






### Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 44" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

## Cutting Instructions

*Note: Be sure to transfer the marked dots from the template to the wrong side of each piece. You will start and stop each seam at these points.*

**From each of Fabrics B, C, F and G, cut:**

twenty-four of Template 1

**From each of Fabrics A and E, cut:**

forty-eight of Template 2

**From each of Fabrics D and H, cut:**

twenty-four of Template 3

twenty-four of Template 3-REVERSED

**From fabric I, cut:**

forty-eight of Template 4

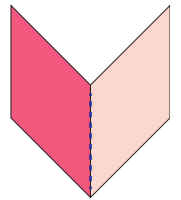
**From the binding fabric, cut:**

eight 2-1/2" x WOF strips

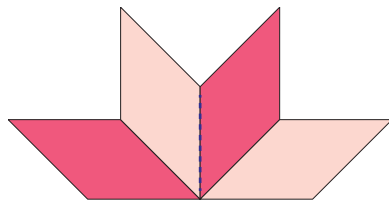
## Assemble the A Blocks

*Note: For all seams, start and stop the seam at the marked dots.*

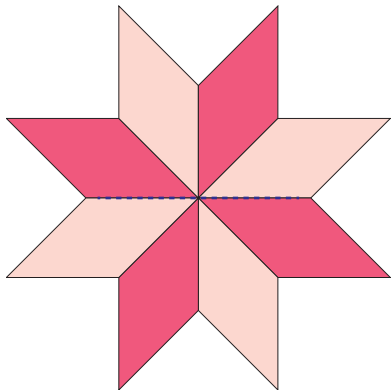
**Step 1.** Sew one Fabric B and C piece together. Press the seam to the darker fabric. Repeat with all remaining B and C pieces, forming pairs.



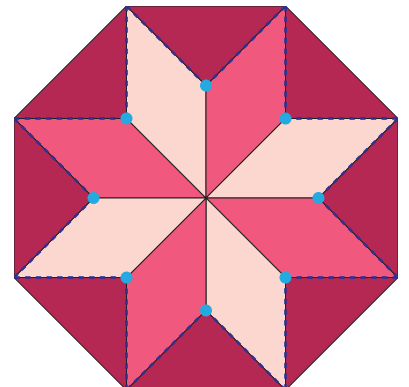
**Step 2.** Sew two pairs together. Press the seam to the darker fabric. Repeat with all units from Step 1.



**Step 3.** Sew two halves together to form a block center. Press the seam open. Repeat to form six A Block centers.

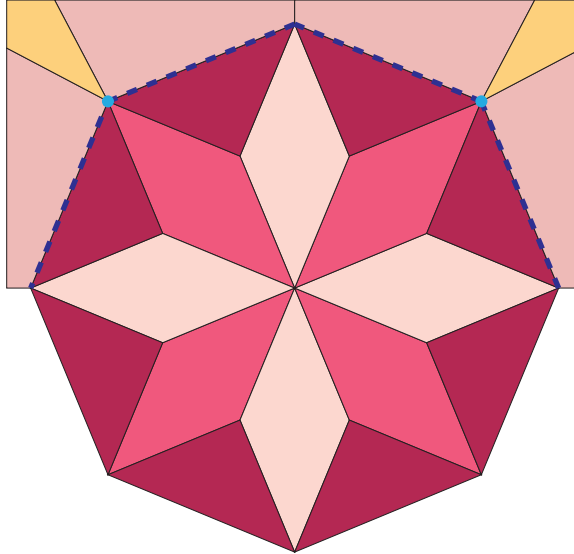
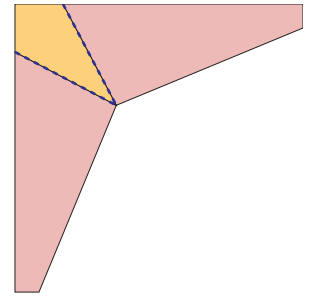


**Step 4.** Sew a Fabric A, Template 2 piece between each set of star pieces, matching the marked dots for easier sewing of seams. Press toward the darker fabric. Repeat for all eight Template 2 pieces in each of the six blocks.



