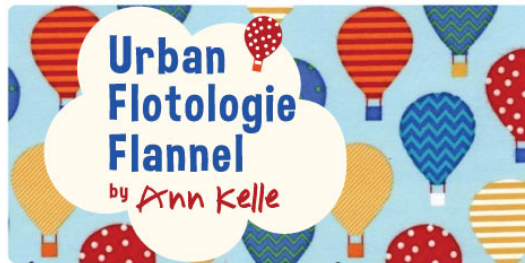

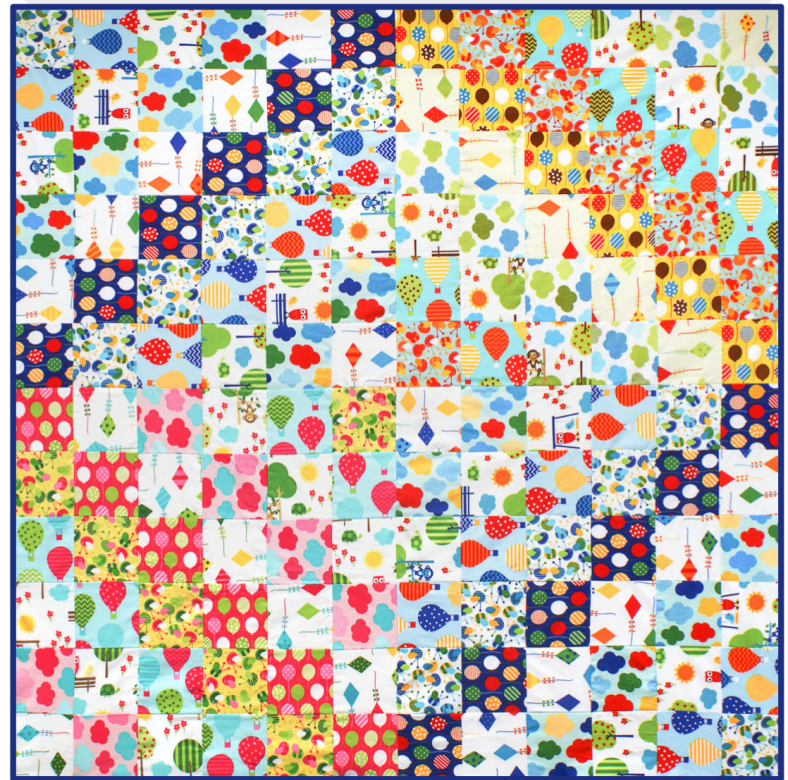
Supplies Needed:

1/4 yd each Sorbet: AAKF-14410-239
 AAKF-14409-239
 AAKF-14408-239
 AAKF-14407-239

1/4 yd each Wild: AAKF-14410-286
 AAKF-14409-286
 AAKF-14408-286
 AAKF-14407-286

1/3 yd each Rainbow: AAKF-14410-263
 AAKF-14409-263
 AAKF-14408-263
 AAKF-14407-263
 AAKF-14406-263

Backing: 4 yds (your choice)
Batting: Twin size



Finished Quilt Size: 60"x 60"

Pattern Level: Confident Beginner

*"I have basic block construction down
and would like to learn a new trick!"*

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Notes on this project:

- Use standard 1/4" seams.
- Shorten your stitch length a little (about a 2) but otherwise treat the flannel just like you would regular cotton.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Instructions:

- From Sorbet and Wild fabrics, cut 1 strip (5.5" x Width of Fabric (WOF)) from each print.
- From Rainbow fabrics, cut 2 strips (5.5" x WOF) from each print.

-Follow the directions from **Bonnie Hunter's Scrappy Trips Around the World tutorial**, but change the dimensions from 2.5" strips to 5.5" when cutting the tube.
