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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 10" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

two 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, for a total of sixty-four small triangles

fifteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew nine strips together end-to-end, then trim:

five 2-1/2" x 49-1/2" row sashing strips

two 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" side sashing strips

From the remaining six strips, subcut:

thirty-two 2-1/2" squares

twelve 2-1/2" x 12" block sashing strips

four 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" strips

From Fabric C, cut:

ten 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 1-1/2" x 10" strips

sixteen 1-1/2" x 12" strips

From Fabric D, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3" squares for the HSTs

two 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 2-7/8" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal, for a total of thirty-two large triangles

From Fabric E. cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3" squares for the HSTs

two 2-7/8" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 2-7/8" squares. Cut each square in half along one diagonal, for a total of thirty-two large triangles

From Fabric F, cut:

two 3-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 3-1/4" squares. Cut each square in half along both diagonals, for a total of sixty-four small triangles

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

two 1-1/2" x 58-1/2" side inner borders

From Fabric G, cut:

eight 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

sixteen 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips

sixteen 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

From Fabric H. cut:

six 6" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end, then trim: two 6" x 55-1/2" top/bottom inner borders two 6" x 69-1/2" side inner borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips


Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric D square with a 3" Fabric E square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make thirty-two D/E HSTs.



Assemble the Half Quarter-Square Triangles (H-QSTs)

Step 2: Arrange one Fabric F small triangle and one Fabric B small triangle to form a pair, taking care to orient the fabric as shown in the example here. Sew together and press toward the darker fabric.





Step 3: Sew one Fabric D large triangle the long edge of the pair from the previous step. Press toward the large triangle. Trim to 2-1/2".



Repeat Steps 2 and 3 to make the following H-QSTs, noting the different fabric placements:

Assemble Block 1



Step 4: Sew a 1-1/2" x 10" Fabric C strip to the top and bottom of a Fabric A square. Press toward the strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 12" Fabric C strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strip.

The resulting block should measure 12" square. Repeat to make eight Block 1 units.

Assemble Block 2



Step 5: Gather: four 2-1/2" Fabric B squares four D/E HSTs

four Fabric E H-QSTs (noting the placement of the Fabric B and F pieces in the diagram)

four Fabric D H-QSTs (noting the placement of the Fabric B and F pieces in the diagram)

Arrange the units into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

Step 6: Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

Step 7: Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block center.

Step 8: Sew a 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press toward the strip. Sew a 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric G strip to the left and right edges of the block. Press toward the strip. Sew a 1-1/4" x 10-1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the block. Press toward the strip.

The resulting block should measure 10-1/2" x 12". Repeat to make four Block 2 units like this.

Step 9: Make four Block 2 units, as shown, noting the differences in the H-QSTs from the previous Block 2 units.



Assemble the Quilt



Step 10: Arrange the Block 1 and Block 2 units together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

- Step 11: Sew the sashing and block rows together. Press seams open or to the sashing.
- **Step 12:** Sew a Fabric B row sashing strip to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center. Press. Sew a Fabric B side sashing strip to the left and right edges of the quilt center. Press.
- **Step 13:** Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.
- **Step 14:** Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
