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## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42 " wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## From Fabric ZZ (background), cut:

one 18-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 18-1/2" squares
five 9-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
eighteen 9-1/2" squares
six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-eight 5-1/2" squares for the HST blocks
five 5 " x WOF strips. Subcut:
thirty-six 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
Tip: Group fabrics into six color groupings (one for each of Blocks A-F) prior to cutting

## Fabrics for Block A

From each of Fabrics A and C, cut:
one $5-1 / 2$ " square for the HSTs
From Fabric B, cut:
two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From each of Fabrics D, G and H, cut:
two 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From Fabric E , cut:
one 6" x WOF strip. Subcut:
two 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing. six 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## From Fabric F , cut:

six 5" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## Fabrics for Block B

From each of Fabrics J and N , cut:
two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From Each of Fabrics I, L, M and O, cut:
three 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

From each of Fabrics $K$ and $P$, cut:
nine 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From Fabric $Q$, cut:
three 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs

## Fabrics for Block C

From each of Fabrics W and Z, cut:
two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From Fabric Q, cut:
four 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From each of Fabrics R, T, V and Y, cut:
four 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From each of Fabrics $U$ and $X$, cut:
twelve 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## Fabrics for Block D

From each of Fabrics EE and HH, cut:
two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From Fabric BB, cut:
four 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From each of Fabrics CC, DD, GG and II, cut:
four 6 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From each of Fabrics AA and FF, cut:
twelve 5" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## Fabrics for Block E

From each of Fabrics RR and LL, cut:
two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs
From Each of Fabrics JJ, MM, PP and QQ, cut:
three 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From each of Fabrics KK and OO, cut:
nine 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From Fabric NN, cut:
three 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs

## Fabrics for Block F

From each of Fabrics TT and VV, cut:
one 5-1/2" square for the HSTs

From each of Fabrics $Y Y$ and $X X$ cut:
two 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From Fabric SS, cut:
four 6" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## From Fabric UU, cut:

one 5-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut: two 5-1/2" squares for the HSTs six 5 " squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.

## From Fabric WW, cut:

six 5" squares. Cut each square in half along a diagonal for paper piecing.
From the Binding Fabric (Fabric AAA), cut:
nine $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips

## Assemble the Blocks

Notes:

- These assembly instructions are specific to the A Blocks. All Blocks (A-F) are assembled in the same way. Refer to the Block Assembly Diagrams for fabric placements within the blocks.
- This quilt is constructed using paper piecing for portions of the block. Sew the pieces in the order indicated on the template. Trim seam allowances to $1 / 4$ " as each new piece is added.

Step 1: Pair each 5-1/2" square (Fabrics A, B and C) with a background fabric square (Fabric ZZ), right sides together. Mark a diagonal on the wrong side of the background square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut along the line, creating two half-square triangle (HST) blocks. Press the seam toward the darker fabric. Trim to 5" square. Repeat for all 5-1/2" squares for the A Blocks.


Step 2: Paper piece Template 1, following the order indicated on the template and the fabric placement indicated in the Block Assembly Diagram.


Step 3: Gather four HSTs, four Template 1 units and one 9-1/2" background square. Arrange in three rows of three, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Sew together into rows, pressing seams toward the Template 1 pieces. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams open. The block should now measure 18-1/2" square.

## Assemble the Quilt



Step 1: Arrange the A-F Blocks and the two 18-1/2" squares into five rows of four blocks each. Refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for fabric placement and block orientation.

Step 2: Sew the blocks together to form rows, pressing the seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the row seams open.

Your quilt is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!
