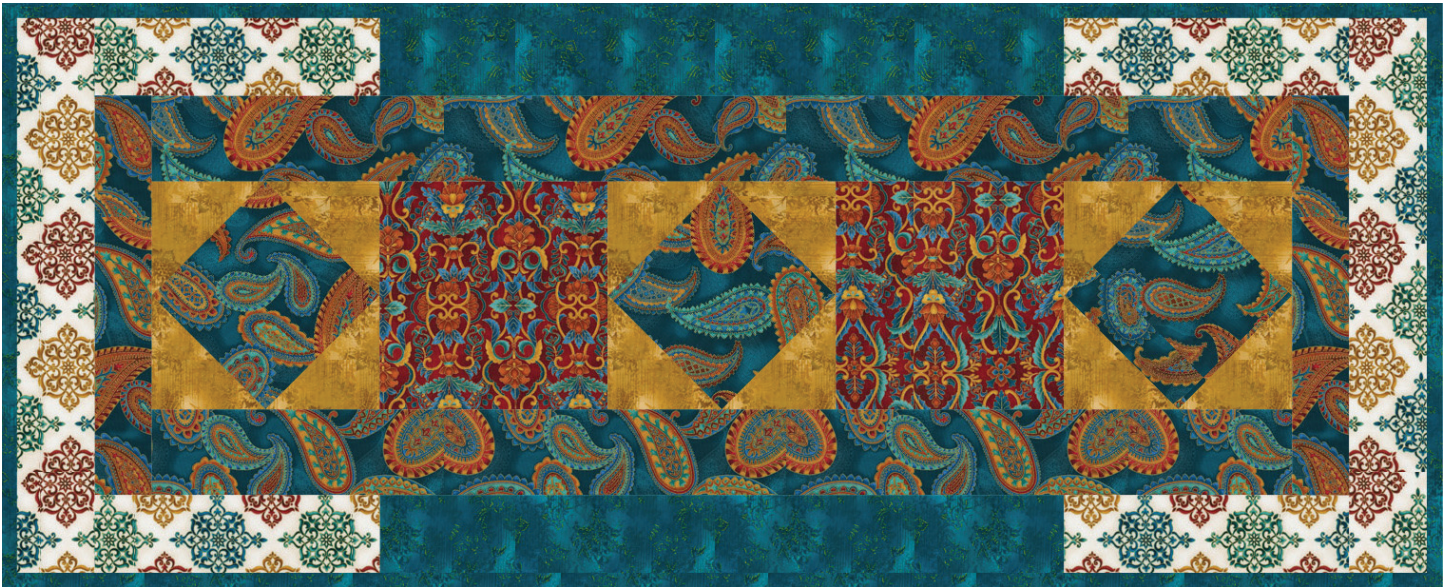

Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 40" wide.

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Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 40" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From **Fabric A**, cut:

one 6-1/8" x WOF strip.

Subcut three 6-1/8" squares. Cut two strips 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" from remainder.
two 3-1/2" x WOF strips for top & bottom border.

From **Fabric B**, cut:

one 4-7/8" x WOF strip.

Subcut six 4-7/8" squares. Cut each once on the diagonal, creating twelve triangles.

From **Fabric C**, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip.

Subcut two 8-1/2" squares.

From **Fabric D**, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut four pieces 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" and two pieces 3-1/2" x 20-1/2".

*fussy cut the strips centering the medallions if desired.

From **Fabric E**, cut:

two 3-1/2" x WOF strips.

Subcut two pieces 3-1/2" x 24-1/2"

four 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

From **Backing Fabric**:

