


Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, cut:

three 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 3" squares for the Large HSTs

eleven 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs

seventy-two 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles for the A Blocks

twelve 2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

seventy-two 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks

Sew the remaining six together, end-to-end, then trim:

five 2" x 48-1/2" row sashing strips

fifteen 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

thirty-six 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks thirty-six 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles for the B Blocks

From each of Fabrics B, C and F-S, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 3" squares for the Large HSTs Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut: six 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs

From Fabric D, cut:

one 3" x WOF strip. Subcut: six 3" squares for the Large HSTs Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut: six 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs six 3" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 3" x 58" side outer borders two 3" x 55-1/2" top/bottom outer borders

From Fabric E, cut:

one 3" x WOF strips. Subcut: six 3" squares for the Large HSTs Trim the remainder of the strip to 2-1/2" wide, then subcut: six 2-1/2" squares for the Small HSTs six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim: two 1-1/2" x 56" side inner borders two 1-1/2" x 50-1/2" top/bottom inner borders

From the Binding Fabric, cut:


seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangles (HSTs)

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric A square with a 3" Fabric B square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make four A/B Large HSTs.

Step 2: Repeat Step 1 to make:

four Large HSTs from each of fabrics C-S, each paired with Fabric A

eight E/D Large HSTs



eight G/F Large HSTs



eight H/I Large HSTs



eight J/K Large HSTs



eight L/M Large HSTs



eight N/O Large HSTs




eight P/Q Large HSTs


Step 3: Repeat Steps 1 and 2, using the 2-1/2" squares to make Small HSTs in the same color pairings and quantities. These HSTs will be trimmed to 2" square.

Assemble the A Blocks



Step 4: Gather: four B/C Large HSTs four A/C Large HSTs four 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric A rectangles

Arrange the units as shown to form the block. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.




Step 5: Sew the Block together in two halves, as shown. Press seams as shown.


Step 6: Sew the two halves together to form the Block. The finished Block will measure 8-1/2" square.



Repeat to make one A Block in each of the following combinations:



Assemble the B Blocks



Step 7: Gather: four B/C Small HSTs four A/C Small HSTs four 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangles

Arrange the units as shown to form the block. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Block Assembly Diagram.




Step 8: Sew the Block center together in two halves, as shown. Press seams as shown.


Step 9: Sew the two halves together to form the Block center. Sew the 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" Fabric A rectangles to the left and right edges of the Block. Press. Sew the 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric A rectangles to the top and bottom of the Block. Press.

The finished Block will measure 8-1/2" square.

Repeat to make one B Block in each of the following combinations:














































Assemble the Quilt



Step 10: Arrange the A and B Blocks into six rows of six blocks. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Step 11: Sew the blocks together to form rows. Press.

Step 12: Sew the rows together to form the quilt center, sewing a Fabric A row sashing strip between each row. Press.

Step 13: Sew the side inner borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom inner borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 14: Sew the side outer borders to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the top and bottom outer borders to the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
