## Supplies Needed

1 fat quarter bundle FQ-771-15 (includes panel)
2-1/2 yds APTM-14560-274
1 Fat Quarter APTM-14553-87
1 Fat QuarterAPTM-14559-87
1 Fat Quarter APTM-14559-29
1 Fat Quarter APTM-14559-274
1 yd Kona Wine
7 1/4 yards backing
Double-sized batting
5/8 yard for binding

Pattern Level: Experienced Intermediate
"I know the ropes and would like to test my skills!"

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Finished quilt measures $78^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{\prime \prime}$

## Notes Before You Begin

- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!
- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.


## Cutting Instructions

## Panel

When more than one fabric is listed, cut EACH fabric the amount specified.

- Fussy cut 8 squares, trimming them to 10-1/2" each.


## APTM-14559-87 \& APTM 14553-87 (Cream background prints)

- Cut 8 strips 2-1/2" $\times 22^{\prime \prime}$ (or width of fat quarter), then subcut into 16 strips 2-1/2" $\times 10-1 / 2$.
- Cut 2 strips 5" x 22", then subcut into 8 squares 5 " $\times 5$ ".


## APTM-14559-274 \& APTM-14559-29 (Green churndash frames)

- Cut 8 strips 2-1/2" x 22" (or width of fat quarter), then subcut into 16 strips 2-1/2" x 10-1/2.
- Cut 2 strips $5^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$, then subcut into 8 squares $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$.
- Cut 2 strips $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 22^{\prime \prime}$, then subcut into 8 strips $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Cut 4 Squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$.

APTM-14558-274 \& APTM-14553-274 (Small center churndash blocks)

- Fussy cut 2 squares $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## APTM-14555-274 (Background for small churndash blocks)

- Cut 4 strips 1-1/2" x 22", then subcut into 16 strips 1-1/2" $\times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
- Cut 8 squares $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$.


## Kona Wine (For sashing and interior border)

- Cut 13 strips 2-1/2" x WOF. Set 9 strips aside.
- From remaining strips, subcut 7 strips $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and 2 strips $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


## APTM-14560-274 (Exterior borders)

- Cut 4 strips lengthwise $8-1 / 2 \times 84^{\prime \prime}$.

Note: Fussycut each strip, so that you are cutting the stripe in the same place for all borders. Use the quilt diagram as a guide.

## Assemble the Large Churn Dash Blocks

## Step 1: Make the Half Square Triangles (HST)

-Place a 5 " green square and a 5 "
background square with right sides together.
-Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner and then sew a scant $1 / 4$ " from each side of the line.
-Cut apart along drawn line.
-You will now have 2 half square triangles.


Note: Be sure to always match the same fabrics together. Use the quilt illustration as a guide.
-Trim to $4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

Repeat steps above to make 32 HSTs.

## Step 2

-Sew a green 2-1/2"x 10-1/2" strip to a back ground $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip along the long edge.
-Repeat to create 32 strip sets.

Note: Pair the same fabrics that you paired up in
 Step 1.

## Step 3

-Sew 2 HSTs to a strip set, as pictured.
-Repeat to make 16 HST/strip sets.


## Step 4

-Sew a strip set to each side of a panel square.


## Assemble the Small Churn Dash Blocks

Using 4-1/2" center block squares, $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips and 3 " squares, follow steps 1-3 to create 4 small churn dash blocks.

## Assemble Quilt Top

Step 1: Assemble the Center Block
-Sew two small churn dash blocks and sashing together and repeat for other two small churn dash blocks.
-Sew together with sashing in between.


## Step 3: Sew Interior Borders

-Sew interior borders to sides and then to top and bottom of quilt top.

## Step 2: Sew Sashing

-Sew blocks into rows with sashing between blocks.
-Sew rows together with sashing in between.

## Attach \& Miter The Outer Borders

## Step 1

-Find center of Outer Border and pin right sides together to top of quilt.
-Sew border starting and stopping 1/4" from each end of quilt top.
-Repeat for three other sides.


## Step 2

-Fold the quilt in half diagonally, right sides together and align two of the borders directly on top of each other.
-Use your ruler to draw a line from the corner of the quilt to the edge of the border.


## Step 3

-Trim off excess border along line and sew 1/4" in from the edge. Begin at the point where your border stitching had ended and sew to the edge of the border.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy.

1 fat quarter APTM-14553-199

7 1/4 yards backing
Double-sized batting
5/8 yard for binding

1 Fat Quarter Bundle FQ-773-15 (include panel) 2-1/2 yards APTM-14560-186 for Borders
1 yard Kona Black for Sashing
7 1/4 yards backing
Double-sized batting
5/8 yard for binding

Fat Quarter Bundle FQ-774-21 (includes panel) 2-1/2 yards APTM-14560-223 for Borders APTM-14553-224: $1 / 4$ yard (1/2 yard total) APTM-14553-223: $1 / 4$ yard (1/2 yard total) 1 yard Kona Champagne for Sashing 7 1/4 yards backing Double-sized batting 5/8 yard for binding
