and sixteen 2-1/2" Fabric K squares into eight rows of eight. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew the units together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows. Sew the rows together to form the Center Square. Press the row seams open. The Center Square should measure 16-1/2" square.

### Add Border 1

**Step 4:** Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

### Add Border 2

**Step 5:** Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

### Add Border 3

**Step 6:** Sew two 1-1/2" Fabric I squares and two 1-1/2" Fabric F squares together to form a 2-1/2" square four-patch. Press the seams toward the darker fabric and press the row seams open. Make forty-eight four-patch blocks.



**Step 7:** Sew eleven four-patch units together, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the left and right Border 3 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.

**Step 8:** Sew thirteen four-patch units together, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the top and bottom Border 3 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.





### Add Border 4

**Step 9:** Sew the side Border 4 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 4 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

### Add Border 5

**Step 10:** Sew the top and bottom Border 5 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 5 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.



## Add Border 6

**Step 11:** Sew the side Border 6 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 6 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

## Add Border 7

**Step 12:** Repeat the process from Step 1, using 3" Fabric E and Fabric I squares to make seventy-two 2-1/2" E/I HSTs.



**Step 13:** Sew seventeen HSTs together, following the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the left and right Border 7 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.

**Step 14:** Sew nineteen HSTs together, following the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the top and bottom Border 7 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.

## Add Border 8

**Step 15:** Sew the top and bottom Border 8 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 8 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

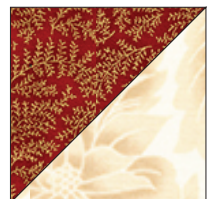
## Add Border 9

**Step 16:** Sew the top and bottom Border 9 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 9 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

## Add Border 10

**Step 17:** Repeat the process from Step 1, using 3" Fabric F and Fabric K squares to make ninety-six 2-1/2" F/K HSTs.

**Step 18:** Sew twenty-three HSTs together, following the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the left and right Border 10 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.



**Step 19:** Sew twenty-five HSTs together, following the orientation shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, to make the top and bottom Border 10 pieces. Sew to the quilt center and press.

## Add Border 11

**Step 20:** Sew the top and bottom Border 11 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 11 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

## Add Border 12

**Step 21:** Sew the top and bottom Border 12 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 12 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

## Add Border 13

**Step 22:** Gather and arrange the 3-1/2" tall rectangles, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement and piece size. Sew together to form the side Border 13 pieces. Repeat for the top and bottom Border 13 units. Sew to the quilt and press.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
