

## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!
- This quilt may look challenging, but in reality, it is a variation of a simple Log Cabin. Check your seam allowance before sewing, as the 'logs' are cut exactly the right length.

# **Cutting Instructions**

#### From Fabric A, cut:

three 3-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: thirty 3-1/2" squares for the block centers

#### From each of Fabrics B-F, cut:

two 2" x WOF strips. Subcut: twenty-four 2" squares six 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut: ninety-six 2-1/2" squares

#### From Fabric G, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for the outer borders.

#### From each of the 35 Fat Eighths, cut:

Set aside the fat eighths that match Fabrics B-F for use in another project.

five 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut a total of the following: sixty 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangles

one hundred twenty 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" rectangles

one hundred twenty 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles

one hundred twenty 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" rectangles

sixty 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles


#### From the Binding Fabric, cut:


seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

# Assembling the Blocks


**Step 1** Mark diagonal lines on the wrong side of each of the 2" Fabric B-F squares. Place a light square on the corner of a 3-1/2" Fabric A square, and sew on the diagonal. Trim the seam allowance to 1/4" and press toward the light triangle.









**Step 2** Continue in the same manner on all four corners of the Fabric A square. Press. At this point the square measures 3-1/2". Repeat for all thirty of the Fabric A squares.







**Step 3** Using the 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, sew to opposite sides of the center square-in-a-square. Press toward the rectangles. Repeat for thirty blocks.


**Step 4** Using the 1-1/2"  $\times$  5-1/2" rectangles, sew to opposite sides of the units from Step 3. Press toward the rectangles. At this point the squares should measure 5-1/2".




**Step 5** Mark diagonal lines on the wrong side of each of the 2-1/2" light squares. Place a white square on a corner of a block from Step 4. Sew on the diagonal and trim away the excess. Repeat for each of the four corners on all the blocks.









**Step 6** Using the 1-1/2"  $\times$  5-1/2" rectangles, sew to opposite sides of the blocks from Step 5. Continue by adding the 1-1/2"  $\times$  7-1/2" strips to make larger blocks. Add the corner squares and trim as before.



**Step 7** Repeat the same procedure using the 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" rectangles and the 9-1/2" rectangles for the next round. Add the corner squares, stitch and trim as before.





## Assembling the Quilt



**Step 1** Arrange the blocks in rows of five, alternating the corner seams. Sew the blocks together into six rows of five. Press the seams in alternating directions.

**Step 2** Sew three borders strips together, then cut in half. Measure, trim and sew borders to the top and bottom of the quilt top. Press toward the borders.

**Step 3** Piece the last four border strips. Measure, trim and sew the borders to the sides of the quilt top. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
