
# LIFE IN THE WILD

## Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, fussy cut:

eight 10" squares

#### From Fabric B, cut:

twelve 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seven 2-1/2" x 12-1/2" block sashing strips

six 2-1/2" x 40-1/2" row sashing strips

Sew the three remaining strips together, end-to-end, and trim to:

two 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" side inner borders

#### From Fabric C, cut:

two 4-1/2" x length of fabric pieces. Trim to 40-1/2" long.

from the remainder of the fabric, cut:

two 5-1/2" x 12-1/2" rectangles

#### From Fabric D, cut:

six 4-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

two 4-1/2" x 56-1/2" side outer borders

three 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-3/4" x 10" side block borders

four 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

#### From each of Fabrics E-G, cut:

three 1-3/4" x WOF strips. Subcut:

four 1-3/4" x 10" side block borders

four 1-3/4" x 12-1/2" top/bottom block borders

#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips

#### Assemble the Blocks

**Step 1:** Sew a 10" Fabric D side block border to the left and right edges of a Fabric A square. Press toward the border. Sew a 12-1/2" Fabric D top/bottom block border to the top and bottom edges of a Fabric A square. Press toward the border. The resulting block should measure 12-1/2" square.



two blocks with a Fabric D border

two blocks with a Fabric E border

two blocks with a Fabric F border

two blocks with a Fabric G border





**Step 3:** Sew a 40-1/2" Fabric B row sashing strip to the top and bottom edges of each 4-1/2" x 40-1/2" Fabric C strip. Press toward Fabric B. These will become Row 1 and Row 5.

- **Step 4:** Arrange the Fabric C rectangles, pieced blocks and sashing strips as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew together to form Rows 2, 3 and 4, pressing toward the sashing strips in each row.
- **Step 5:** Sew the rows together, placing the remaining two Fabric B row sashing strips between Rows 2 & 3 and Rows 3 & 4. Press toward the sashing.
- **Step 6:** Sew the Fabric B side sashing strips to the left and right edges of the quilt. Press.
- **Step 7:** Sew the Fabric D side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the Fabric D top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
