Fabric Requirements

Blocks		Yardage	Cutting Directions
• Fabric A (DDJ 5775-6 Rose) (*MR5)		1/3 yard	Cut 2 strips 4-7/8" x WOF and subcut into (10) 4-7/8" squares Cut each square in half diagonally for 20 triangles
• Fabric B (DDJ 5761-2 Pink) (*MRA)		1/3 yard	Cut 2 strips 4-7/8" x WOF and subcut into (10) 4-7/8" squares Cut each square in half diagonally for 20 triangles
• Fabric C (DDJ 5772-2 Natural) (*MR5)		1 yard	Cut 4 strips 2 1/2" x WOF and subcut into (52) 2 1/2" squares Cut 7 strips 2 1/2" x WOF and subcut into (56) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles Cut 2 strips 2 1/2" x WOF and subcut into (2) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" & (1) 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strips
• Fabric D (DDJ 5774-6 Rose) (*MR5)		1/2 yard	Cut 6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF and subcut into (96) 2 1/2" squares
• Fabric E (DDJ 5764-2 Pink) (*MRA)		1/4 yard	Cut (4) 4 1/2" squares
• Fabric F (DDJ 5763-2 Pink) (*MRA)		1/3 yard	Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x WOF and subcut into (16) 4 1/2" squares
Border			
• DDJ 5762-2 Pink (*MRA)		1 yard	Cut 4 strips 6 1/2" x 34 1/2" LENGTHWISE positioning the darker floral stripe in the center of each strip
Binding			
• DDJ 5772-6 Rose (*MR5)		3/8 yard	
Backing			
• Fabric F (GFK560501L-17A)		3 yards	

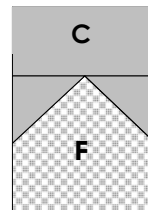
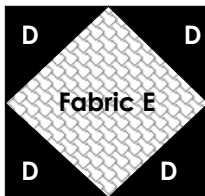
Assembly

- Make **20 Half Square Triangles** using the 4 7/8" triangles from Fabric A and Fabric B;
Place right sides together and sew on the long diagonal being careful not to stretch the fabric
- Make **40 Flying Geese** units by placing a 2 1/2" Fabric D square on each side of a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together.
Sew along the diagonal and press toward the outside; trim excess fabric to 1/4".



- Make **4 Square-in-a-Square** blocks by placing a 2 1/2" Fabric D square on one corner of a 4 1/2" Fabric E square, right sides together, and sew across the small square diagonally. Fold, press and trim away the excess fabric. Repeat on the remaining 3 corners.

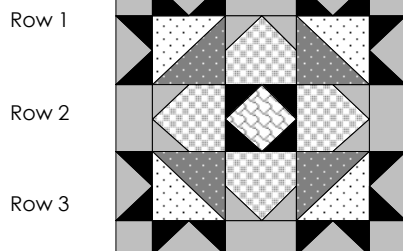
Make **8 Elongated Flying Geese** units by sewing 2 1/2" Fabric C squares to one side of a 4 1/2" Fabric F square. Sew a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the Flying Geese side of this unit to create an "elongated Flying Geese"



Sew all pieced units together following the diagrams to the right.

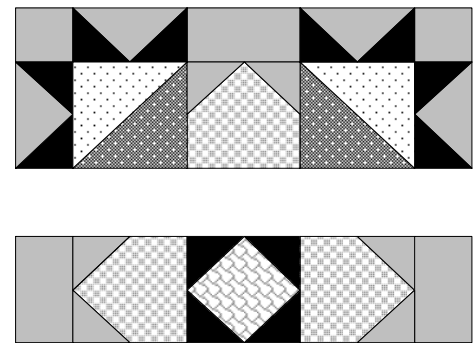
There are 4 large blocks in the quilt top. Each block consists of Row 1, Row 2 and Row 3, which is Row 1 flipped.

Sew the rows together for one 16 1/2" square block; make 4.



Rows 1 & 3
Make 8

Row 2
Make 4



Sew 2 completed blocks together with a 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" sashing strip between. Repeat with the remaining two blocks. Then sew these two units together with the 2 1/2" x 34 1/2" strip between.

Borders: Measure across the center of the quilt both vertically and horizontally and adjust border strip lengths, if needed.

Sew two of the border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt. Sew each of the remaining border blocks to opposite ends of the side border strips and sew to the quilt top being careful to keep the baskets in the correct position. Refer to the picture for placement. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
