

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 10-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

eight 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-one 5-1/4" x 10-1/2" sashing
rectangles

From Fabric C, cut:

three 5-1/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twenty 5-1/4" cornerstone squares

From Fabric D, cut:

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
twelve 3" x 4-5/8" rectangles
six Template A pieces
six Template A-Reversed pieces

From Fabric E, cut:

eighteen Template B pieces

From Fabric F, cut:

six Template B pieces
six Template C-Reversed pieces
six Template D-Reversed pieces

From Fabric G, cut:

twelve Template B pieces
six Template C pieces
six Template D pieces

From Fabric H, cut:

six 3" x 2-1/8" rectangles

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

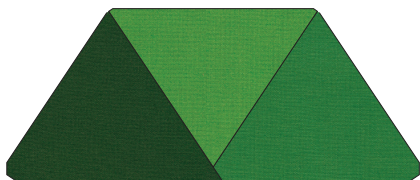
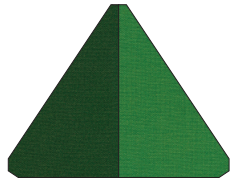
six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Tree Blocks

Step 1: Gather:

one Template C/Fabric G triangle
one Template C-Reversed/Fabric F triangle

Sew together along the longest edge. Press.



Step 2: Gather:

one Template B/Fabric G triangle
one Template B/Fabric E triangle
one Template B/Fabric F triangle

Sew together, in that order, to form a row, as shown. Press.

Step 3: Gather:

two Template B/Fabric E triangles
one Template B/Fabric G triangle
one Template D/Fabric G piece
one Template D-Reversed/Fabric F piece

Sew together to form a row, as shown, placing the
fabrics in the location shown in the diagram.
Press.

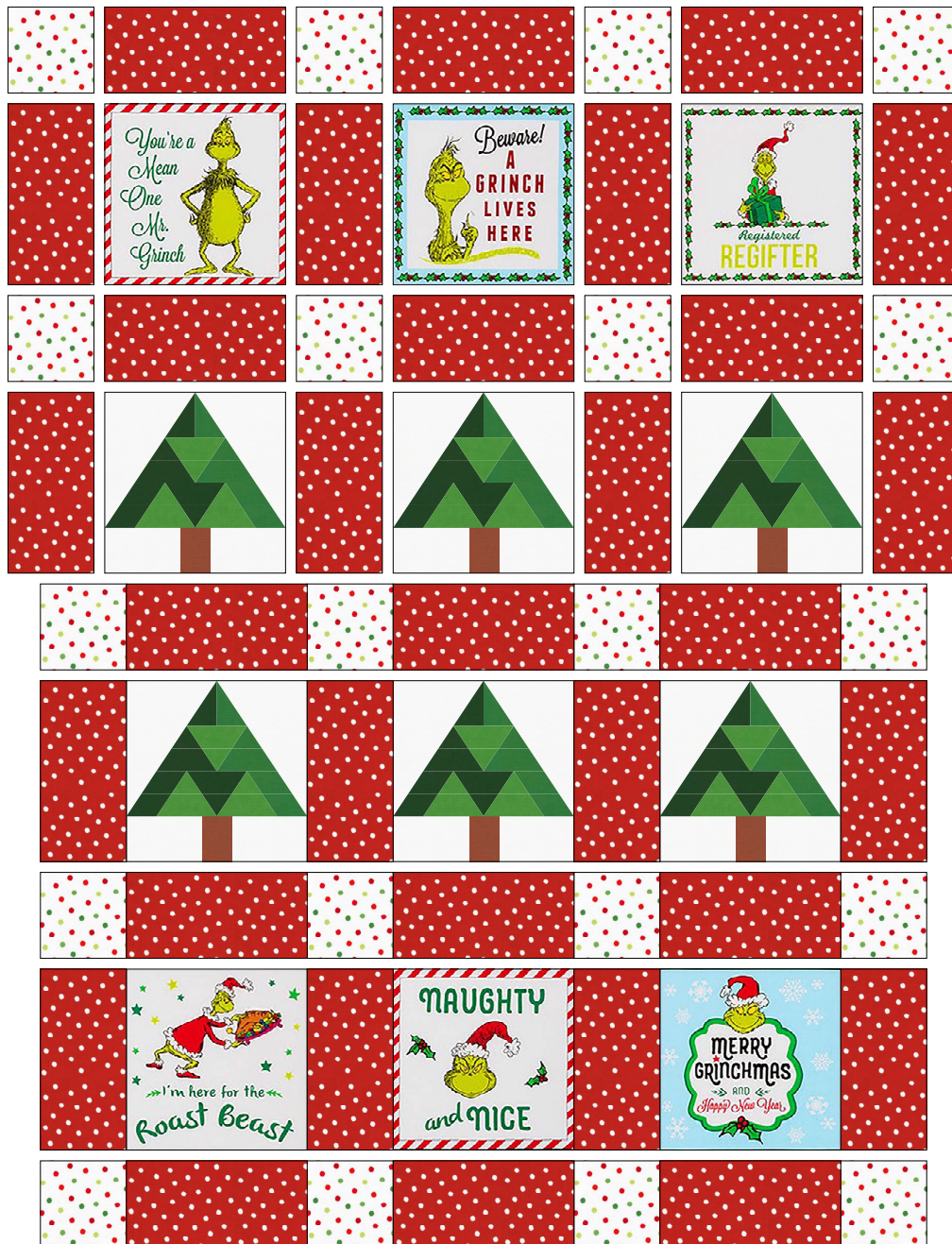


Step 4: Sew the completed Step 1, Step 2 and Step 3 units together, as shown. Press. Sew a
Fabric D/Template A and Fabric D/Template A-Reversed piece to the left and right edges of
the tree. Press.

Step 5: Sew a Fabric D rectangle to opposite edges of a Fabric H rectangle, along the 3"
sides. Press. Sew to the bottom edge of the tree block. Press.

Repeat Steps 1-5 to make six Tree Blocks, each 10-1/2" square.

Assemble the Quilt



Step 6: Arrange the Fabric A Blocks and Tree Blocks together as indicated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew each row together, using Fabric B sashing strips between each block and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make four block rows.

Step 7: Gather four Fabric C cornerstone squares and three Fabric B sashing strips. Sew each row together, using cornerstones between each sashing strip and at the beginning and end of each row. Press seams toward the sashing. Repeat to make five sashing rows.

Step 8: Sew the sashing and block rows together, pinning and nesting the seams. Press seams open or to the sashing.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

Print at 100%.

Check size printed correctly using 1" box for scale prior to cutting fabric.
