## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4$ " unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From each Fabrics $A$ and $B$, cut:

seven 7" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty-nine 7" squares each of A and B.
From Fabrics C and D, cut:
two 7" x WOF strips. Subcut: eleven 7" squares each of C and D.
From the binding fabric, cut:
seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a Fabric A square with a Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat to make seventy-seven A/B HSTs and twenty-two C/D HSTs. Trim each to 6-1/2" if necessary.

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 2: Arrange the HSTs as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram, noting the fabric placement and orientation of each unit.

Step 3: Sew the HSTs together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.


Step 4: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.
Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
