

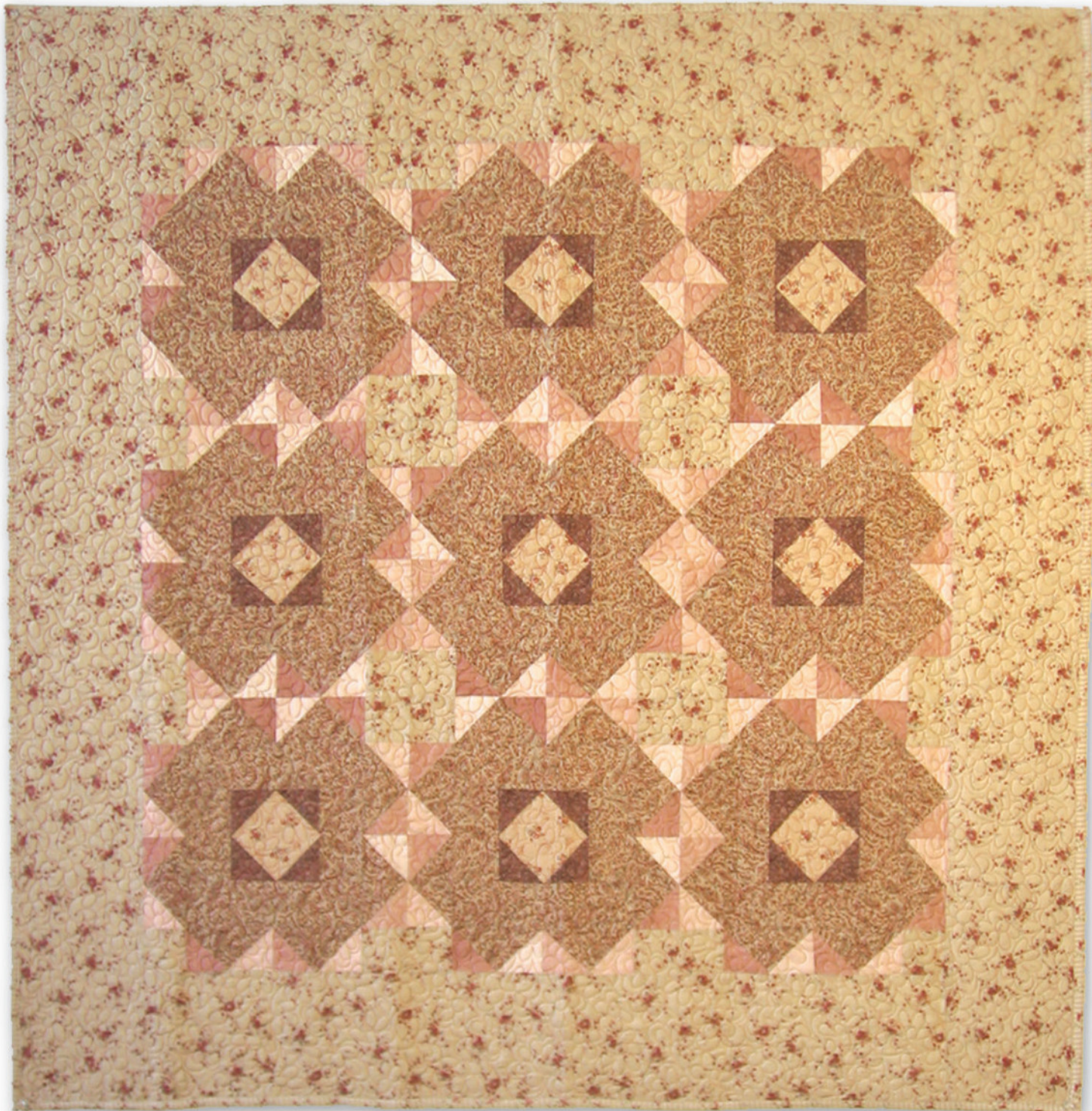

## Fabric Requirements

### Blocks

- DDJ – 8479-97 Rose (Fabric A)
- DDJ – 8477-160 Taupe (Fabric B)
- DDJ – 8476-97 Rose (Fabric C)

- DDJ – 8501-97 Rose (Fabric D)
- DDJ – 8475-97 Rose (Fabric E)

### Border

- DDJ – 8475-97 Rose (Fabric E)

### Binding

- DDJ – 8472-97 Rose (Fabric F)

### Backing

- DDJ – 8501-97 Rose (Fabric D)

## Yardage

1/4 yard

## Cutting Directions

Cut 1 strip 4-1/4" x WOF; subcut into (9) 4-1/2" squares  
Cut 3 strips 2-1/2" x WOF; subcut into (36) 2-1/2" squares  
Cut 10 strips 2-1/2" x WOF;

subcut into (90) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles

Cut 5 strips 2-1/2" x WOF;

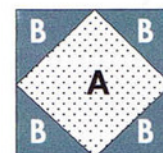
subcut into (18) 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

Cut 9 strips 2-1/2" x WOF; subcut into (144) 2-1/2" squares

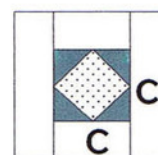
Cut 3 strips 2-1/2" x WOF; subcut into (36) 2-1/2" squares

Cut 5 strips 6-1/2" x WOF; subcut & piece to fit the following:  
2 strips 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" and 2 strips 6-1/2" x 48"

Cut 5 strips 2-1/2" x WOF

## Assembly

**Make 9 Square in a Square** blocks by placing a 2-1/2" Fabric B square on one corner of a 4-1/2" Fabric A square, right sides together, and sew across the small square diagonally. Fold, press and trim away the excess fabric. Repeat on the remaining 3 corners for Unit 1.

Sew a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the top & bottom of each Square in a Square.

Sew a 2-1/2" x 8-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to each side to make Unit 2.

Finished size should be 8-1/2" square.



**Make 72 Flying Geese** by placing a 2-1/2" Fabric D square on one end of a 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together. Sew along the diagonal and press toward the outside; trim excess fabric to 1/4". Repeat on the other end as illustrated.

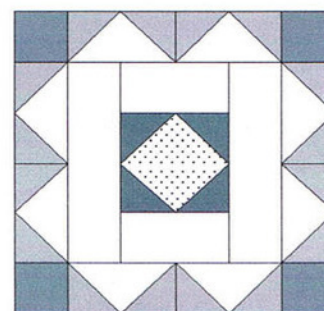
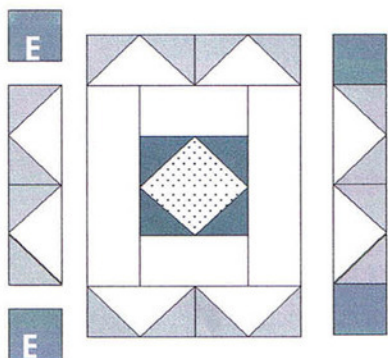
Make pairs of Flying Geese by sewing 2 units together for Unit 3. Make 36



Unit 3

Sew a Unit 3 to the top and bottom of each Square in a Square block.

Sew a 2-1/2" Fabric E square to each end of the remaining 18 pairs of Flying Geese. Sew to the left and right sides of the Square in a Square block for a completed block. Make 9 blocks. Finished size should be 12-1/2" square.



Sew the 9 blocks together into 3 rows, 3 blocks each.

## Borders

Measure across the center of the quilt both vertically and horizontally and adjust border strip lengths, if needed.

Sew the 6-1/2" x 36-1/2" border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt.

Sew the 6-1/2" x 48" strips to the sides of the quilt.

Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
