

Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

Fabric A

- Cut twelve strips 5" x WOF, then subcut each strip into eight rectangles 5" x 6-1/2" (ninety-six rectangles total).

Fabrics C, D & E

- Cut sixteen squares 5" x 5".

Fabrics F, H, J, K & L

- Cut eight squares 5" x 5".

Fabrics G & I

- Cut four squares 5" x 5".


Assembly Instructions

Step 1: Make Sashing


- Sew two Fabric B strips with short ends together to create one long strip.
- Repeat to make fourteen strips (seven for each quilt top).

Step 2: Assemble Quilt Top

- Sew columns together according to the assembly diagram. You will be alternating a 5" x 5" square with a Fabric A rectangle.
- Sew the columns together with a Fabric B strip in between each column. Make sure you keep the columns aligned as you are sewing them together. Trim excess from the Fabric B strips.
- Sew the second quilt top together following the layout diagram on page 4.





Layout for Piet "Primary Colorstory" quilt #2.

Piet "Earth" Colorstory 1 and 2









Piet "Iron" Colorstory 1 and 2




