## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### From each Ten Square, cut:

- two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - two 3" x 5-1/2" rectangles
  - two 3" squares
- one 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
  - two 2-1/2" squares

### From Fabric A, cut:

- eleven 1" x WOF strips. Subcut:
  - eighty 1" x 3" rectangles
  - eighty 1" x 2-1/2" rectangles

### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

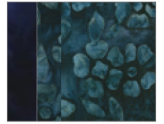
- five 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Gather one 2-1/2" square, one 3" square, and one 3" x 5-1/2" rectangle all cut from the same Ten Square. Gather one 1" x 2-1/2" Fabric A rectangle and one 1" x 3" Fabric A rectangle as well.

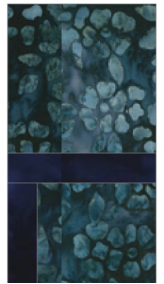
**Step 2:** Sew the 1" x 2-1/2" rectangle to the left edge of the 2-1/2" square, then press.



**Step 3:** Sew the 1" x 3" rectangle to the top edge of the unit, then press.



**Step 4:** Sew the 3" square to the top edge of the unit, then press.

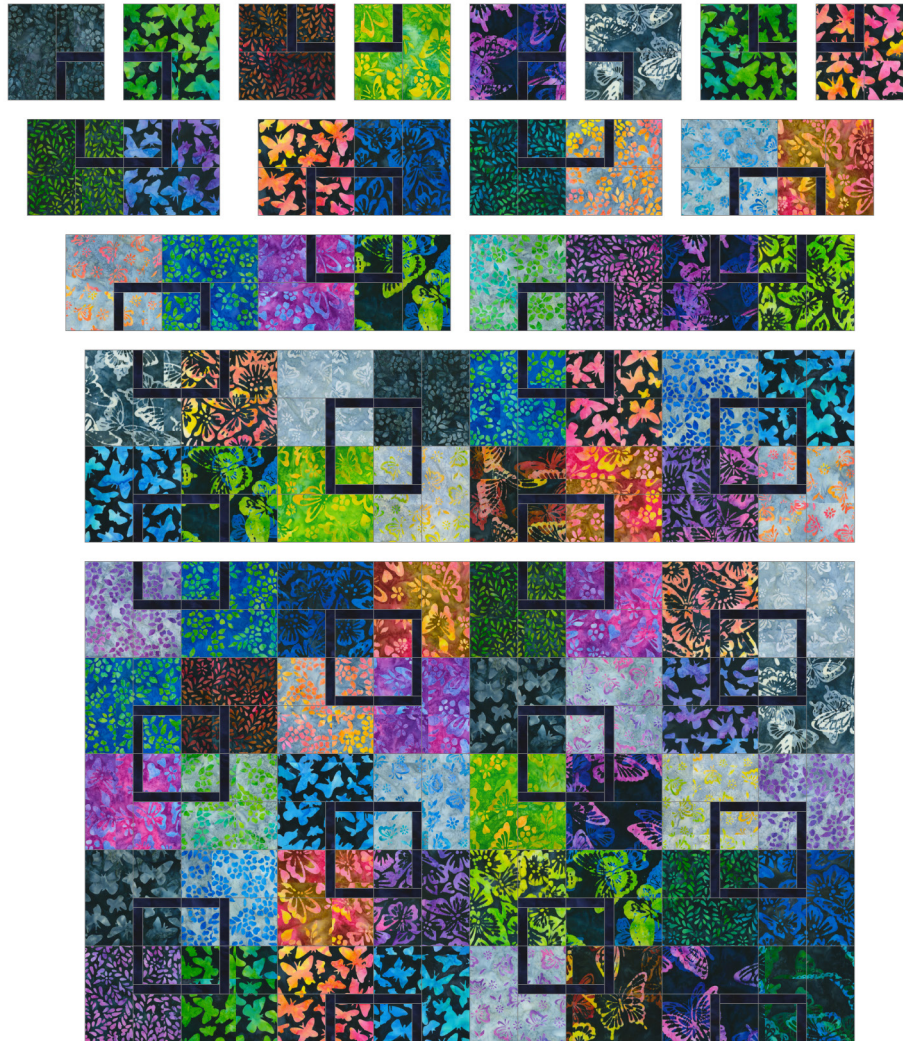


**Step 5:** Sew the 3" x 5-1/2" rectangle to the left edge of the unit, then press.



**Step 6:** Repeat Steps 1-5 to make eighty blocks. You will have leftover sets cut from the Ten Squares that can be discarded.

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 7:** Arrange the blocks into ten rows of eight blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 8:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the seams to the left in the odd-numbered rows and to the right in the even-numbered rows.

**Step 9:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
