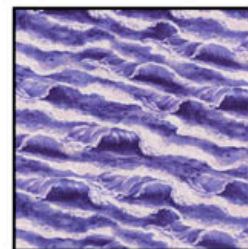

# SECRETS OF THE REEF

## Fabrics Needed:

Center Panel	ALR-5076-3 Marine	3/4 yard
Inner Borders (Green Bubbles)	ALR-5077-9 Kelp	3/4 yard
Fabric A (Blue Bubbles)	ALR-5077-6 Ocean	1-1/4 yards
Fabric B (Purple Wave)	ALR-5072-5 Dawn	2/3 yard
Fabric C (Yellow Sky)	ALR-5073-3 Sunshine	3/4 yard
Fabric D (Pink Bubbles)	ALR-5077-10 Sunset	1 yard
Outer Border	ALR-5075-3 Ocean	2-1/4 yards
Backing	ALR-5074-4 Marine	3-1/2 yards

## Cut:

Cut one 18-1/2" x 28-1/2" rectangle  
 Cut two 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" & two 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" for the Panel Borders. Cut six 2-1/2" x width of fabric (WOF). Piece into two 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" & two 2-1/2" x 60-1/2".  
 Cut fifty-six of Template A, fifty-six of Template A reversed, fifty-six 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" & fifty-six 2-1/2" squares.  
 Cut twenty-eight 3-1/2" squares & twenty-eight 2-7/8" squares.  
 Cut fifty-six Template B, twenty-eight 2-7/8" squares & fourteen 2-1/2" squares.  
 Cut twenty-eight 3-1/2" squares & seven 2-1/4" x 45" for binding.  
 Cut three 4-1/2" x width of fabric and piece into two 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" for the top and bottom borders. Cut two 4-1/2" x 64-1/2" from the length of fabric for the side borders.  
 Piece into one 56" x 76" for the backing.

## Block Assembly Instructions:

- Place one 3-1/2" Fabric B square on top of one 3-1/2" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across one diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line (fig. 1). Cut one the drawn line to make two half-square triangles (fig. 2). Make fifty-six Fabric B/D half-square triangles. Trim them to measure 2-7/8" square.
- Place one half-square triangle from Step 1 on top of another half-square triangle, right sides together. Make sure the center seam is going in the same direction on both half square triangles and the Fabric B triangle is opposite from the Fabric D triangle (fig. 3). Draw a diagonal line across the top half-square triangle so that it goes through the sewn seam. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line (fig. 4). Cut one the drawn line to make two quarter-square triangles (fig. 4). Make fifty-six Fabric B/D quarter-square triangles.
- Place one 2-7/8" Fabric B square on top of one 2-7/8" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across one diagonal of the top square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn line (fig. 1). Cut one the drawn line to make two half-square triangles (fig. 2). Make fifty-six Fabric B/C half-square triangles.
- Place one Template A on the top left side of one Template B (fig. 5). Sew in place. Place one Template A reversed on the top right side on the Template B (fig. 6). Sew in place. Make fifty-six Point Units.
- Follow the block layout and make fourteen blocks that measure 10-1/2".

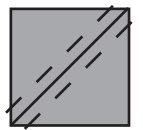

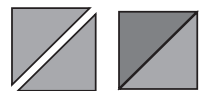

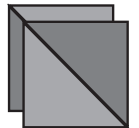

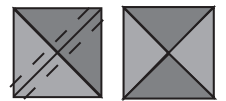

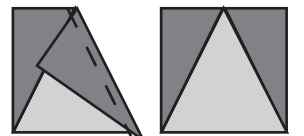
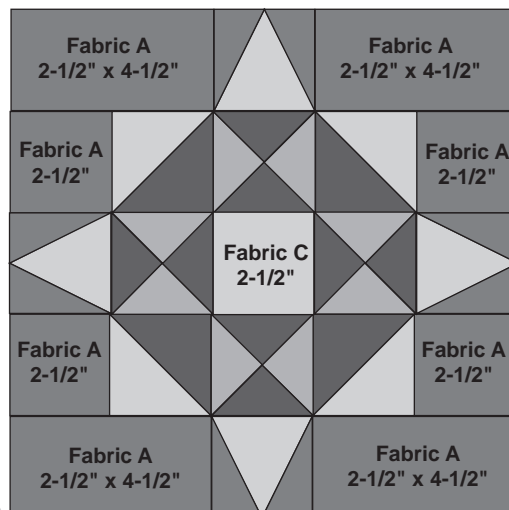


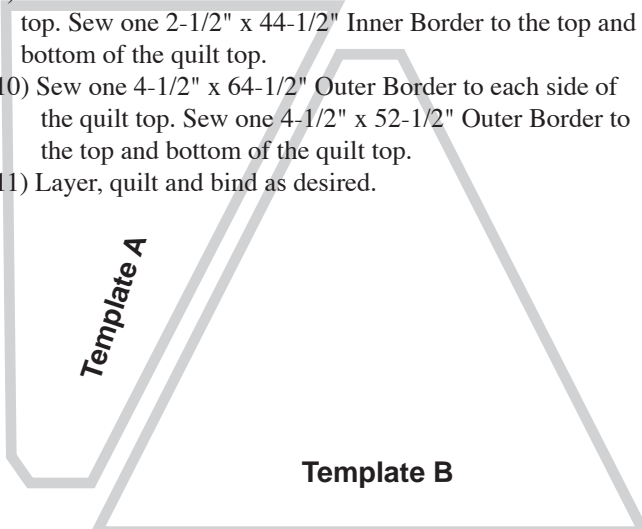

## Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- Sew one 1-1/2" x 28-1/2" Inner Border to each side of the Center Panel. Sew one 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" Inner Border to the top and bottom of the Center Panel.
- Sew three finished blocks together for each side of the Center Panel. Sew the pieced blocks to the Center Panel.
- Sew four finished blocks together for the top and bottom of the Center Panel. Sew the pieced blocks to the top and bottom of the Center Panel.
- Sew one 2-1/2" x 60-1/2" Inner Border to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2-1/2" x 44-1/2" Inner Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 4-1/2" x 64-1/2" Outer Border to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 4-1/2" x 52-1/2" Outer Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