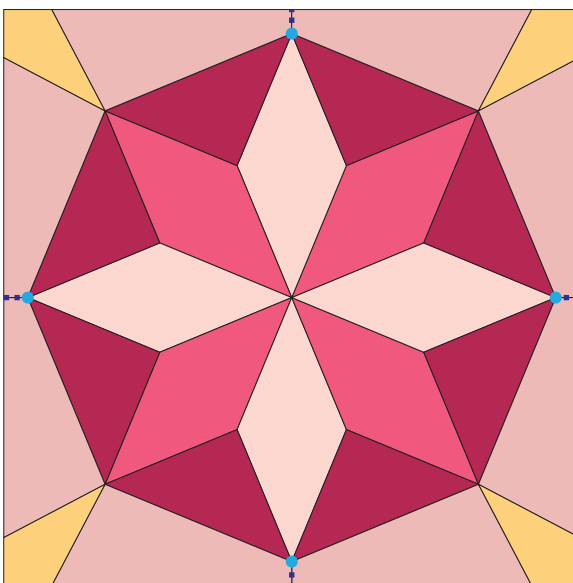
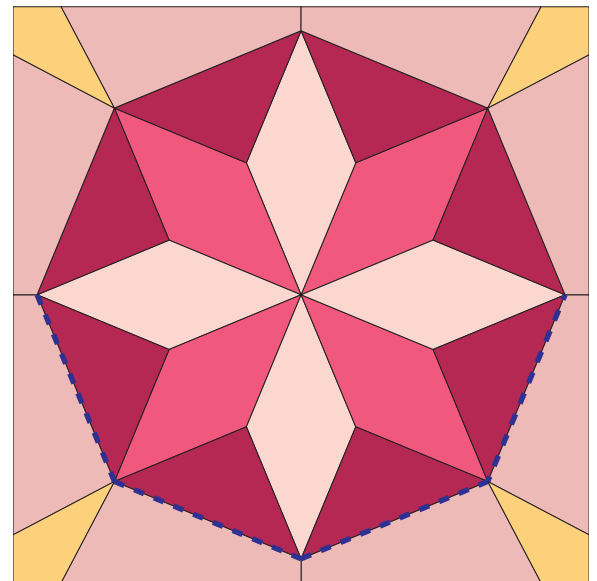
**Step 5.** Sew a Fabric D, Template 3 and Template 3-REVERSED piece to two sides of a Template 4 piece. Press away from Template 4. Repeat for all Fabric D, Template 3/3-REVERSED pairs.

**Step 6.** Sew a unit from Step 5 to the block, pinning and pivoting at the marked dots. Repeat at the opposite corner of the block. Press both seams toward the center of the block.



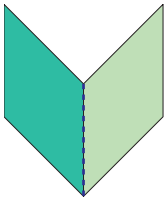
**Step 7.** Repeat Step 6, sewing units to the remaining corners. This time, press both seams away from the center of the block. The final, short seam between the Step 5 units will not be sewn yet.

**Step 8.** Sew the short seams between the outer units. Fold the block right sides together to aid in piecing this final seam, matching the marked dots. Press the seam open. Repeat Steps 6-8 for all remaining A Blocks.

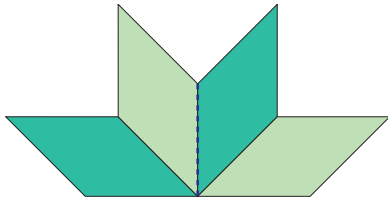


## Assemble the B Blocks

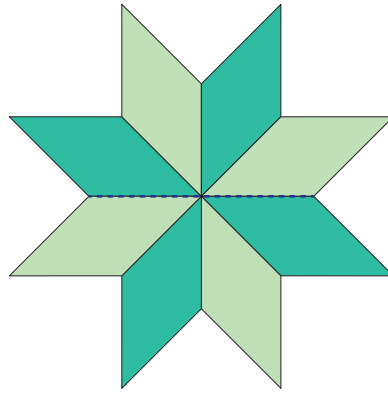
Repeat the steps used to assemble the A Blocks, using Fabrics E-I.



