Fabric and Supplies Needed

Fabric amounts based on yardage that is 42" wide.

Notes Before You Begin

- Read through all of the instructions before beginning.
- All of the seam allowances are 1/4" unless otherwise noted.
- Press seam allowances open unless otherwise noted.
- Width of fabric (WOF) is equal to at least 42" wide.
- Right sides together has been abbreviated to RST.
- Remember to measure twice and cut once!

Cutting Instructions

From Fabric A, fussy cut:

six 9-1/2" squares

From Fabric B, cut:

four 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

forty-eight 3" squares for the HSTs

From Fabric C, cut:

ten 3" x WOF strips. Subcut:

nine 3" x 11-1/2" sashing strips

forty-eight 3" squares for the HSTs

Sew the remaining three strips together end-to-end, then trim:

two 3" x 52" column sashing strips

five 2-1/2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2-1/2" x 38-1/2" top/bottom Border 1 pieces

two 2-1/2" x 56-1/2" side Border 1 pieces

From Fabric D, cut:

one 8-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

one 11-1/2" x WOF strip. Subcut:

twelve 2" x 11-1/2" rectangles

From Fabric E, cut:

five 2" x WOF strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 2" x 42-1/2" top/bottom Border 2 pieces

two 2" x 59" side Border 2 pieces

six 1-1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

twelve 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" rectangles

twelve 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" rectangles

Tip: Cut two of each length per strip in order to maximize the yardage.

From Fabric F, cut:

seven 4-1/2" x length of fabric strips. Sew together, end-to-end, then trim:

two 4-1/2" x 45-1/2" top/bottom Border 3 pieces

two 4-1/2" x 67" side Border 3 pieces

From the Binding Fabric, cut:

seven 2-1/2" x WOF strips

Assemble the Half-Square Triangle (HST) Blocks

Step 1: Pair a 3" Fabric B square with a 3" Fabric C square, RST. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square. Sew 1/4" away from both sides of the marked line. Cut on the marked line, creating two half-square triangles (HSTs). Press toward the darker fabric. Trim to 2-1/2" square. Repeat to make ninety-six B/C HSTs.





Step 2: Gather: sixteen B/C HSTs two 2" x 8-1/2" Fabric D rectangles two 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric D rectangles

Arrange the HSTs in four rows of four, following the Block Assembly Diagram. Note the fabric placement and HST orientation. Sew the HSTs together to form rows, pressing the seams in opposite directions every other row. Sew the rows together, nesting the seams and pressing the seams to one side.

Sew the 2" x 8-1/2" Fabric D strips to the top and bottom edges of the block. Press. Sew the 2" x 11-1/2" Fabric D strips to the left and right edges of the block. Press. The HST Block should measure 11-1/2" square.

Repeat to make six HST Blocks.

Assemble the Cat Blocks

Step 3: Sew the 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" Fabric E strips to the top and bottom edges of a Fabric A square. Press. Sew the 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" Fabric E strips to the left and right edges of the block. Press. The Cat Block should measure 11-1/2" square.

Repeat to make six Cat Blocks.





Step 4: Arrange the Cat and HST Blocks together in three columns of four, following the Quilt Assembly Diagram. Place the 3" x 11-1/2" Fabric C sashing strips between the blocks in each column. Sew the blocks and strips together to form three separate columns. Press toward the sashing.

Step 5: Sew the three columns together, placing a 3" x 52" Fabric C columns sashing strip between each one. Press toward the sashing.

Step 6: Sew the top and bottom Border 1 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 1 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 7: Sew the top and bottom Border 2 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 2 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Step 8: Sew the top and bottom Border 3 pieces to the quilt center. Press toward the borders. Sew the side Border 3 pieces to the sides of the quilt center. Press toward the borders.

Your quilt top is complete. Baste, quilt, bind and enjoy!

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
