Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Printing the Templates

- Print one copy of page 8 at 100% and cut out the Inner Circle Template and the Outer Background Template. Optional: Trace the templates to template plastic.

Cutting Instructions

 From each fabric, cut the number of squares indicated in the chart to the right.

Follow the instructions below to cut the template pieces from the 7" and 9" squares.



From the 7" x 7" squares:

- Fold each square in half and then in half again. Iron the square to create creases. Place the Inner Circle Template with the straight edges aligned with the two folded edges of the square and cut along the curve.
- Repeat with all of the 7" squares to make forty-eight circles.

From the 9" x 9" squares:

- Fold each square in half and then in half again. Press the square to create creases. Place the Outer Background Template with the straight edges aligned with the two folded edges of the square and cut along the curve.
- Repeat with all of the 9" squares to make forty-eight background squares.




Assembly Instructions

Make the Blocks


1. Place a Fabric P Circle right side up on a flat surface and place a Fabric E Background Square right side up on top of the circle.



2. Pin the background, right sides together, with the circle at the four creases. The best way to do this is by keeping the pieces flat and flipping the background over at each crease so that the right sides are together.




- 3. Pick the pieces up and pin together all around, easing the fabrics as you pin. You may need to pin and re-pin to ease the fabric, but do NOT move the pins at the four creases.
- 4. Sew together using a 1/4" seam allowance.



5. Press the block flat, with seam allowances toward the outside of the block. Trim the block to 8-1/2" x 8-1/2".


Tip: Fold the block into quarters again and press the creases back into it. Use the creases as a guide to help you trim the edges of the block at 90° angles.

6. Repeat Steps 1-5 to make forty-eight blocks. You may follow the Assembly Guide on page 5 to match up the fabrics, or pair them up as you like.



Assemble the Quilt Top


1. Sew the blocks into eight rows of six blocks each, then sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.