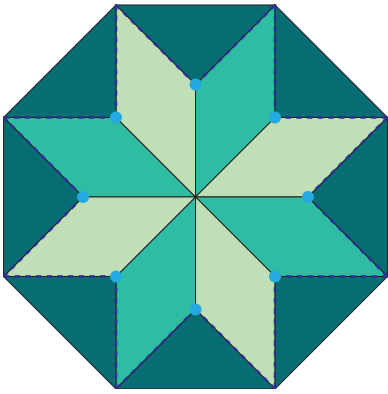

## Assemble the Quilt

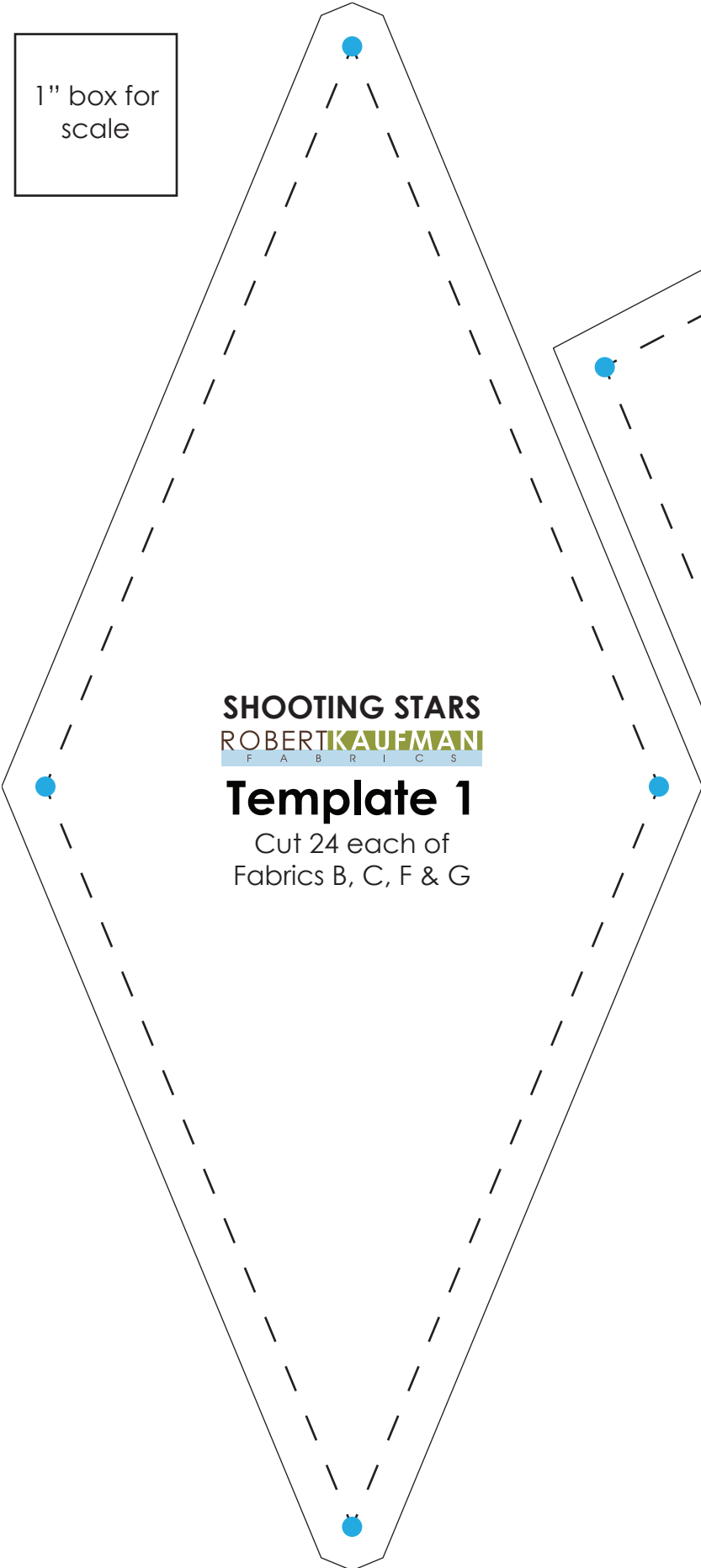


Arrange the quilt in four rows of three blocks each, alternating A and B Blocks as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram.

Sew blocks together in rows, pressing seams to the left in odd numbered rows and to the right in even numbered rows.  
Sew rows together, pressing seams open.

Your quilt top is now complete! Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