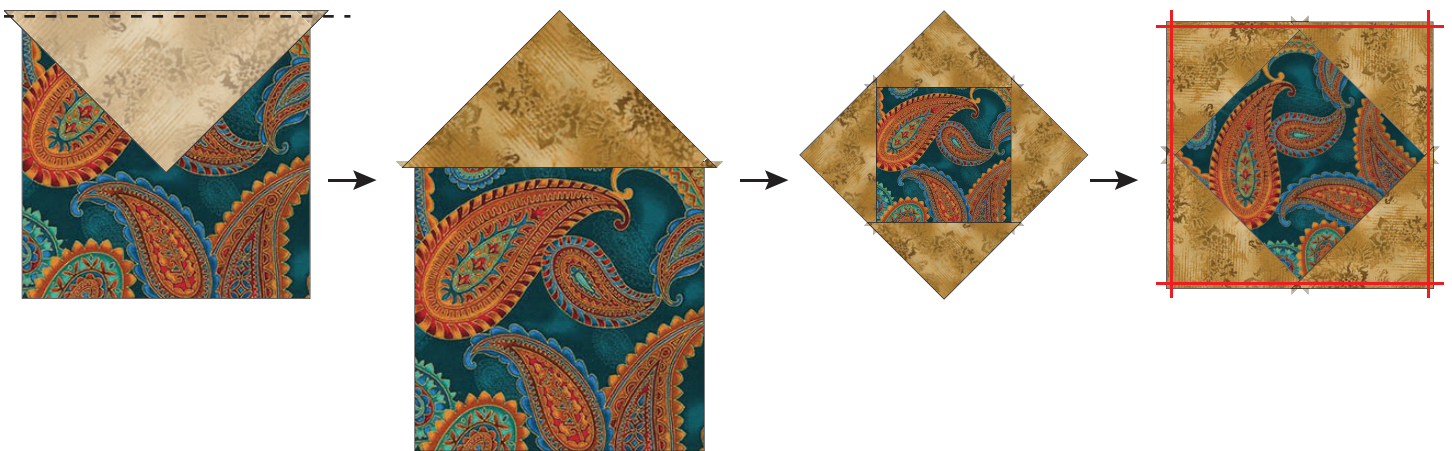
Make a backing that measures at least 24" x 54".

Cut a 25" x WOF strip.

Cut an 11" x WOF strip, sub cut an 11" x 25" piece.

Piece them together using a 1/2" seam allowance.

Assemble the Blocks



Sew a Fabric B triangle to one side of a Fabric A square. Repeat on all sides pressing seams outward towards Fabric B. Trim block to 8-1/2" square. Repeat to make three blocks. Sew the three blocks together with the two Fabric C squares following the diagram and pressing seams towards Fabric C.



Add the Borders



Sew a Fabric A 3-1/2" x WOF strip to the long sides of the blocks, trim excess and press seams towards Fabric A.

Sew a Fabric A 2-1/2" x 14-1/2" to the short sides of the block strip and press seams towards Fabric A.

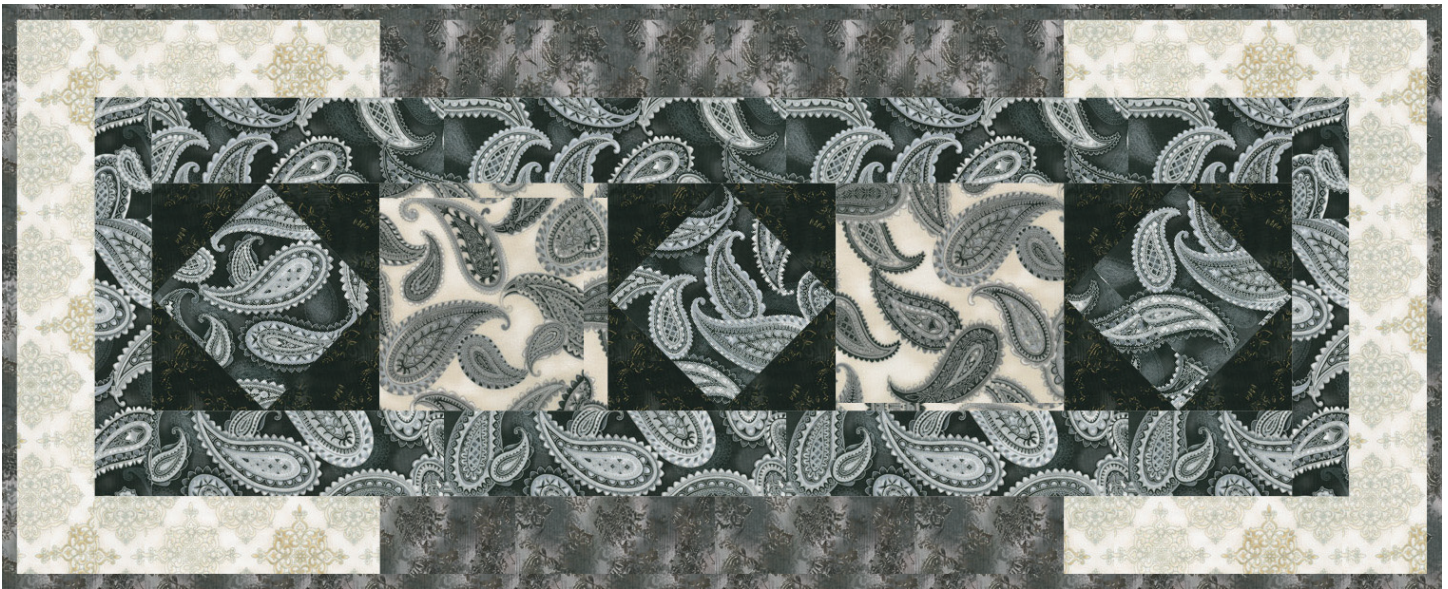
Sew a Fabric D 3-1/2" x 10-1/2" strip to either side of a Fabric E 3-1/2" x 24-1/2" strip pressing seams towards Fabric E. Make two outer border strips.

