Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

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## Pattern Notes

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

#### **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

one 21-1/2" x 21-1/2" square

From the remainder, cut:

four 11-3/8" x 11-3/8" squares. Cut each square once along the diagonal, creating eight triangles.

#### From Fabrics B-J, cut:

a total of eighty-four 4" x 4" squares (9-10 from each print)

#### From the binding fabric, cut:

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips


#### Assemble the A Blocks




**Step 1:** Gather nine assorted Fabric B-J squares. Sew into three rows of three, pressing seams to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows. Sew the rows together, pressing the row seams open. Repeat to create four A Blocks.

#### Assemble the B Blocks

**Step 2:** Gather six Fabric B-J squares. Arrange and sew one row of three squares, one row of two squares. You will have one square remaining as the final 'row'. Press the seams to one side as illustrated. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams. Repeat to create eight units.







**Step 4:** Pin one triangle RST with each pieced unit, aligning the two straight sides. Pin along the angled edge, with the pieced unit wrong side up on your work surface. Sew along the marked line. Note: This seam allowance will seem slightly larger than 1/4", but stitching on the marked line is essential for a correctly pieced block.

**Step 5:** Trim off the excess from the triangle and the squares, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press the seams open. The resulting block should measure 11" square. Repeat Steps 3 and 4 to create eight B Blocks.



#### Assemble the Quilt



**Step 6:** Arrange the A and B Blocks and the 21-1/2" square as illustrated in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press all seams open.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