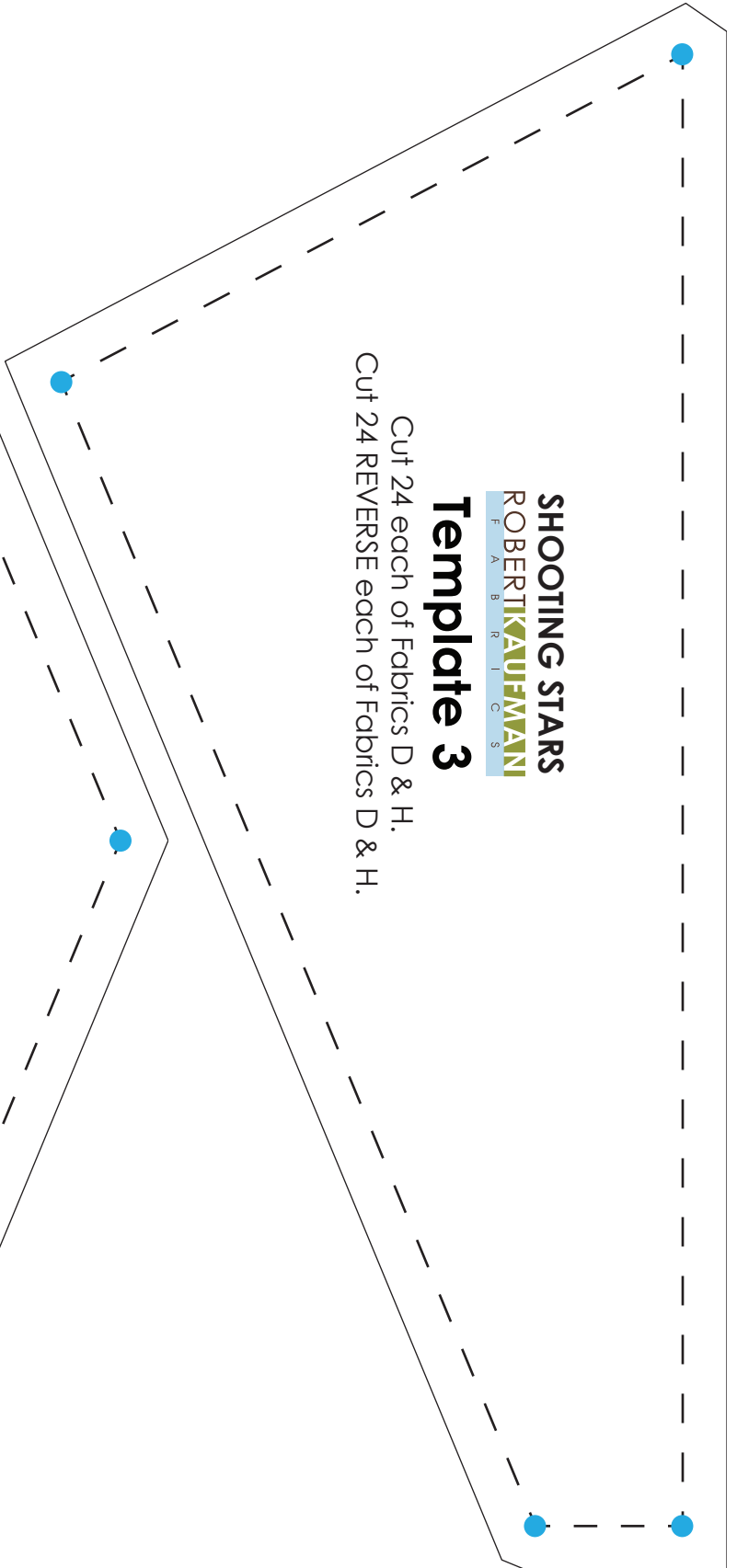

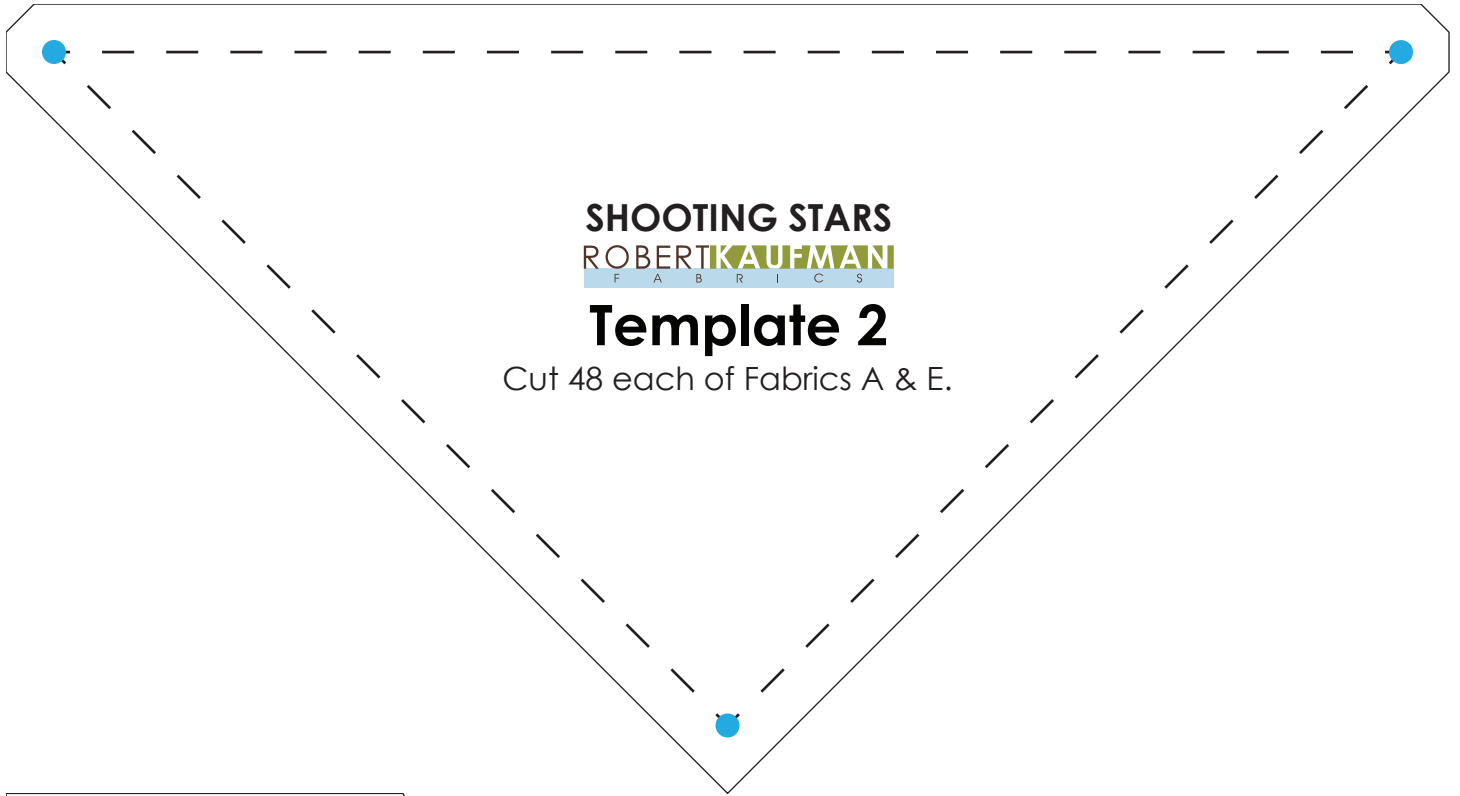

