Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42 " wide.


## Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least $42^{\prime \prime}$ wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## From Fabric $A$, cut

sixteen 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two-hundred and fifty-six 2-1/2" squares.
forty-nine 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:
two 1-1/2" $\times 34-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strips.
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip.
seventy-nine 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
sixty-four 1-1/2" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
two-hundred and fifty-six 1-1/2" squares.
Sew the nine remaining strips together end-to-end. Press the seams open, then subcut: two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 56-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip. two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 78-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip. one $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 89-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ sashing strip.

## From Fabric B, cut:

three 12" x WOF strips. Subcut
seven 12" squares.
Subcut each square once diagonally to yield fourteen large setting triangles.
two $12^{\prime \prime} \times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles, then trim them to $9-1 / 2$ " square.
Subcut each square once diagonally to yield four small setting triangles.

## From Fabric C, cut:

one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
seven 5 " squares for the block assembly.
From Fabric D, cut:
two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fourteen 5 " squares for the block assembly.
From each of Fabrics $E$ and $H$, cut:
three 5" x WOF strips from each fabric. Subcut:
twenty-two 5" squares from each fabric for the block assembly.

## From each of Fabrics F and G, cut:

three 5" x WOF strips from each fabric. Subcut:
twenty-one 5" squares from each fabric for the block assembly.
From Fabric I, cut:
two 5" x WOF strips. Subcut:
fifteen 5 " squares for the block assembly.
From Fabric J, cut:
one 5" x WOF strip. Subcut:
six 5 " squares for the block assembly.
From the Binding Fabric, cut:
eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips.

Step 1: Gather:
two 1-1/2" Fabric A squares
two 2-1/2" Fabric A squares
one 5" Fabric C-J square

Step 2: Place the two 2-1/2" Fabric A squares on opposite corners of the 5" Fabric C-J square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on each Fabric A square as shown. Sew on the marked line, then trim the excess $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ away from the sewn seam. Press towards the darker fabric.


Step 3: Place the two 1-1/2" Fabric A squares on opposite corners of the unit, RST. Mark a diagonal line on each Fabric A square as shown. Sew on the marked line, then trim the excess 1/4" away from the sewn seam. Press towards the darker fabric.


Step 4: Repeat Steps 1-3 to make:

Fabric C Units

twenty-one Fabric G Units

fourteen
Fabric D Units

twenty-two
Fabric H Units

twenty-two Fabric E Units

fifteen
Fabric I Units

twenty-one Fabric F Units

six Fabric J Units


Step 5: Gather:
four Step 1-4 units-refer to the Quilt Assembly Diagram for the fabric combinations
two $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A rectangles
one 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle

Step 6: Sew two units to the top and bottom of a 1-1/2" $\times 5$ " rectangle as shown. Pay close attention to the rotation of each unit. Press.


Step 7: Make a second unit as shown. Pay close attention to the rotation of each unit. Press.


Step 8: Sew the two units you just created to either side of the $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle as shown. Press.

Step 9: Repeat Steps 5-8 to make thirty-two blocks in the fabric combinations shown on the Quilt Assembly Diagram.


## Assemble the Quilt

Step 10: Arrange the blocks into eight diagonal rows. Note the fabric placement and block orientation in the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Place a 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric A sashing rectangle in between the blocks and on each end of the row.

Step 11: Sew the blocks and sashing rectangles together to form diagonal rows. Press the seams towards the sashing rectangles.

Step 12: Sew a sashing strip to the top and/or bottom of each row as shown on the Quilt Assembly Diagram. See the Quilt Assemby Diagram for sashing lengths.

Step 13: Sew a large setting triangle to the end of each diagonal row. Note the rotation of the triangles on the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Press.

Step 14: Match the sashing rectangles from row-to-row, then sew the diagonal rows together. Press the row seams open.

Step 15: Sew the small setting triangles onto the corners of the quilt. Press.
Your quilt top is complete! Baste, quilt, bind, and enjoy!
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
