## Notes Before You Begin

- Please read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Press all seam allowances open after each seam is sewn, unless otherwise noted.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!


## Cutting Instructions

## Fabric A

- Cut two squares 19-1/4" x 19-1/4"
- Cut two squares 19" $\times 19^{\prime \prime}$


## Fabric B

- Cut one squares 19" $\times 19^{\prime \prime}$.


## Fabric C

- Cut two squares 19-1/4" x 19-1/4".

Fabric D

- Cut one square 19-1/4" $\times 19-1 / 4$ ".


## Fabric E

- Cut four squares 9-1/2" $\times 9-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$


## Step 1: Make the Center Square

- Sew the four Fabric E squares together, as pictured, so that the pattern is facing two different ways (fig. 1). Block will measure 18-1/2" x 18-1/2" (fig, 2).

Step 2: Make Half Square Triangles (HSTs)

- Place a Fabric A 19" x 19" square, right sides together, on a Fabric B 19" x $19^{\prime \prime}$ square and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
- Sew a scant 1/4" on either side of the line (fig. 3).
- Cut apart along the drawn line (fig. 4) and press block open.
- You will now have two HST blocks. Trim to $18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}(f i g 5)$.
- Repeat to make a second set of blocks using the same fabrics.


Step 3: Make Quarter Square Triangle Blocks (QSTs).

- Following the instructions from Step 2, make two HSTs using Fabrics A and C (fig. 6) and two HSTs using Fabrics C and D (fig. 7). Press seam allowances toward Fabric C. Do NOT trim.

- Place an A/C HST, right sides together, on a C/D HST. The seams will be lined up with the Fabric C triangles opposite each other and the seams nested (fig. 8).
- Draw a diagonal line that is perpendicular to the original seam line and stitch a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on either side of the line (fig. 8).
- Cut apart along the drawn line. You will now have two QST blocks.
- Press the blocks open and trim to $18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ (fig. 9).
- Repeat to make two more identical QSTs.

Step 4: Assemble the Quilt

- Sew the blocks, as pictured, into rows and then sew the rows together (fig. 10).
