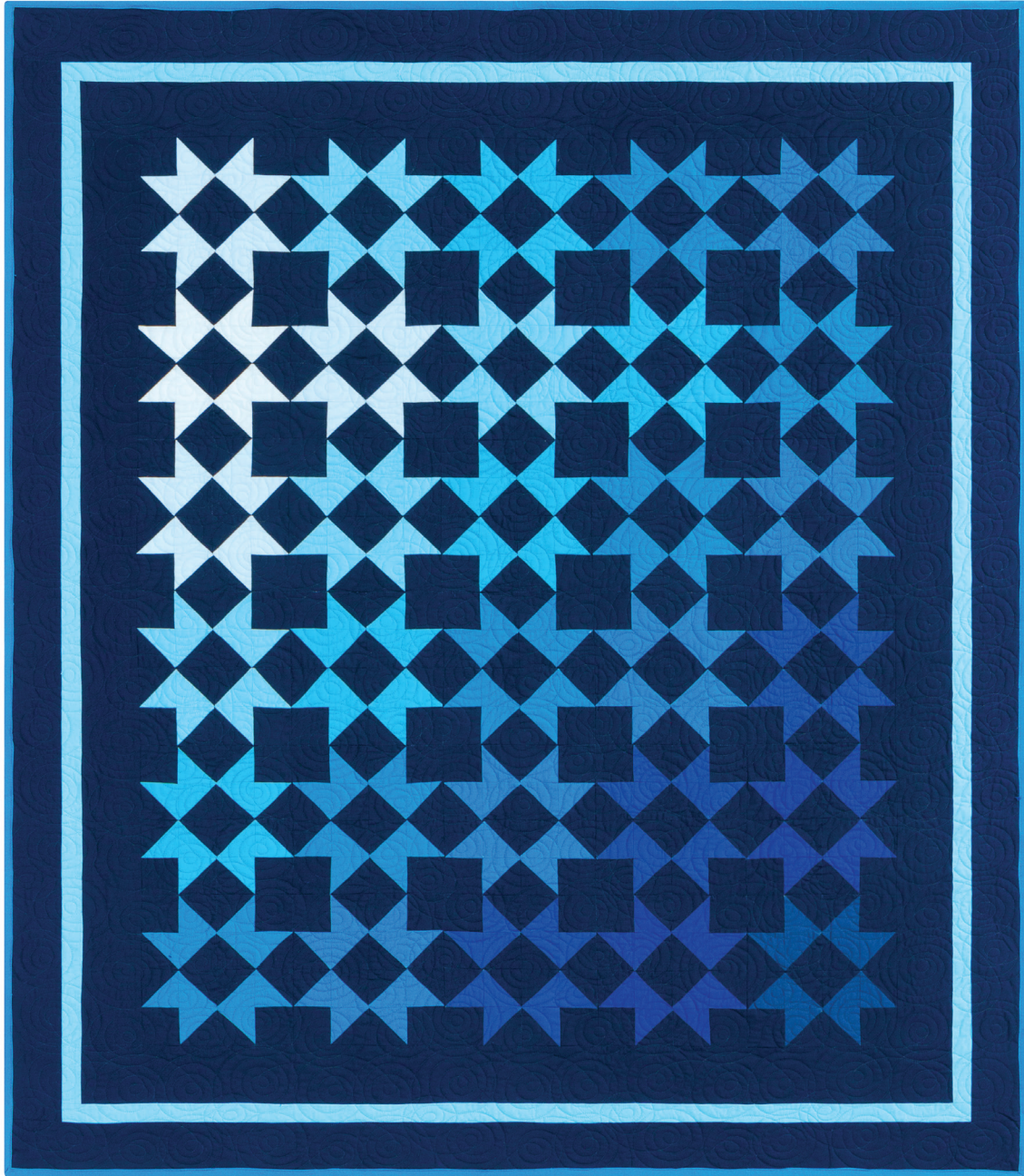

Finished quilt measures: 54" x 62"











## Fabric and Supplies Needed

*Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.*

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### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

### **From Fabric A, cut:**

ten 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 3-1/2" x 46-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 48-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 54-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

two 3-1/2" x 56-1/2" side Border 3 pieces

thirteen 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred eighty 3" squares for the HSTs