Sew a Fabric DE strip to the long sides of the runner pressing seams outward towards the Fabric DE strip.

Sew a Fabric D 3-1/2" x 20-1/2" strip to either side of the runner to complete the pieced top.

Your table topper is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

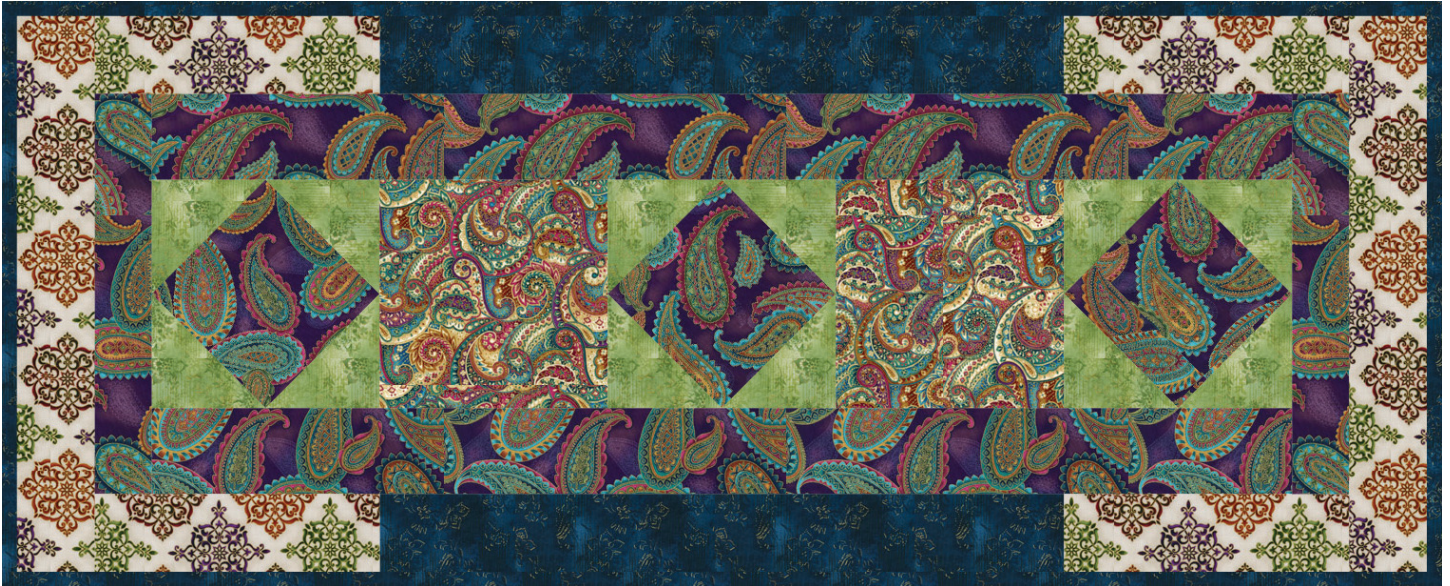
