

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From each of Fabrics A-G, cut:

one Template B piece (popsicle)

From each of Fabrics H-N, cut:

two Template C pieces (popsicle accent)

From Fabric O, cut:


fourteen Template A pieces (popsicle sticks)

From Fabric P, cut:


seven $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares seven 3" x $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles two 2" x $35 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles two 2" x 11" rectangles

Assembly Instructions

- 1. Using the placement guide as reference, pin two Fabric O popsicle stick pieces in place on one 3" x 5-1/2" Fabric P (background) rectangle. Use image below as a placement guide.
- 2. Machine baste around the curve of the shape using a 1/4" seam allowance.




- 3. Using matching thread & needle, turn edges and whip stitch in place. Straight ends will remain unsewn, with raw edges matched to the edge of the background rectangle.
- 4. Repeat steps 1-3 for a total of seven units.
- 5. Using the placement guide below as a reference, pin one popsicle (Template B) piece in place on one 5-1/2" background square. Machine baste the curve of the Template B piece using a 1/4" seam allowance.
- 6. Pin two popsicle accents in place, again using the image below as a placement guide. Each accent piece will be 1/8" away from the sides of the main popsicle. Tip: once both accents are placed together, unpin and remove one. Baste and hand stitch the




remaining accent in place completely to avoid any overlap with the second accent. Then, place and stitch the second accent piece in place.

- 7. Using matching thread & needle, turn edges and whip stitch in place. Straight ends will remain unsewn, with raw edges matched to the edge of the background rectangle.
- 8. Repeat for a total of seven units. Pair the fabrics as follows: A/H, B/I, C/J, D/K, E/L, F/M, G/N.

9. Pair up the popsicle units right sides together and sew using a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams open.




10. Lay out the table runner following the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Sew the popsicle units together, pressing the seams open. Sew the 2" x 35-1/2" rectangles to the top and bottom of the quilt center. Press toward the border. Sew the 2" x 11" rectangles to the sides of the quilt center, pressing toward the border.



11. Your wall hanging is complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