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

one hundred twenty 2-1/2" squares

### **From Fabric B, cut:**

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twenty four 3" squares for the HSTs

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 1-1/2" x 48-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

two 1-1/2" x 54-1/2" side Border 2 pieces

### **From each of Fabrics C and D, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

six 3" squares for the HSTs

### **From each of Fabric E and G, cut:**

two 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

eighteen 3" squares for the HSTs

### **From Fabric F, cut:**

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 3" squares for the HSTs

### **From each of Fabrics H and I, cut:**

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty 3" squares for the HSTs

### **From Fabric J, cut:**

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 3" squares for the HSTs

### **From the Binding Fabric, cut:**

six 2-1/2" x WOF strips



## Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

**Step 1:** Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make forty-eight A/B HSTs.



**Step 2:** Repeat Step 1 to make:



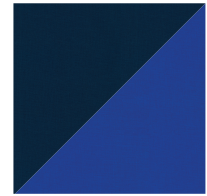
twelve A/C HSTs

thirty-six A/E HSTs



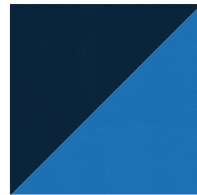
twenty-four A/F HSTs

sixty A/I HSTs

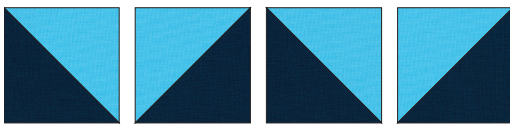

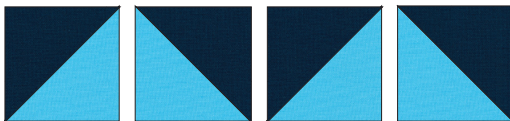
## Assemble the Blocks



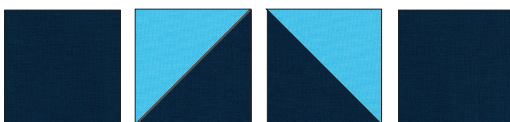
**Step 3:** Gather:  
four 2-1/2" Fabric A squares  
twelve A/B HSTs



Arrange the units into four rows of four. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.

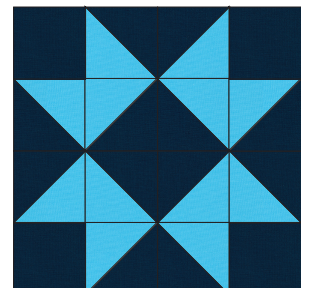


**Step 4:** Sew the squares together to form the rows. Press the seams in opposite directions every other row.

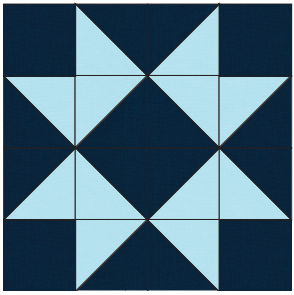


**Step 5:** Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side to form the block.

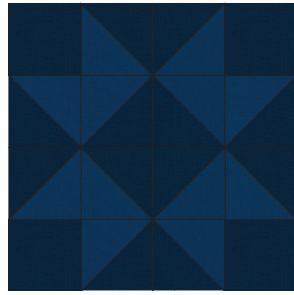
The finished block should measure 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make four Fabric B Blocks.



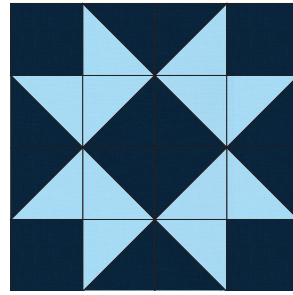
**Step 6:** Repeat Steps 3-5 to make:



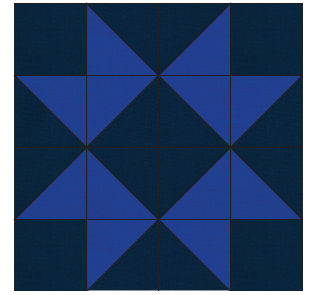
one Fabric C Block



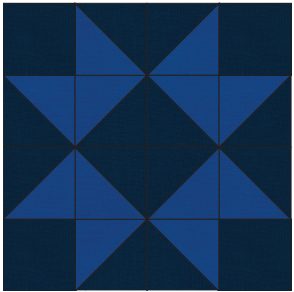
one Fabric D Block



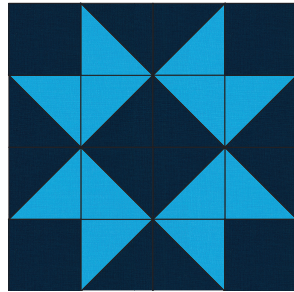
three Fabric E Blocks



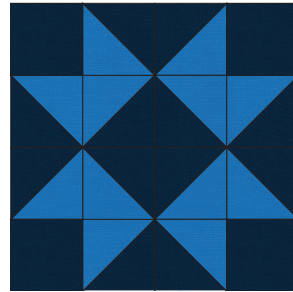
two Fabric F Blocks



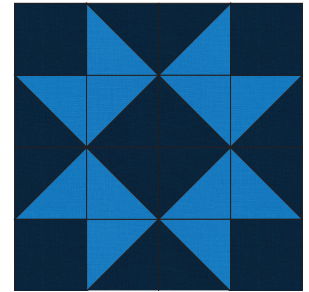
three Fabric G Blocks



five Fabric H Blocks

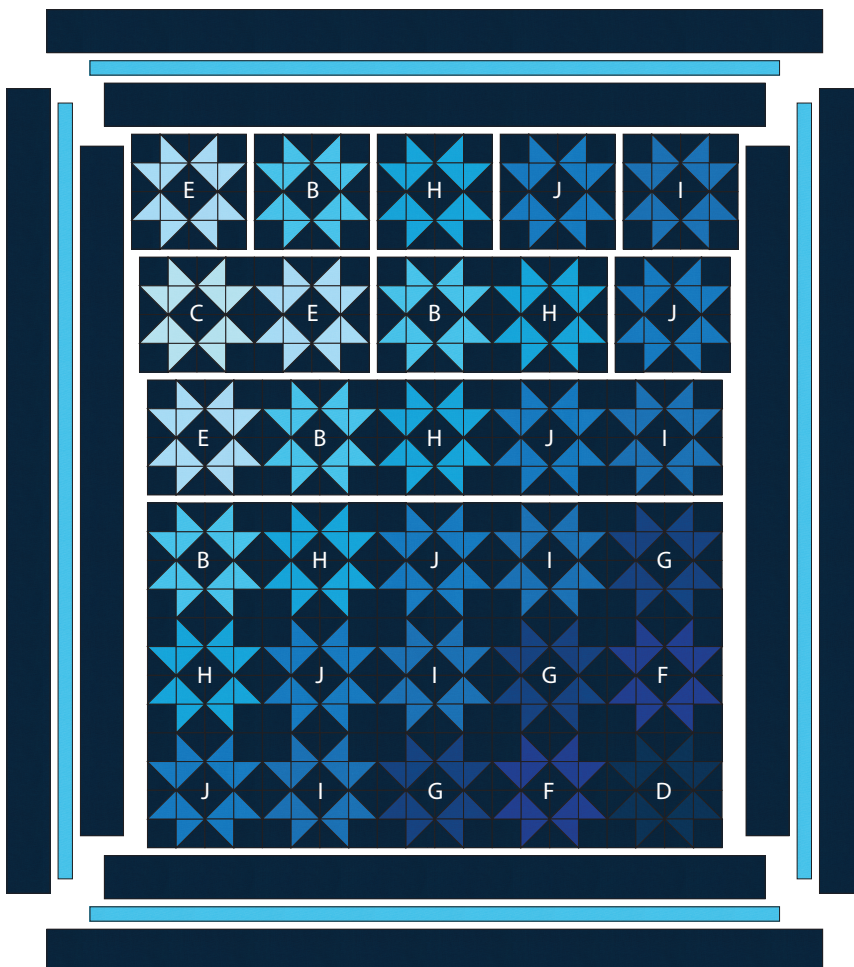


five Fabric I Blocks

## Assemble the Quilt



**Step 7:** Arrange the blocks into six rows of five blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

**Step 8:** Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press the rows to the left in the odd numbered rows and to the right in the even numbered rows.

**Step 9:** Sew the rows together to form the quilt center. Press the row seams open.

**Step 10:** Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 11:** Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

**Step 12:** Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