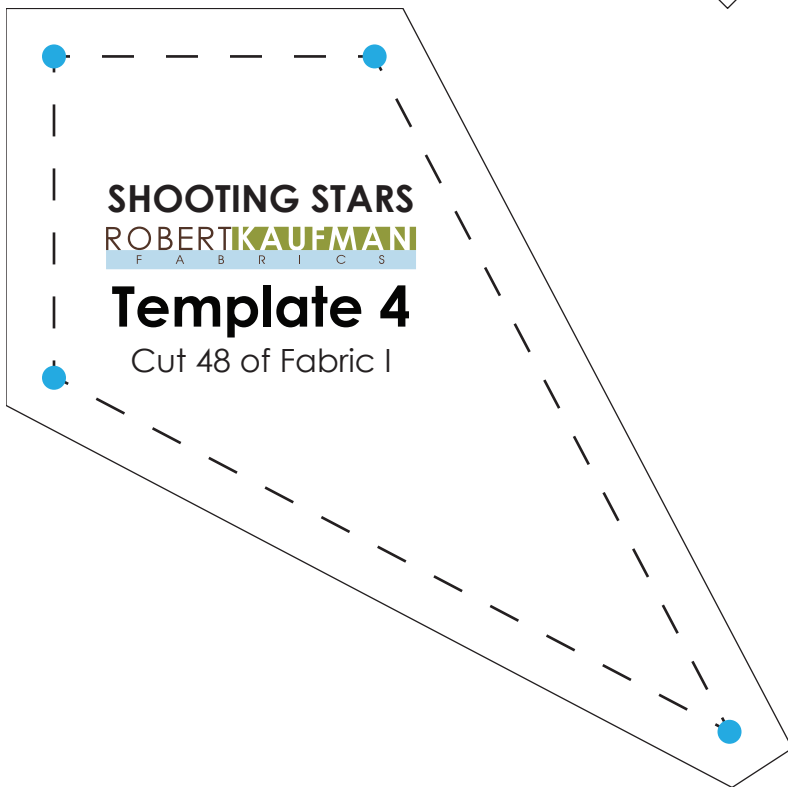
Cut 24 each of Fabrics D & H.
