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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

nine 7" x 11" rectangles

From Fabric B, cut:

two 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/4" x 7" top/bottom block borders

four 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" side block borders

Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

From Fabric C, cut:

two 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/4" x 7" top/bottom block borders

four 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" side block borders

Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

two 4" squares

From Fabric D, cut:

two 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/4" x 7" top/bottom block borders

four 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" side block borders

Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

four 4" squares

From Fabric E, cut:

two 1-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-1/4" x 7" top/bottom block borders

four 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" side block borders

Tip: Cut two of each length from each WOF strip in order to maximize yardage.

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:

three 4" sauares

From Fabric F, cut:

one 1-1/4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 1-1/4" x 7" top/bottom block borders
two 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" side block borders
one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut:
five 4" squares

From Fabric G, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: two 2-1/2" x 24-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces two 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

From Fabric H, cut:

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 2-1/2" x 28-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces two 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" side Border 2 pieces

From Fabric I, cut:

two 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: four 4" x 4-1/2" rectangles twenty-six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric J, L-N, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 4" squares

From Fabric K and O, cut:

one 4" x WOF strip. Subcut: three 4" squares

From Fabric P, cut:

five 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3-1/2" x 39-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces two 3-1/2" x 57-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Blocks

Step 1: Sew a 7" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of a Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the strips. Sew a 12-1/2" Fabric B strip to the sides of a Fabric A rectangle. Press toward the strips. The block should measure 8-1/2" x 12-1/2".

Repeat to make a total of nine blocks, using Fabrics B-F for the block borders. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric pairings, if desired.



Assemble the Pieced Border

Step 2: Gather eight of the 4" squares and eight of the 2-1/2" x 4" Fabric I rectangles. Sew together, alternating squares and rectangles to form the left pieced border. Use the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific fabrics for the squares, or select fabrics at random. Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make the right pieced border



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Step 3: Gather six of the 4" squares, five of the 2-1/2" x 4" Fabric I rectangles and two 4" x 4-1/2" Fabric I rectangles. Sew together, alternating squares and rectangles to form the top pieced border. Use the Quilt Assembly Diagram for specific fabrics for the squares, or select fabrics at random. Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make the bottom pieced border.





Step 4: Arrange the Step 1 blocks in three rows of three to form the quilt center. Sew the blocks together to form rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions every other row. Sew the rows together, pressing the seams to one side.

Step 5: Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 6: Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the side pieced borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom pieced borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
