Cutting

Fabric A - 4 strips @ 6" x **length** of fabric Fabric B - 4 strips @ 6" x **length** of fabric, fussy cut to include desired area of scribble stripe Fabric C - 4 strips @ 6" x WOF Fabric D - 4 squares @ 3" x 3" Fabric E - 4 strips @ 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric F - 4 strips @ 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric G - 4 strips @ 2" x WOF Fabric H - 3 strips @ 5-1/2" x WOF Fabric I - 2 strips @ 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric J - 1 strip @ 3-1/2" x WOF Fabric K - 1 strip @ 1-1/2" x WOF Fabric L - one 6" x 6" square **WOF: width of fabric**

To make this quilt you will be piecing squares within squares using strips of different widths for each square.

Start with Fabric L square and add Fabric K strip to left side, aligning top edges. Press seams to one side and trim leftover strip. Sew leftover strip to right side of square, press seams, and trim. Repeat to add Fabric K to top and bottom of Fabric L square.

Using this same method of piecing, pressing then trimming, sew the next four strips (Fabrics J, I, H, & G in this order) to the square.

Sew Fabric E & F strips together, then sew to the left and right sides of the square. Trim the remainder of the EF strip to measure 2pcs @ 2" x 26-1/2". Sew two Fabric D squares to either side of EF strips. Sew these to the top and bottom of the square, lining up seams so that the Fabric D squares are aligned with side strips.

Sew Fabric C strips to the square, left, right, top, then bottom, trimming where necessary.

Sew Fabric B strips to the LEFT, BOTTOM, RIGHT, and TOP sides of the square, trimming where necessary.

Make four strips for the outermost square. The left and right strips are made by piecing a 6" square of Fabric B to the either end of a 40" length, making sure the direction of Fabric B is in keeping with the design. Sew to the left and right sides. The top and bottom strips are made much in the same way, but with the addition of two Fabric A squares measuring 6" each, added to both ends. Sew to top and bottom ensuring that the seams align, completing the design.

Layer, quilt, & bind.

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
